351. For the first time in India, a Seaweed Park will be set up in Tamil Nadu to improve the livelihood of fishermen. The project to raise quality fish fry in the sea would be implemented under the "Prime Minister's Matsya Sampada Yojana". Rs. 20,000 Cr is to be invested in Tamil Nadu for fisheries projects. {Read more} **Key Points:**

352. On April 12, India's first Persian newspaper Mirat-ul-Akhbar completed 200 years. Mirat-ul-Akhbar began publication from colonial Calcutta on April 12, 1822 and was the first first printed journal in the Persian world. The weekly journal, published on Fridays, was founded and edited by Raja Ram Mohan Roy, a polymath, scholar and reformer. {Read more} Key Points:

353. On April 15, Bihar government sent a fresh proposal to the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) to get "Cyclopean Wall" listed in the UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is a more than 2,500 years old structure at Rajgir. The Cyclopean Wall of Rajgir is a 40 km long wall of stone which encircled the ancient city of Rajgir to protect it from external enemies and invaders, built before 3rd century BC. Bihar is the home to two UNESCO World Heritage Sites - Nalanda University & Mahabodhi temple. {Read more}

354. On April 13, International Institute of Information Technology Hyderabad (IIITH) hosted its first national symposium under the "Quantum Enabled Science & Technology (QuEST)" program initiated by Department of Science & Technology (DST) from April 11-13, 2022. The Symposium was conducted by the national coordinator of QuEST, Professor Arun K Pati and Prof Apoorva Patel who is also the co-ordinator of QuEST. The same was hosted by IIITH's Centre for Quantum Science and Technology (CQST). {Read more}

355. On April 13, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj department of Jammu & Kashmir administration launched a mobile app called "Jan Nigrani" to help people lodge complaints related to various schemes online. The app is an internet based solution for reporting and resolving grievances by the residents of the Jammu and Kashmir against various schemes of the department. {Read more}

356. On April 18, Telangana government launched a State-specific "Space Tech Framework", with the aim of establishing the State as a globally recognised one-stop destination for space technology. The event is India's first-ever official event hosted on Metaverse. Hyderabad-based technology company Gamitronics has created a blockchain technology led metaverse platform PartyNite where the government's space-tech policy was introduced at a SpaceShip walk through event. {Read more}

Hunar Haat is a credible platform to promote 'Swadeshi' products. The minister also highlighted 'Tejas', a skilling programme which is launched by Government of India. Under this initiative, India will send skilled manpower to UAE. Within a year, 30,000 skilled job-seekers will be sent to UAE. {Read more}

It will help the visually-impaired gain seamless access to education resources and audiobooks. {Read more}

On April 20, California-based Biliti Electric Inc (Biliti) announced to setup the world's largest electric three-wheeler factory in Telangana, with a production capacity of 2,40,000 electric vehicles each year. The new plant is estimated to drive private investment of \$150 million and expected to create over 3,000 jobs in the State. Biliti currently operates through an exclusive manufacturing partnership with Hyderabad-based Gayam Motor Works (GMW) for manufacturing its three-wheelers. {Read more}

On April 14, International Monetary Fund (IMF) approved the creation of a new facility named "Resilience and Sustainability Trust" to help low-income and most middle-income countries deal with longer-term challenges such as climate change and pandemics. It would take effect from May 1 with a goal of raising at least \$45 billion. {Read more} Key Points:

366. On April 15, the 121 Finance became India's first fintech-led NBFC-Factor to receive the Certificate of Registration from the RBI under "Registration of Factors (Reserve Bank) Regulations, 2022". Until now, Factoring was offered only to the large corporates; however, 121 Finance has brought factoring to the MSMEs and has its roots ground deep in FinTech. {Read more}

367. On April 18, State Bank of India (SBI) raised 3-year funds worth \$500 million through a syndicated loan facility. The facility is for \$400 million-plus \$100 million as a greenshoe option. It is the first offshore USD Secured Overnight Financing Rate (SOFR)-linked syndicated loan by SBI through its Gift City Branch. SBI Gift City Branch has become the largest branch in IFSC. MUFG, Bank of America, and JP Morgan were the joint lenders for this offering whereas First Abu Dhabi Bank acted as facility agent. {Read more}

