When: published on 18th May 2021

Arvind Kumar set to be the next Managing Director (MD) of Chennai Petroleum Corporation Limited (CPCL), a subsidiary company of Indian Oil. He has been recommended for the post by the Public Enterprises Selection Board (PESB) panel on Tuesday. He is currently serving as Executive Director (Projects) Refineries HQ of Indian Oil, New Delhi. Currently, CPCL's Director (Finance) Rajeev Ailawadi is holding the additional charge of CPCL's MD post.

Kumar has been recommended for the post of MD of CPCL from a list of eight candidates who interviewed by the selection panel. There were a total of three candidates including Kumar who were on the list were from India Oil and one each from Chennai Petroleum Corporation Limited, Madras Fertilizers Limited, Fertilizers & Chemicals Travancore Limited, Indian Telecommunication Service and REPCO Home Finance Limited.

As Managing Director (MD) of CPCL, Kumar will be the chief executive of the corporation and will be accountable to its board of directors, holding company and the government. He also will be responsible for the efficient functioning of the corporation for achieving its corporate objectives and performance parameters.

What: Announces Special Grant Of Rs 10 Lakh To Villages Achieving 100% Vaccination

When: published on 18th May 2021

Punjab Chief Minister Captain Amarinder Singh announced a special development grant of Rs 10 lakhs to each village that meets the state government's 100% vaccination goal under the 'Corona Mukt Pind Abhiyan.' The Chief Minister urged Sarpanches and Panches across the state to lead their villages in the battle against COVID-19, urging them to encourage people to get tested even if they

have mild symptoms and to get vaccinated.

Via LED screens, he was communicating virtually with village Panchayats represented by more than 2000 heads/members in over 4000 live locations across the state's rural areas. The CM told them that his government had already given Sarpanches permission to use up to Rs.5000 per day from

Panchayat funds for emergency COVID care, up to a total of Rs.50,000.

The Chief Minister stressed the importance of educating the rural population about the adverse effects of Coronavirus and the importance of early diagnosis and treatment in order to save lives, saying that this could only be accomplished through special awareness campaigns. He requested the Panchayats to set up special medical camps and enlist the help of ex-servicemen who had served in many wars during their active military careers and were now helping the state combat the

pandemic.

The Telangana government on Tuesday decided to implement Ayushman Bharat in the state with immediate effect, almost two-and-half-years after the Centre launched the health scheme nationally.

Telangana health officials signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the national health authority on Tuesday to implement the scheme in the state. The state health authorities have directed the chief executive officer of Telangana Aarogyasri Health Care Trust to see that patients

get treatment in the empanelled hospitals as per the newly converged health scheme.

Ayushman Bharat was launched by the Centre in September 2018. Telangana was among the states that had opposed the scheme and even claimed that its own Aarogyasri scheme was much better. Chief minister K Chandrasekhar Rao had rejected the national scheme on the floor of the assembly.

Limited on the manufacturing of the Johnson COVID-19 vaccine. We believe Biological E. will be an important part of our global COVID-19 vaccine supply network, where multiple manufacturing sites are involved in the production of our vaccine across different facilities, sometimes in different countries and continents, before the vaccine can be distributed", read an official statement by Johnson and Johnson.

The Union Government has said that 24 per cent more wheat has been procured during the current Rabi Marketing Season 2021-22 in comparison to corresponding period of last year. Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution in a statement said that a quantity of over 373.51 lakh tonnes of wheat has been procured against the last year corresponding purchase of over 300 lakh tonnes.

It said, nearly 38.22 lakh farmers have already been benefitted from the ongoing procurement operations with MSP value of over Rs 73,768 crore. It said, procurement of wheat in ongoing Rabi Marketing Season is continuing smoothly in the procuring States including Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Rajasthan and Himachal Pradesh.

Karnataka has emerged as the best state and is ranked number one in establishing health and wellness centres (HWC) under the Ayushman Bharat Program, to provide comprehensive primary healthcare in rural areas, the state's Health and Family welfare department said on Tuesday.

The state leads in implementing the project for the year 2020-21, the department said in a statement.

It said the union government had set a target of establishing 2,263 HWC sub-centres, and the state has upgraded 3,300 centres till March 31, which is 146 per cent more than the set target.

The Centre had also given the target of upgrading 2,096 PHCs to HWCs, 2,168 have been upgraded so far which is 103 per cent more than the set target, it further said.

What: fared "relatively better" than other major economies in Q1 of 2021: UN

When: published on 19th May 2021

India, China and South Africa have fared "relatively better" than other major economies in imports and exports in the first quarter of this year, according to the latest UN data which said that global trade recovery from the COVID-19 crisis hit a record high during in the same period.

