51. On April 5, Tata Power Renewables Energy Ltd (TPREL), a wholly owned subsidiary of Tata Power, commissioned a 300-MW Solar Project in Dholera in Gujarat. The project will generate 774 million units of power annually. The single-axis solar tracker systems track the sun from east to west while rotating on a single point. With the addition of 300 MW, the renewables capacity for Tata Power will now be 3,400 MW with 2,468 MW of solar and 932 MW of wind. {Read more} Key Points:

The ministry also clarified that the ownership of assets available with all film units will remain with the Government of India and the 'Films Division' brand will continue under the NFDC. With this, the Promotional Vertical of the NFDC will take over the task of organising film festivals from the Directorate of Film Festivals (DFF), and the film preservation work done by the National Film Archives of India (NFAI). Moreover, Children's Film Society of India is also included in the NFDC. A budgetary allocation of Rs 1304.52 Cr is set aside for implementing all planned activities until 2026. {Read more}

66. Four public sector lenders, State Bank of India, Canara Bank, Punjab National Bank and Union Bank of India have reduced their stake in India Debt Resolution Company Ltd (IDRCL) to 5% each. The 'Bad bank' or the National Asset Reconstruction Company Ltd (NARCL) will acquire bad loans from banks to help clean up their books, while the IDRCL will handle the debt resolution process of these loans. With the current round of preferential allotment by IDRCL, equity stake of Canara Bank is reduced to 5% from previous holding of 14.90%. While the stakes of PNB, UBI & SBI came down to 5% from 11.8%, 12.30% & 12.30%. Public sector banks (PSBs) will hold 51% stake in NARCL and 49% in the debt management company IDRCL. {Read more}

Total exports during last fiscal year increased to a record high of \$417.81 billion, imports too soared to \$610.22 billion, leaving a trade gap of \$192.41 billion. The trade deficit in March 2022 was \$18.69 billion. {Read more}