Defence Affairs

368. On April 20, Defence Secretary Ajay Kumar launched INS Vagsheer, the sixth Scorpene-class submarine under 'Project-75', at Mazagon Dock in Mumbai. Vagsheer is named after the sand fish, a deadly deep-sea predator of the Indian Ocean. The Mazagon Dock has so far delivered four Scorpene-class submarines under the project to the Indian Navy - INS Kalvari, INS Khanderi, INS Karanj and INS Vela. The fifth submarine 'Vagir' is currently under trial at sea. {Read more}

369. On April 18, National Security Advisor Ajit Doval inaugurated the National Cyber Security Incident Response Exercise. National Cyber Exercise (NCX) India will be conducted as a hybrid exercise over a period of ten days from 18 to 29 April 2022 with the aim to train senior management and technical personnel of Government. The program is being conducted by the National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS) in association with Data Security Council of India (DSCI) as the Knowledge Partner and supported by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO). The platform for training is being provided by CyberExer Technologies, an Estonian cybersecurity company accredited for globally conducting several large cyber exercises. Government of India is taking various steps to build capacities and enhance skills in Cyber Security. {Read more}

370. On April 18, Stefanos Tsitsipas won the men's singles title at the "Monte Carlo Masters 2022" beating Alejandro Davidovich Fokina. With this, Stefanos Tsitsipas became the first repeat champion at Monte Carlo Masters since Spaniard Rafael Nadal in 2018. {Read more}

371. On April 18, 15-year old Young Indian Grandmaster from Chennai, D. Gukesh emerged victorious in the 48th La Roda International Open Chess tournament. He defeated Israel's Victor Mikhalevski in the final round. Gukesh's compatriot - R. Praggnanandhaa, another teenage GM, took the third spot. {Read more} **Key Points:**

372. On April 16, Top Indian swimmer Sajan Prakash from Kerala won the men's 200m butterfly gold at the Danish Open swimming meet in Copenhagen, Denmark. He stopped the clock at 1.59.27 to stand atop the podium. Last year in Rome, Prakash become the first Indian swimmer to breach the Olympic 'A' standard time. Teenager Vedaant Madhavan, son of Indian actor R. Madhavan, won the silver medal in the men's 1500m freestyle event. Shakthi Balakrishnan finished second in the 'B' Final and eight overall in the women's 400m medley. {Read more}

373. On April 18, a classified satellite for the U.S. National Reconnaissance Office named "NROL-85" was launched into space from California. The satellite lifted off from Vandenberg Space Force Base aboard a two-stage 'SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket'. It was the first mission by the NRO to reuse a SpaceX rocket booster. {Read more} **Key Points:**

374. On April 18, China successfully launched a new satellite named "Zhongxing-6D" into space from the Xichang Satellite Launch Center in southwest China's Sichuan Province by a Long March-3B carrier rocket. This launch marked the 415th mission for the Long March series carrier rockets. {Read more} **Key Points:**

376. On April 17, the Appointment Committee of the Cabinet has granted an extension of one year to Atomic Energy Commission Chairman Kamlesh Nilkanth Vyas. This is the second extension for Vyas, who was first appointed to the post in September 2018. {Read more}

He was initially appointed as prime minister in March 2021. Yamoussoukro & CFA franc are the capital & currency of the country, respectively. {Read more} Key Points:

Naresh replaced his batchmate Vijay Kumar Dev who retired from the post on April 20. Vijay Kumar Dev took charge as the State Election Commissioner of Delhi on April 21. Dharmendra, a 1989-batch IAS, is appointed as the Chief Secretary of Arunachal Pradesh, in the place of Naresh. {Read more} **Key Points:**

Hemophilia or Haemophilia is an inherited genetic disorder in which the blood's capacity to clot is substantially impaired, causing one to bleed excessively even from minor injuries. In 2022, the theme is "Access for All: Partnership. Policy. Progress. Engaging your government, integrating inherited bleeding disorders into national policy". The World Federation of Hemophilia (WFH) was established in 1963 to enhance treatment and care for all hemophilia patients. The WFH began observing World Hemophilia Day in 1989. It chose 17 April as the date to honour the WFH founder Frank Schnabel's birthday. {Read more}
