What: lands in Indian Ocean

When: published on 9th May 2021

Remnants of China's biggest rocket landed in the Indian Ocean on Sunday, with most of its components destroyed upon re-entry into the atmosphere, ending days of speculation over where the debris would hit but drawing US criticism over lack of transparency.

The coordinates given by Chinese state media, citing the China Manned Space Engineering Office, put the point of impact in the ocean, west of the Maldives archipelago.

Debris from the Long March 5B has had some people looking warily skyward since it blasted off from China's Hainan island on April 29, but the China Manned Space Engineering Office said most of the debris was burnt up in the atmosphere.

Maharashtra Health Minister Rajesh Tope has said that patients of Mucormycosis will be treated free of cost under Mahatma Phule Jan Arogya Yojana of the state. Tope said that Mucormycosis is a



rare fungal infection which is now affecting those suffering from Corona virus and the medicines required for the treatment of this disease are expensive, therefore the state has decided to provide free treatment for this disease.

Cases of mucormycosis are rising among COVID-19 survivors, causing blindness or serious illness and even death in some cases and the health department of Maharashtra has taken serious note of it. The state Health Minister Rajesh Tope has said that due to the expensive treatment of the disease, the patients will be treated free of cost in 1000 hospitals in the state under the Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jan Arogya Yojana. He said that patients with uncontrolled diabetes are more likely to have symptoms of fungal disease and dark spots are found near the nose and lips. He added that if the disease is not treated early, it can have adverse effects on the respiratory system, brain and eyes. Therefore an awareness campaign will be launched in the state to fight the disease. Tope has appealed that the patients suffering from this disease should not panic and those who have diabetes should keep it under control and has also urged the patients to exercise, have a proper diet and take medication on the advice of doctors.

Puducherry has become the 'Har Ghar Jal' Union Territory by ensuring that every rural home gets a household tap connection. Puducherry has now become the fourth state or UT after Goa, Telangana and Andaman and Nicobar Islands to provide assured tap water supply to every rural home under Central Government's flagship programme, Jal Jeevan Mission, JJM.

The Ministry of Jal Shakti in a statement said that all 1.16 lakh rural households in Puducherry have tap water supply now. The UT has achieved the 'Har Ghar Jal' status much ahead of the target fixed. The Ministry also said that the State of Punjab and the UTs of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu have also crossed the milestone of covering 75 per cent of rural homes with assured tap water supply. Punjab has also planned for 100 per cent coverage of all rural households by 2022.

Fintech major Paytm on Thursday launched 'COVID-19 Vaccine Finder' - a platform to help citizens check the availability of vaccination slots - on its Mini App store. The platform will help citizens to check the availability of vaccination slots for a specific date by individually entering different pin codes or district details along with age group (18+ or 45+), a statement said.

In case the slots are saturated for the near future, users can select the option for real-time alerts from Paytm once any slot is free, it added.

"The automated process reduces the hassle and ordeal of refreshing the platform for new slots repeatedly. The data is sourced on a real-time basis from the CoWIN API where a slot can be booked to take the vaccination," it said.

A Paytm spokesperson said the new feature will help users find COVID vaccine slots in their locality and set for alerts when new slots open up.

Earlier, in August 2018, the name of the village was officially changed from Miyon ka Bara to Mahesh Nagar after residents complained that they were unable to get matrimonial matches for their children as the name gave an impression that it is inhabited by Muslims. The Union Home



Ministry had approved the change of name and conveyed the decision to the Rajasthan government in 2018.

A similar exercise was repeated for renaming the railway station as it is a Union subject.

The village in has a population of around 1400 people.

The Hindu had earlier reported that during the pre-Independence period, the original name of the village was Mahesh Ro Bado and over a time its name changed, giving an impression that it is inhabited by Muslims.

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has developed an artificial intelligence algorithm 'ATMAN AI', that can detect Covid-19 infection by analysing chest x-rays.

This method fo<mark>r rapid id</mark>entification and assessment of lung involvement was developed with the support of 5C Network & HCG Academics.

This will be utilized by online diagnostic startup 5C Network, India's largest digital network of radiologists, with support of HCG Academics across India.

UK Singh, director, CAIR, DRDO, said: "The development of ATMAN, an artificial intelligence- based diagnostic tool for chest x-ray screening is part of DRDO's effort to help clinicians and partners on the frontline to have the tools they need to rapidly diagnose and effectively treat Covid-19 patients. Given the limited testing facilities for coronavirus, there is a rush to develop AI tools for quick analysis using x-rays. The tool will help in automatically detecting radiological findings indicative of Covid-19 in seconds, enabling physicians and radiologists to more effectively triage the cases, especially in an emergency environment."

Canada Pension Plan Investment Board (CPP Investments), the largest Canadian pension fund manager, today said it bought an additional 15.9 per cent of the total units in IndInfravit Trust for Rs 1,005 crore. The units were bought in two separate deals.

CPP Investments has acquired seven per cent of the units from Sadbhav Infrastructure Project and will acquire an additional 8.9 per cent from L&T IDPL, which, upon completion, will increase CPP Investments' stake in IndInfravit from 27.9 per cent to 43.8 per cent.

IndInfravit is an infrastructure investment trust (InvIT) sponsored by L&T Infrastructure Development Projects Limited . Launched in 2018, IndInfravit acquires and maintains stable brownfield road concessions in the country.

IndInfravit holds a portfolio of 13 operational road concessions across five states including Karnataka, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and Telangana.

For the coming Kharif 2021, it is proposed to distribute more than 20 lakh mini kits of seeds amounting to nearly Rs 82 crore. It is ten times more than last year. The total cost for these mini-kits will be borne by the Central Government to boost the production and productivity of tur, moong and urad. The move will cover over four lakh hectare area across the country. The Ministry of Agriculture in a statement said that for effective implementation of the Kharif mini kit programme, a massive outreach with the concerned districts will be held.
