301. On April 15, Ministry of Roads, Transport and Highways (MoRTH) developed a portal named "e-DAR" (e-Detailed Accident Report). The web portal will be linked to the Integrated Road Accident Database (iRAD). The portal will provide instant information on road accidents with a few clicks and help accelerate accident compensation claims, bringing relief to victims' families. {Read more}

The flight will be operational from Dibrugarh in the state of Assam to Pasighat in Arunachal Pradesh and then to Lilabari in Assam. The Ministry of Civil Aviation (MCA) has approved a budgetary support of Rs 500 Cr for enhancing Air Connectivity as well as Aviation Infrastructure in the Northeastern region till March 2024. {Read more}

The MTS project is envisaged to maintain the continuity of the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) like nutrition supply, immunisation and health check-up etc. The state government's Women and Child Development (WCD) department had launched it as a pilot project in November, 2021 in 6 districts. {Read more}

307. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in collaboration with States & UTs celebrated the 4th Anniversary of Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav from April 16-22, 2022. During the celebration, Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya released a quarterly report on AB-HWCs. The central government has provided more than 2.48 Cr tele-consultation services through 1.17 lakh Ayushman Bharat Health Wellness Centres (AB-HWC) across India in last 4 years. "E-Sanjeevani" is providing affordable and accessible health care to the people across India. The Centre is committed to commissioning a total of 1,50,000 AB-HWCs by the end of this year across the country. The first AB-HWC in Jangla, Chhattisgarh was started in 2018. 'e-Sanjeevani' platform is developed by Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC). {Read more}

308. The University Grants Commission (UGC) announced that students will now be able to pursue two full-time academic programmes in physical mode simultaneously. The commission has put together a set of guidelines regarding the same on its website. Students can either choose a combination of a diploma programme and an undergraduate (UG) degree, two master's programmes, or two bachelor's programmes. The rationale behind the decision to allow students to pursue two academic degrees simultaneously is to help them gain diverse skills, according to the UGC. The UGC is a statutory body set up by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education and it is governed by UGC Act 1956. {Read more}

The induction of these indigenously developed Systems by TASL and Bharat Forge would greatly enhance the operational capabilities of Indian Army in future conflicts. {Read more}

'Neptune' (also known as 'RK-360MT') is Ukrainian anti-ship cruise missile capable of destroying targets within a range of 300 km. Its design is based on the 'Soviet Kh-35' anti-ship missile. {Read more}