The Global Trade Update by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) on Wednesday said that in Q1 2021, the value of global trade in goods and services grew by about 4 per cent quarter-over-quarter and by about 10 per cent year-over-year.

"Importantly, global trade in Q1 2021 was higher than pre-crisis levels, with an increase of about 3 per cent relative to Q1 2019," it said, adding that the trade rebound of Q1 2021 continues to be driven by the strong export performance of East Asian economies.

In Q1 2021, the value of trade in goods was higher than pre-pandemic level, but trade in services remains substantially below averages. During the first quarter of 2021, global trade of COVID-19 related products remained strong.

Technology Academy Finland (TAF) has today, on 18 May, declared British Cambridge University professors Shankar Balasubramanian and David Klenerman as winners of the Millennium Technology Prize. The Prize is worth one million euros.

The duo's Next Generation Sequencing (NGS) technology means DNA can now be read in super-fast times. This means huge benefits to society, from helping the fight against killer diseases such as COVID-19 or cancer, to better understanding crop diseases and enhancing food production.



Next generation sequencing provides an effective way to study and identify new coronavirus strains and other pathogens. With the emergence of the pandemic, the technology is now being used to track and explore the novel coronavirus viral mutations, which is growing global concern. This work has helped the creation of multiple vaccines now being administered worldwide and is critical to the creation of new vaccines against new dangerous viral strains. The results will also be used to prevent future pandemics. The International Selection Committee – the body of experts that evaluates all nominations for the prize – made its decision in February 2020, before the global spread of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Tashi Yangjom holds the title of the first Indian woman climber to scale Mount Everest in 2021. She began the climb on May 9 and completed her journey on May 11, reaching the peak early 6 am.

She is among the first in India to kick off climbing season this year in the face of a deadly wave of coronavirus obstructing sporting activities. Earlier this month, panic gripped the Everest base camp as reports of a possible COVID-19 outbreak there emerged. Authorities in Nepal raised the alarm about as many as 17 positive cases, as per the BBC.

The Competition Commission of India (CCI) has approved the acquisition of an additional 25% stake in Adani Krishnapatnam Port by Adani Ports & Special Economic Zone (APSEZ).

The Rs 2,800 crore transaction will make the port in southern Andhra Pradesh fully owned by the Gautam Adani-led firm. APSEZ had acquired its 75% stake in October last year.

The CCI also gave its approval to White Oak Capital-owned GPL Finance & Investments' acquisition of 100% equity in YES Asset Management and YES Trustee Ltd.

What: to sell 1.95% stake in Axis Bank to raise Rs 4,000 cr

When: published on 19th May 2021

The Centre is selling up to 58 million shares in Axis Bank, held via the Specified Undertaking of the Unit Trust of India (SUUTI) to raise around ₹4,000 crore.

These shares are sold through the offer for sale (OFS) route. The OFS will open for non-retail investors on Wednesday, while retail investors can bid on Thursday.

The government is selling 35 million shares, or 1.21% stake, in the company as a base offer with a green-shoe option of 22 million shares, or 0.74% stake, at a floor price of ₹680 apiece. Shares of Axis Bank gained marginally on Tuesday to close at ₹711.90 on BSE.

SUUTI held a 9.56% stake in Axis Bank as of December 31, 2018. It reduced the stake to 3.45% as of March 31, 2021. SUUTI sold 6.14 million shares of Axis Bank in December last year, garnering ₹374 for the government. In November, it had sold 3.6 million shares for a consideration of ₹221.47 crore. The stock has rallied 18% since December 1, compared with a 15% jump in the Nifty index.

Adani Green Energy on Wednesday announced that it will acquire SB Energy's 5 GW India renewable power portfolio for a fully completed EV of \$3.5 billion.

"Adani Green (AGEL) has signed definitive agreements for 100% acquisition of SB Energy Holdings Limited. SB Energy India is a joint venture between Japan-based SoftBank Group Corp (80%) and Bharti Group (20%) and houses 4,954 MW of renewable assets in India", the company said in an exchange filing.

"Kotak Mahindra Bank Limited has acquired 1,30,80,000 Equity Shares (~46.7% of the issued and paid-up Equity Share Capital) of Kotak Mahindra Pension Fund Limited ("KMPFL") from Kotak Mahindra Asset Management Company Limited ("KMAMC")", the bank said.

A Long March-4B rocket, developed by the Shanghai Academy of Spaceflight Technology, carried the Haiyang-2D (HY-2D) satellite to orbit. The launch occurred at 12:03 a.m. (Beijing Time), according to the launch center. The satellite was manufactured by the China Academy of Science (CAST).
