After graduating from the Elphinstone College in Mumbai, he trained in western classical music in London and Paris.

On returning home, he joined the advertising world, working for a phenomenal 6,000 ad jingles. He created the soundtracks for Aparna Sen's '36 Chowringhee Lane' and Kundan Shah's 'Jaane Bhi Do Yaaro'. His last work was an opera titled 'Agni Varsha' which was performed in New York. (Read more)

What: excludes Lakshmi Vilas Bank from second schedule of RBI Act

When: published on 6th May 2021

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Thursday said it has excluded Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB) from the Second Schedule of the RBI Act after it was merged with DBS Bank India Ltd (DBIL) last year.

"We advise that the "Lakshmi Vilas Bank Ltd" has been excluded from the Second Schedule to the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 with effect from November 27, 2020, vide Notification DOR.PSBD.No.1849/16.01.067/2020-21 dated December 17, 2020, which is published in the Gazette of India (Part III - Section 4) dated January 16 – January 22, 2021," RBI said in a notification on Thursday.

A bank mentioned in the Second Schedule of the Reserve Bank of India Act is known as 'Scheduled Commercial Bank'.(Read more)

The RBI on Friday said an advisory group has been constituted to assist the second regulatory review authority (RRA 2.0) which was constituted by the central bank earlier this month to streamline regulations and reduce the compliance burden of regulated entities.

Headed by SBI managing director S Janakiraman, the advisory group will assist the RRA by identifying regulations, guidelines, and returns that can be rationalised.

The RBI has set up the second regulatory review authority (RRA 2.0), initially for a period of one year from May 1, 2021, with a view to streamline regulations and reduce the compliance burden of regulated entities.(Read more)

What: ties up with Essar to develop steel plant in Kadapa

When: published on 6th May 2021

The Andhra Pradesh (AP) Government has entered a partnership with Essar Steel for establishing a steel plant in the Kadapa district, with 3 million tonne per annum (mtpa) capacity.

On February 23, the state Cabinet withdrew its previous decision, electing Liberty Steel India as the JV associate to construct the YSR Steel Plant.

According to Information Minister Perni Venkataramaiah, the State Cabinet considered the proposal and accepted SBICAP's recommendation to pick Essar Steel as the JV partner.

The outlined capital expenditure of the project is Rs 11,606 crore. The government set up the YSR Steel Corporation for the progress and operation of a new steel plant in the Kadapa district and invited bids last November from prominent firms for recruiting as a joint venture partner. (Read more)

Lieutenant Governor, Manoj Sinha today approved the further release of Rs 250 crore as Interest Subvention, part of economic package for revival of business and industry in J&K, and handed over a cheque of the said amount to Jammu and Kashmir Bank as third instalment of the 5% Interest Subvention.

Arun Kumar Mehta, Financial Commissioner, Finance Department and RK Chhibber, Chairman and MD J&K Bank were present on the occasion.

Government of J&K had already released Rs 500 crore so far, and today another instalment of Rs 250 crore as 5% Interest Subvention was released as part of the overall package of Rs 1353 crore. The Interest Subvention has so far provided immense relief to 3.44 lakh borrowers in the current Covid-19 crisis.

What: passes away

V Kalyanam, best known as the man who served as Mahatma Gandhi's personal secretary between 1944 and 1948, passed away in the city at 99.

It was exactly 77 years ago, on another sweltering May afternoon that Kalyanam had met 'Bapu' for the first time in Bombay. The latter had just been released from prison and was undergoing a treatment of naturopathy in the city. But Kalyanam had soaked in the Gandhian ideology before that by working at the Sevagram Ashram for about a year and serving eight months in jail for participating in the Quit India Movement. "He was caught by the police in Delhi slipping pamphlets under doors of homes. He was fresh out of college and was doing his bit," says Kalyanam's biographer Kumari S Neelakandan.(Read more)

What: comes up with "COVID-19 Hospital Transport Service" for free transportation of needy infected patients

The Haryana Police has come up with "COVID-19 Hospital Transport Service" (COV-HOTS) for free transportation of needy infected patients from their homes to hospitals or nursing homes and back. The service is free and exclusively meant for COVID patients.

Haryana Director General of Police (DGP), Manoj Yadava said that a total of 440 vehicles are being provided for this service and every police district would get 20 SUVs for this purpose.

"These vehicles are being provided after the instances of either shortage of ambulances or overcharging by private ambulance service providers came to the notice of the police", DGP said.

He said, 126 COV-HOTS vehicles have already been provided to all the districts across the state and 70 SUVs would reach the districts today. The remaining 244 would be delivered by Sunday evening, he added.(Read more)
