What: appointed White House senior adviser

When: published on 15th May 2021

Indian-American policy expert Neera Tanden has been appointed as a senior adviser to US President Joe Biden, two months after she withdrew her nomination as Director of the White House Office of Management and Budget due to stiff opposition from Republican senators.

Tanden has been entrusted with two tasks - launch a review of the US Digital Service, and plan contingencies that could result from the Supreme Court's consideration of Republican lawsuits seeking to strike down the Affordable Care Act.

Tanden, 50, is currently the president and CEO of a progressive think-tank, Center for American Progress (CAP). She expected to join the White House team on Monday.

"We have created a completely transparent system for distribution of foreign aid with a detailed SOP (standard operating procedure)," NITI Aayog CEO Amitabh Kant told ET, "CovAid will help individuals and organisations to do end-to-end tracking till the ultimate beneficiary." A detailed SOP has been laid out to ensure that the states with high active cases receive supplies on a priority basis.

Punjab Chief Minister Captain Amarinder Singh condoled the death said, "Saddened to lose former Governor & Senior Congress Leader & six-time MP, Raghunandan Lal Bhatia Ji. My thoughts and prayers are with his family members in their hour of grief. May his soul rest in peace."

What: Launched Moma Market Mobile App For Vegetable Delivery

When: published on 15th May 2021

To ensure people get fresh vegetables at their doorsteps amid the Covid-19 induced curfew, chief minister N Biren Singh on Friday launched a mobile application for home delivery of the same.

The 'MOMA market mobile application' can be downloaded from www.momamarket.com and it will also be available on Google Play Store soon, a statement issued by the CM's office said, adding that the app version for iOS will also be released shortly.

To break the chain of infection, curfew is currently in force in seven districts — Imphal West, Imphal East, Thoubal, Kakching, Bishnupur, Churachandpur and Ukhrul.

Under the CM's supervision, Manipur Organic Mission Agency (MOMA), a unit of the state horticulture and soil conservation department, introduced the app to make fresh vegetables available for day-to-day consumption and curb the distress sales of farm produces during lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Jeff Bezos' space venture Blue Origin will launch its first astronaut crew to space on July 20, flying on its space tourism rocket called New Shepard, the company announced Wednesday.

Blue Origin has yet to open ticket sales or release pricing information about New Shepard flights, but will host a public auction for a seat on the first crewed launch.



A sealed online auction will run until May 19 and bids can go up to \$50,000 – with the company requiring additional identification information and a \$10,000 deposit for higher bids. Then, from May 19 onward, Blue Origin will hold a public bidding process – before a final live online auction on June 12.

What: partners with SpaceX to provide Starlink Internet Service

Elon Musk-run SpaceX has announced a new partnership to bolster the use of its satellite Internet connectivity. The US-based aerospace manufacturer has collaborated with Google Cloud to deliver data, cloud services, and applications to its enterprise customers.

Cloud services are often required by organisations having broad footprints, like public sector agencies, businesses with presences at the network edge, or those operating in rural or remote areas. Google Cloud will now try to leverage Starlink's high-speed broadband Internet for its infrastructure to support such activities for its enterprise customers.

Under the partnership, SpaceX will locate Starlink ground stations within Google data centre properties. The company's more than 1,500 low-Earth-orbit satellites will then enable secure, low-latency delivery of data through Google Cloud.

After a comprehensive assessment, 15 names were initially shortlisted, out of 107 candidates, that were identified for doing incredible work with communities to safeguard wildlife, habitats, and the future of society. Out of the 15 candidates, the Whitley Fund for Nature narrowed down to six finalists, including Y. Nuklu Phom.

It offers a host of other facilities that include providing contact details of various SPOCs (single point of contact) across zones for help, registration facility for employees to sign up for volunteer work in their cities, reaching out under the 'Need Help' section to request assistance for themselves or their families.

The site is also hosting external links for suppliers of necessities like oxygen cylinders, Remdesivir, plasma and hospital beds.

NABARD has additionally sanctioned Rs 1150 crore to Government of Assam throughout 2020-21 underneath RIDF XXVI for creation of latest infrastructure initiatives. On implementation, these initiatives will result in creation of 610 kms size of rural roads benefitting 1255 villages and favourably impacting about 16 lakh individuals of rural areas of Assam, apart from benefiting 2472 hectare underneath irrigation, augmentation of infrastructure growth of 2437 elementary faculties and 23,397 ha underneath flood safety.

It was also the first double bagel in the final of the Rome tournament and the most one-sided since Hungary's Andrea Temesvari beat American Bonnie Gadusek 6-1 6-0 in 1983.

Swiatek's third title overall following triumphs at Roland Garros and Adelaide came on the back of one of the most dominant performances of the 19-year-old's career as she dropped only 13 points against the Czech, who was the 2019 Rome champion.
