1. The word 'incidentaly' is misspelled here. The correct spelling of the word is 'incidentally'.

Incidentally (Adverb): Introducing a different topic; in point of fact.

Secondly, the word 'settled' is wrong in the context of the sentence. Instead of 'settled', 'debt' should have been used here.

Debt (Noun): A sum of money that is owed or due.

The other two words are spelled and used correctly in the sentence.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

2. Each and every word is correct by all means as there is no fault in any of them.

The sentence is contextually and grammatically correct also, which leads to choose option E.

So, option E is the correct answer.

3. The word 'immediatly' is misspelled here. The correct spelling of the word is 'immediately'.

Immediately (Adverb): Without delay or hesitation; with no time intervening.

Secondly, the word 'subtracting' is wrong in the context of the sentence and does not fit in the sentence. Instead of 'subtracting', 'adding' should have been used here.

Adding (Verb): To put in (an additional element, ingredient, etc.).

The other two words are spelled and used correctly in the sentence by all means.

Evidently, option B is the correct answer.

4. The word 'imitaiton' is the first misspelled word here. The correct spelling of the word is 'imitation'.

Imitation (Noun): Something copied or derived from an original.

Secondly, the word 'cofee' is also misspelled. The correct spelling of the word is 'coffee'.

Coffee (Noun): A hot drink made from the roasted and ground seeds (coffee beans) of a tropical shrub.

The other two words are spelled and used correctly in the sentence.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

5. There is no error in the sentence. It is an error-free sentence.

All words are perfectly spelled and are at the correct places too.

Evidently, option E is the correct answer.

6. The word 'grammer' is the first misspelled word here. The correct spelling of the word is 'grammar'.

Grammar (Noun): the branch of linguistics that deals with syntax and morphology (and sometimes also deals with semantics).

Secondly, the word 'relationship' is also misspelled. The correct spelling of the word is 'relationship'.

Relationship (Noun): The way in which two or more people or things are connected, or the state of being connected.

The other two words are spelled and used correctly in the sentence.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

7. There is no error in the sentence. It is an error-free sentence.

All words are perfectly spelled and are at the correct places too.

Evidently, option E is the correct answer.

8. The word 'gratefull' is misspelled here. The correct spelling of the word is 'grateful'.

Grateful (Adjective): Feeling or showing gratitude.

Secondly, the word 'dumb' is wrong in the context of the sentence and does not fit in the sentence. Instead of 'dumb', 'talented' should have been used here.

Talented (Adjective): Having a natural aptitude or skill for something.

The other two words are spelled and used correctly in the sentence by all means.

Evidently, option B is the correct answer.

9. The word 'garanteeing' is misspelled here. The correct spelling of the word is 'guaranteeing'.

Guaranteeing (Verb): To make certain of.

Secondly, the word 'crash' is wrong in the context of the sentence. Instead of 'crash', 'prosperity' should have been used here.

Prosperity (Noun): The state of being prosperous.

The other two words are spelled and used correctly in the sentence.

Option A is hence the correct answer.
