All other words are correct in every aspect. Also, meaning of the given words:

**Working (Adjective):** having paid employment.

**Acceptance (Noun):** the action of consenting to receive or undertake something offered.

**Accompanying (Adjective):** provided or occurring at the same time as something else.

**Rejection (Noun):** the dismissing or refusing of a proposal, idea, etc.

Hence, option C is the correct answer.

2. 'Accomplishments' is the incorrect spelling of the word. The correct spelling is 'accomplishments'.

Also, meaning of the given words:

**Hateful (Adjective):** arousing, deserving of, or filled with hatred

**Convention (Noun):** a way in which something is usually done.

**Attention (Noun):** notice taken of someone or something; the regarding of someone or something as interesting or important.

**Accomplishment (Noun):** something that has been achieved successfully.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

3. The only misspelled word among all is 'accuraete'. The correct spelling of the word is 'accurate'.

Also, meaning of the given words:

**Message (Noun):** a verbal, written, or recorded communication sent to or left for a recipient who cannot be contacted directly.

**Accurate (Adjective):** (especially of information, measurements, or predictions) correct in all details; exact.

**Expire (Verb):** to (of a document, authorization, or agreement) come to the end of the period of validity.

**Supposed (Verb):** to think or assume that something is true or probable but lack proof or certain knowledge.

Hence, option B is correct.

4. If we look thoroughly, one can find that only 'aik' is wrongly spelled. 'Ache' should have been used in place of it.

Also, meaning of the given words:

**Passenger (Noun):** a traveler on a public or private conveyance other than the driver, pilot, or crew.

**Hygiene (Noun):** conditions or practices conducive to maintaining health and preventing disease, especially through cleanliness.

**Antiseptic (Noun):** an antiseptic compound or preparation.

Hence, option C is correct.

8. 'Antidode' is the incorrect spelling of the word. The correct spelling is 'antidote'.

Also, meaning of the given words:

**Followed (Verb):** to go or come after (a person or thing proceeding ahead); move or travel behind.

**Cue (Noun):** a signal for action.

**Hoping (Verb):** to want something to happen or be the case.

**Antidote (Noun):** a medicine taken or given to counteract a particular poison.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

9. All of the given words are correctly used except 'cost', which is completely out of context as the sentence talks about 'divers' and it can't be a 'cost' here as divers are generally found near 'coast'. It should be '**coast** of the ancient port city of Caesarea'.

Also, meaning of the given words:

**Amateur (Noun):** a person who engages in a pursuit, especially a sport, on an unpaid rather than a professional basis.

**Divers (Noun):** a person who dives as a sport.

**Cost (Adjective):** (of an object or action) require the payment of (a specified sum of money) before it can be acquired or done.

**Coast (Noun):** the part of the land adjoining or near the sea.

**Dating (Verb):** to establish or ascertain the date of (an object or event).

Hence, option C is correct.

10. If we look thoroughly, one can find that 'alone' is out of context as sentence gives information about some 'reports for' and 'pregnant women, and those considering pregnancy' and 'alone' does not fit in any manner as the sentence does not talk about one individual. 'Altogether' should have been used in place of it.

Also, meaning of the given words:

**Nevertheless (Adverb):** in spite of that; notwithstanding; all the same.

**Suggest (Verb):** to put forward for consideration.

**Considering (Adverb):** taking everything into account.

**Alone (Adjective):** having no one else present.

**Altogether (Adverb):** completely; totally.

Option D is hence the correct answer.
