Who: Ex-Saurashtra player Rajendrasinh Jadeja

What: passes away

When: published on 16th May 2021

Former Saurashtra pacer and match referee Rajendrasinh Jadeja passed away on Sunday due to Covid-19. He was 66. The Saurashtra Cricket Association (SCA) said that Jadeja died early Sunday morning.

"Everyone at Saurashtra Cricket Association are deeply saddened by the untimely demise of Rajendrasinh Jadeja, one of the most remarkable yesteryear cricketers of Saurashtra. He left for heavenly abode today early morning after fighting a hard battle against Covid-19," it said in a statement.

Jadeja played 50 first class matches and took 134 wickets. He also played in 11 List A games and took 14 wickets and also scored 1,536 runs in first class cricket, with 104 runs in List A.

He served as the Board of Control for Cricket in India's (BCCI) official referee in 53 first-class matches, 18 List A games and 34 T20s.

Notable astronomy communicator and director of the Nehru Planetarium, Nandivada Rathnasree, 57, died on Sunday after being infected with Covid. Rathnasree, who joined the planetarium in 1996 as a senior educator and became its director in 1999, has been credited with several new initiatives and projects during her long stint.

Anuj Sinha, former director of the National Council for Science and Technology Communication said that she was devoted to her role. "She ensured that the number of outreach events multiplied by several times. She would work on weekends, day and night to ensure astronomy reached people.





She brought a lot of life to the subject. I was also in science outreach so she was a great ally to work with. She tried to make sure that the wonders of the sky are seen, appreciated and understood," he said.

Her husband Patrick Dasgupta is a faculty member at the Department of Physics and Astrophysics at Delhi University.

What: successfully lands Zhurong rover on Mars

When: published on 17th May 2021

China has become the second country after the US to successfully land a spacecraft on the surface of Mars. According to the state media, the controlled touchdown of Zhurong – a six-wheel rover named after a fire god in Chinese mythology – occurred at around 7:18 a.m. Beijing Time on 15 May. It landed, as planned, in southern Utopia Planitia, which is a largely flat area between 25° and 30° north of the Martian equator.

Zhurong was launched in July 2020 as part of China's first independent Mars mission Tianwen-1. The mission arrived at Mars in February and it orbited the red planet for three months, searching for the best location to descend. Tianwen-1 then released the lander – containing Zhurong – after 1





a.m. on 15 May. The lander first used a heat shield during entry into the Martian atmosphere, followed by a parachute during descent near the surface, before finally firing a "retro engine" to safely land. With Tianwen-1 still in orbit, it will now provide relay communication between Zhurong and the Earth.

"You did it. You are in the Hall of Fame now. You are a true champion, not just an MVP. You are an all-time great," Vanessa said.



San Antonio Spurs star Duncan, Minnesota Timberwolves and Boston Celtics big man Garnett, twotime NBA champion coach Rudy Tomjanovich and WNBA legend Tamika Catchings were among those also inducted on Saturday night.

What: Wins Consecutive High Jump Titles While Representing University in USA

When: published on 16th May 2021

Representing Kansas State University, India's Tejaswini Shankar won back-to-back men's high jump titles in the Big 12 Outdoor Track and Field Championships in Manhattan, USA. Shankar, 22, cleared the bar at 2.28m to win high jump gold on Saturday, but his efforts fell short of Tokyo Olympic Games qualification standard of 2.33m. Shankar had also won the men's high jump title in the 2019 edition of the Big 12 Outdoor Track and Field Championships while the 2020 edition was cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

The Delhi-based national record in men's high jump is studying business administration at Kansas State University. He is on a four-year athletics scholarship since 2017.



Shankar had skipped the Federation Cup Athletics Championships in March as the dates clashed with his National Collegiate Athletics Association (NCAA) indoor season. He won the high jump bronze by clearing 2.24m in the NCAA meet.

Shankar is the third Indian to compete in the highly competitive USA circuit, the breeding ground for many US track and field Olympians.

What: partners with Elon Musk's SpaceX for its Starlink satellite Internet service

Elon Musk-run SpaceX has announced a new partnership to bolster the use of its satellite Internet connectivity. The US-based aerospace manufacturer has collaborated with Google Cloud to deliver data, cloud services, and applications to its enterprise customers.

Cloud services are often required by organisations having broad footprints, like public sector agencies, businesses with presences at the network edge, or those operating in rural or remote areas. Google Cloud will now try to leverage Starlink's high-speed broadband Internet for its infrastructure to support such activities for its enterprise customers.

Under the partnership, SpaceX will locate Starlink ground stations within Google data centre properties. The company's more than 1,500 low-Earth-orbit satellites will then enable secure, low-latency delivery of data through Google Cloud.

What: releases Rs. 5,968 crore to 15 States under Jal Jeevan Mission for financial year 2021-22

The Government of India has released Rs 5,968 Crore to 15 States for the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission in the financial year 2021-22. This is the first tranche of the four to be released in this financial year. Other 17 States/ Union Territories (UTs) have been asked to send their proposals to National Jal Jeevan Mission for release of funds.

"Out of the Central fund allocated under Jal Jeevan Mission, 93 percent of the fund is to be utilized on developing water supply infrastructure, 5 percent on support activities and 2 percent on water quality monitoring and surveillance activities", as per an official release by the Ministry of Jal Shakti.

The Central funds are released by the Government of India based on the output in terms of tap water connections provided in the States/ UTs and the utilization of available Central and matching State share.
