Intaglio printing based identification marks for helping the visually challenged in identification of denomination of banknotes are present in notes of Rs 100 and above.

1. Yosuke Asaji won the 2019 Asia-Pacific Diamond Cup.

Indian Professional golfer Rahil Gangjee finished tied 39th while 23-year-old Viraj Madappa faltered on the final day and ended tied 53rd at the Asia-Pacific Diamond Cup 2019.

Japan's Yosuke Asaji capped the title at the Sobu Country Club.

Asaji's winning total of three-under-par 281 also secured him a spot at The 148th Open which will be held at Royal Portrush, Northern Ireland in July 2019.

Micah Lauren Shin of the USA shared second place with Japanese amateur RenYonezawa.

2. Navy's first full-fledged SSB opened at Kolkata.

(Latest Legal Current Affairs Capsule of 20th May 2019)

The Indian Navy's first full-fledged Services Selection Board (SSB) was on Tuesday inaugurated by Navy Chief Admiral Sunil Lanba at Diamond Harbour near Kolkata.

The SSB (Kolkata) is located at a place that was previously occupied by a Naval Coastal Battery, a Navy statement said.

This is the fifth SSB of the Indian Navy and will cater for selection of both permanent and short service commission (SSC) officers. The other boards are located in Bhopal, Bengaluru, Visakhapatnam and Coimbatore.

Spread over 27 acres on the banks of Hooghly, the SSB (Kolkata) has the capacity to screen 5,000 officer-candidates annually.

3. Hinduja brothers top UK's Rich List for third time.

The billionaire Hinduja brothers have been named as the wealthiest people in the UK for a third time, according to the Sunday Times Rich List.

Sri and Gopi Hinduja saw their fortune increase by 1.356 billion pounds (\$1.7 billion) in the last year to 22 billion pounds, the BBC quoted the list as saying.

The Hinduja Group, a family business, was founded in Mumbai in 1914, and now it has interests around the world including in oil and gas, banking, IT and property.

4. Kerala links Aadhaar to attendance, salary for all govt officials.

Kerala's Left Democratic Front (LDF) government has made Aadhaar-based attendance mandatory for all government offices in the state, contradicting the stand of Left parties countrywide on the biometric identification project.

Leaders of Left parties in India, especially those from Kerala, have made some of the most fervent speeches against Aadhaar in public meetings and in Parliament.

All government offices are to install Aadhaar-based biometric attendance systems within six months, according to the 6 May order. As such, 560,000 officials, from those in the secretariat to government school staff, will need an Aadhaar number to draw their salaries.

5. India to co-chair Consultative Group (CG) of Global Facility for Disaster Reduction and Recovery (GFDRR).

India is unanimously chosen as co-chair of the Consultative Group (CG) of Global Facility for Disaster Reduction and Recovery (GFDRR) for the fiscal

year 2020. The decision was taken during the CG meeting of GFDRR held in Geneva, Switzerland today, on the margins of the 6th Session of the Global Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction (GPDRR) 2019. The CG Meeting was co-chaired by Africa Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) Group of States, the European Union (EU) and World Bank. Additionally, GFDRR in cooperation with the UNDRR and the EU is also organizing the 4th edition of World Reconstruction Conference (WRC) on May 13-14, 2019.

GFDRR is a global partnership that helps developing countries better understand and reduce their vulnerability to natural hazards and climate change. GFDRR is a grant-funding mechanism, managed by the World Bank, that supports disaster risk management projects worldwide. It is presently working on the ground with over 400 local, national, regional, and international partners and provides knowledge, funding, and technical assistance.

6. BharatPe ropes in Salman Khan as brand ambassador.

Merchant service and UPI payments app BharatPe Monday said it has roped in Bollywood actor Salman Khan as its brand ambassador.

The company is on an aggressive growth spree and will be launching a brand advertising campaign with Khan shortly, it said in a release.

The new brand campaign with Khan will be focused towards educating merchants and users about UPI payments along with driving adoption of BharatPe app for all their business needs, it added.

The fintech startup will also partner with the actor for outdoor campaigns, radio, social media and in-app education initiatives, the statement said.

7. Jehan Daruvala won FIA Formula 3 Championship.

Young Indian racer Jehan Daruvala, driving for Prema Racing, won the inaugural round of the FIA Formula 3 Championship, one of the support events to Formula One, here Sunday.

The all new FIA F3 Championship was created by merging the erstwhile GP3 Championship and FIA F3 European Championship, resulting in an ultra-competitive 30 car grid.

The only Indian on the grid, 20-year-old Jehan started from second position and grabbed the lead into the run down to the first corner. With an accident involving four cars at the back of the grid, the safety car was deployed on lap one.

At the restart Kari was able to benefit from Jehan's slipstream during the restart, and Jehan had to defend hard to keep the lead.

8. Mumbai Indians beat Chennai Super Kings in last-ball thriller to win 4th title.

Mumbai Indians defeated defending champions Chennai Super Kings by 1 run in a thriller in Hyderabad to become the 1st team to win the Indian Premier League 4 times.

Shane Watson played a starring role for Chennai Super Kings in an IPL final for the second successive year but his efforts were in vain as MI made a spectacular comeback.

It was a tense final. It was a thriller. After fortunes shifted both ways, Chennai Super Kings needed 9 off the final over but Lasith Malinga, who had gone for 20 in his previous over, gave away only 7 in the final over of the season to seal a sensational victory for Mumbai Indians.

No team had ever defeated Chennai Super Kings 4 times in an IPL season. MI had got the better of CSK in the league stages twice and had crushed them in the first qualifier before the nail-biting win in the final.

9. ADMM-PLUS exercise concludes in Singapore.

The 4th ASEAN Defense Ministers Meeting Plus (SDMM-Plus) Maritime Security Field Training Exercise (MS FTX) in the South China Sea concluded at Changi Naval Base in Singapore on Sunday,

Singapore's Ministry of Defense said in a statement that the ADMM-Plus Maritime Security Field Training Exercise held from April 30 to May 13 2019. It was held two phases. The Phase 1 of ADMM-Plus MS FTX Was scheduled for 1st May to 3rd May and its Phase 2 was scheduled from 9th May to 12th May. The Exercise began on 30th April in Busan, South Korea and concluded in Singapore.

The ADMM-Plus comprises of 10 ASEAN countries (Jakarta, Indonesia includes Thailand, Brunei, Laos, Indonesia, Myanmar (Burma), Vietnam, Singapore, Combodia, Malasia and Phillipines) and other 8 countries which are Australia, Japan, China, United Nations, New Zealand, South Korea, Russia and India.

10. DRDO conducts successful flight test of ABHYAS.
