National & States Affairs

501. On April 26, India entered the 'Guinness Book of World Records' for waving the maximum number of national flags simultaneously. 78,220 tricolors were waved at the 'Veer Kunwar Singh Vijayotsav' programme organised at Bhojpur, Bihar in the presence of Home Minister Amit Shah. The event was held to pay a tribute to the victory of the then King of Jagdishpur, Veer Kunwar Singh. The previous world record was of about 56,000 when Pakistani flags were waved at a function in Lahore in 2004. {Read more}

502. On April 21, NITI Aayog released the draft Battery-swapping Policy, targeted at electric two-wheelers and three-wheelers, to expedite large-scale adoption of EVs. Battery swapping involves exchanging discharged batteries for charged ones. The draft policy recommends prioritising all metropolitan cities with a population greater than 4 million for development of battery-swapping networks under the first phase (1-2) years. {Read more}

504. In April 2022, Commerce Ministry relaxed various norms under the Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG) scheme in order to reduce compliance requirements and facilitate ease of doing business. The changes include - Exporters can file Export Obligation (EO) by June 30 of each year instead of by April 30, but any delay will be subject to a late fee of Rs 5,000. Requests for Export Obligation extension should be made within 6 months of expiry, instead of 90 days. Requests for blockwise Export Obligation extension should be made within 6 months of expiry. However, applications made after 6 months and up to 6 years will entail a late fee of Rs 10,000 per authorisation. Earlier, no specified time limit was prescribed, leading to discretionary interpretations. {Read more}

505. On April 20, PM Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of the Indian Railways' 9000 horse power (HP) electric locomotives in Dahod, Gujarat as part of the 'Make in India' and 'Make for World' initiatives. An investment of more than Rs 20,000 Cr is being done in the project. The project is capable to haul a load of 4500 tonnes of cargo load at a maximum speed of 120 kmph. Indian Railway expects that the first locomotive will turn out from the factory in early 2024. The locomotive will be manufactured with the use of Green Energy and will have a green manufacturing tag. Dahod is the main Railway Station on Delhi-Mumbai Route. Dahod Railway workshop was established in 1926. {Read more}

506. On April 26, The Civil Aviation Ministry and the Himachal Pradesh government signed an MoU for the development of a Greenfield Airport in Nagchala, in the district of Mandi, Himachal Pradesh. The airport is being developed under the ministry's Greenfield Airport Policy. A Joint Venture firm between the state government of Himachal Pradesh and the Airport Authority of India (AAI) has been formed. The expected land requirement for the upcoming airport is around 515 acres and the airport project is estimated to cost around Rs 900 Cr excluding the cost of land. {Read more}

508. On April 21, the United States conducted an Open-air study of Genetically Engineered Mosquitoes with an aim to suppress a wild population of virus-carrying mosquitoes. The aim of the experiment by Oxitec, a United Kingdom-based biotechnology firm, is to reduce the population of wild Aedes aegypti mosquitoes that is a vector for viruses such as chikungunya, dengue, zika and yellow fever. {Read more}

509. On April 23, Argentina announced to launch a campaign in India demanding negotiation with the United Kingdom to settle the territorial dispute over the Falkland Islands (Islas Malvinas). Twitter has been involved in taking an environmentally sustainable approach in running its operations and it is now reaching close to its plans of achieving 100% carbon-neutral power sourcing in all its data centers. {Read more}

511. On April 26, SEBI restructured its Advisory Committee on Market Data that recommends policy measures pertaining to areas like securities market data access and privacy. The panel now has 21 members (earlier 20). The committee is chaired by M S Sahoo. The Panel is responsible for recommending appropriate policy for access to securities market data. In addition, the committee recommends standardization of data definitions; data identification logic (usage of uniform codes for identifying and storing data - raw data and derived data) and data validation techniques (single source of truth, validation). {Read more}

On April 20, two different variants of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile were test-fired successfully from the Indian Navy's frontline guided-missile destroyer INS Delhi and Indian Air Force (IAF)'s frontline fighter jet Sukhoi-30 MKI. On March 5, the Indian Navy successfully test-fired an advanced version of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile from the stealth destroyer INS Chennai in the Indian Ocean. The first test launch of the initial version of BrahMos took place in 2001. The Indian Navy began deploying BrahMos on its frontline warships in 2005. A combination of the names of India's Brahmaputra and Russian Moskva rivers, BrahMos missiles are designed, developed and produced by BrahMos Aerospace, a joint venture company set up by the DRDO & Mashinostroyenia of Russia. {Read more}

520. On April 24, Emmanuel Macron was re-elected as the President of France for five more years in a historic win. This is the first time in two decades that France has chosen a president for a second straight term. He celebrated with his supporters in front of the Eiffel Tower Paris. He won in the second round of the presidential election with 58.55% of the votes, while his rival, far-right presidential candidate, leader of the National Rally party Marine Le Pen got 41.45%. {Read more}

On April 24, Union Jal Shakti ministry appointed Justice Vineet Saran of the Supreme Court and Justice Ponugoti Naveen Rao of the Telangana high court as chairman and member respectively of the Ravi and Beas Water Tribunal. Ravi and Beas Water Tribunal was constituted in 1986 for verification of the quantum of usage of water claimed by Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan. Justice Ashok Bhushan who was functioning as chairman relinquished the post after he was made chairman of the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal in November 2021. {Read more}

Meghalaya was selected among the top 360 projects across the world, out of which, UN selected the top 5 in 18 categories and awards them as Champion Project. Meghalaya has been selected by the UN as one of these Champion Projects. One among these top 5 will be declared the winning project. Meghalaya's e-proposal system is poised to win the winner award also for which the prize ceremony will be held on May 31 in Geneva, Switzerland. {Read more}

This day has been observed by the African government since 2001 but was first marked in 2008. The 60th session of the World Health Assembly converted Africa Malaria Day to World Malaria Day. {Read more}

It exposed around 8.4 million people in the three countries to radiation. On 8 December 2016, the United Nations General Assembly declared 26 April as International Chernobyl Disaster Remembrance Day. The day was first observed in 2017. {Read more}
