Dr Oraon presented the State Budget with a total outlay of 91 thousand 277 crore rupees, with an increase of over 7,100 crore rupees in comparison to last year's budget. A provision of Rs 1200 crore has been made in the Budget for waiving off farmers' loans.

The breakup of budget includes a revenue expenditure of Rs. 75755.01 crore and Capital Expenditure of Rs 15521.99 crores.(Read more)

In Gujarat, the Deputy Chief Minister Nitin Patel has presented the budget for the year 2021-22 in the State Assembly at Gandhinagar today. Mr. Patel who holds the portfolio of Finance Ministry has



presented the State Budget with the total outlay of two lakh 27 thousand 29 crore rupees. This is the biggest outlay of the State Budget in Gujarat till now.

Delivering his budget speech, Mr. Patel announced the record allocation of 11,323 crore rupees for the health and family welfare. This was significant in view of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Patel has also announced the allocation of 7,232 crore rupees for the agriculture, farmer's welfare and cooperative sector. He also announced the allocation of 32,000 crore rupees for the education, while 3,511 crore rupees has been allocated for the woman and child development.

Similarly, an amount of 1,500 crore rupees has been allocated for the Ahmedabad Mumbai bullet train project, while 652 crore rupees have been allocated for the Statue of Unity. According to the budget, an amount of 1,349 crore rupees has been allocated for the tribal development. Mr. Nitin Patel said that Gujarat is now coming out from the COVID-19 pandemic following the rollout of vaccination under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He said that this year's budget will focus on ongoing development of the state.(Read more)

Kieron Pollard hit six sixes in an over to guide West Indies to a comprehensive four-wicket win against Sri Lanka in the first game of their three-match T20 series.

Sent in to bat at the Coolidge Cricket Ground in Osbourn, Antigua, Sri Lanka scored 131 for nine, with the debutant Pathum Nissanka top-scoring with 39 from 34 balls.

As the home side began their chase, leg-spinner Akila Dananjaya took a hat-trick in the fourth over in dismissing Evin Lewis for 28 and then Chris Gayle and Nicholas Pooran.

But in the sixth over the spinner was pummelled in all directions by Pollard, who joins India's Yuvraj Singh in hitting six sixes in a T20 international over. He also became the third player – along with Herschelle Gibbs – to record the achievement in any format of the game at international level. (Read more)

What: Discover 5 new Species of Shrub Frogs in Western Ghats

Five new species of shrub frogs have been discovered from the Western Ghats by researchers from India and the US. Western Ghats are one of the globally recognised biodiversity hotspots.

The frogs belong to the Old World tree frog family Rhacophoridae.

As per a report in news agency PTI, they were discovered by researchers from University of Delhi, Kerala Forest Research Institute and University of Minnesota. SEED is designed as a competitive incentive program for start-ups and MSMEs (micro, small and medium enterprises) wishing to develop products / services in areas of interest to ISRO, the space agency helping them to use its facilities, officials said.

A formal mechanism for the program is expected to be announced soon, they said. (Read more)

What: to pay shareholders from Rs 9,876 crore Numaligarh Refinery stake sale

Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd (BPCL) may use Rs 9,876 crore proceed from stake sale in Numaligarh Refinery to pay a special dividend to shareholders, the biggest being Government of India, BPCL director (finance) N Vijayagopal said on Tuesday. The Board of BPCL on Monday approved the sale of the company's 61.65 per cent stake in Numaligarh Refinery Ltd (NRL) to a consortium of state-owned Oil India, consultancy firm Engineers India Ltd (EIL) and Government of Assam for Rs 9,875.96 crore.

The offer by the OIL-led consortium was "above the reserve price we had set for the stake sale," he told reporters.

BPCL will seek approval of the shareholders at a meeting on March 25 and plans to sign the sale pact within two days of that and conclude the transaction before month-end, he said.(Read more)

Union Government has plans to sell up to 16 per cent of its stakes in IRCON International through an offer for sale (OFS) today, i.e. March 3, 2021. The government seeks to raise around Rs 662 crore through stake sales. The floor price for the offer has been fixed at Rs 88 per share.

The base issue size of the OFS is 10 per cent or over 4.70 crore equity shares, with a green-shoe option to retain over-subscription of 6 per cent or over 2.82 crore shares. The total issue size, including the green-shoe option, comes to 16 per cent or over 7.52 crore shares.(Read more)

Markets regulator Sebi on Wednesday cancelled the certificate of registration of Sahara India Financial Corporation Ltd as a sub-broker citing its failure to fulfill the "fit and proper" criteria.

The regulator had appointed a designated authority in 2018 to enquire whether Sahara India Financial violated provisions of Intermediaries Regulations.

According to the designated authority's report, considering the antecedents of Subrata Roy Sahara and the various judicial pronouncements against him and other group companies of Sahara, it is determined that Sahara India Financial (noticee) is not a "fit and proper person" to continue as a subbroker in the securities market.(Read more)

What: Inks USD 10.40 Mn Soft Loan Pact With Eswatini

Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank) on Wednesday said it has inked a USD 10.40 million (Rs 75.99 crore) loan deal with Eswatini (Swaziland) on behalf of the Indian government.

Exim Bank, on behalf of the Indian government, has extended a Line of Credit (LoC) of USD 10.40 million to the government of the Kingdom of Eswatini (Swaziland) for the construction of disaster recovery site, the bank said in a release.

With the signing of this agreement, Exim Bank, till date has extended three LoCs to Eswatini, taking the total value to USD 68.30 million.

Exim Bank said the Indian government's soft loan to Eswatini covers projects in sectors including information technology, disaster management and agriculture.(Read more)

Global terror financing watchdog, Financial Action Task Force (FATF) on Thursday retained Pakistan on its "grey list" till June after concluding that Islamabad failed to address its strategically important deficiencies, to fully implement the 27 point action plan that the watchdog had drawn up for Pakistan.

The global watchdog had in October last year asked Pakistan, which has been on the FATF grey list over issues related to terror financing, to deliver on all 27 points by this February. (Read more)

Australian conservationists on Wednesday unveiled plans to build the world's first refuge for the platypus, to promote breeding and rehabilitation as the duck-billed mammal faces extinction due to climate change.



The Taronga Conservation Society Australia and the New South Wales State government said they would build the specialist facility, mostly ponds and burrows for the semiaquatic creatures, at a zoo 391 km (243 miles) from Sydney, by 2022, which could house up to 65 platypuses.

"There is so much to learn about the platypus and we know so little," Taronga CEO Cameron Kerr told reporters.(Read more)

What: to participate in Multinational Air Exercise 'Desert Flag VI' in UAE for the 1st time

When: published on 3rd March 2021

The Indian Ministry of Defence (MoD) has announced that the Indian Air Force (IAF) will take part in the Exercise Desert Flag-VI.

The country is participating for the first time in the exercise and will join the airforces of France, the US, the UAE, Saudi Arabia, South Korea and Bahrain.

Starting on 3 March, the exercise will run until 27 March at Al-Dhafra airbase in the UAE.

According to a statement issued by the MoD, the IAF will participate with six Su-30 MKI, two C-17 and one IL-78 tanker aircraft in the exercise.

The Sukhoi Su-30MKI is a multirole combat fighter aircraft jointly developed by the Sukhoi Design Bureau and Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) for IAF. (Read more)
