The 'Indo-Nepal Remittance Facility Scheme' was launched by RBI in May 2008 as an option for cross-border remittances from India to Nepal. Moreover, the RBI also reviewed the 'Currency Distribution & Exchange Scheme' (CDES) and hiked the incentives being paid to the banks for distribution of coins to the General Public to Rs 65/bag from Rs 25/bag and additional incentive of Rs 10 per bag for coin distribution in rural and semi-urban areas. {Read more}

727. On August 27, The Reserve Bank of India has issued "Master Directions on Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs) 2021" with fresh classification of the instruments. The master directions classify PPIs in two categories - Small PPIs and Full KYC PPIs. They were earlier classified as Closed Systems PPIs, Semi-Closed Systems PPIs and Open System PPIs. Small PPIs can have cash up to ₹10,000 loaded per month, not exceeding ₹1.2 lakh in a year. While the outstanding amount for Full-KYC PPIs should not be exceeding Rs 2 lakh at any point of time. Small PPIs should be converted into full-KYC PPIs within 24 months from the date of issue of the PPI. {Read more}
