Madhya Pradesh Governor Anandiben Patel on Sunday approved the ordinance to increase reservation for Other Backward Classes (OBCs) from 14 per cent to 27 per cent, making MP the only state in India to have 27 per cent quota for OBCs. In a big move before the Lok Sabha elections, the Kamal Nath government in MP issued an ordinance, almost doubling the reservation for OBCs to 27 per cent. State Law and Legal Affairs Minister PC Sharma on Saturday told news agency PTI the ordinance had been "issued and notified".

Political analysts are saying the move has been taken to woo OBC voters before the Lok Sabha elections 2019. The ordinance was forwarded to the governor on Friday, following which she gave her consent to increase the reservation for OBCs to 27 per cent in MP. As per reports, the Elections Commission of India (ECI) could announce election date soon, and states and central government are doing everything they can to appease voters before the Model Code of Conduct kicks in.
