On August 24, Union Minister of Information & Broadcasting Anurag Thakur launched "Azadi Quest", a series of online educational games based on India's freedom struggle, developed in collaboration with Zynga India. The information for these games was curated by the Indian Council of Historical Research's Publications Division. The move was part of efforts being made by the government to acknowledge the contributions of freedom fighters and 'unsung' heroes. The "Azadi Quest" games would also bolster the capabilities of the Animation, Visual Effects, Gaming and Comic (AVGC) sector in India. {Read more}

517. On August 27, Germany launched the world's first fleet of Hydrogen-powered Passenger Trains in the state of Lower Saxony. According to reports, 14 trains with hydrogen fuel cell drive - produced by French manufacturer Alstom - are to replace diesel trains. The total cost of the project is around \$92 million. These trains will save 1.6 million litres of diesel fuel a year. {Read more}

It is a regional strategy to address severe Non-communicable Diseases at first-level referral health facilities. Health ministers of African countries endorsed the plan at the 72nd session of the World Health Organization (WHO) Regional Committee for Africa in Lome, Togo to reduce premature mortality from NCDs. NCDs include heart diseases, cancers, diabetes, asthma among others. Globally, NCDs are the main cause of morbidity and mortality. They account for 71% of global mortality, according to WHO. {Read more}

Developed by DRDO, the rockets are produced by private sector firm. The Guided Extended Range Rocket Ammunition has a range of 75 km with an accuracy of 40 meters. This year in April, the DRDO and the Indian Army had successfully test fired Pinaka MK-1 (Enhanced) Rocket System and Pinaka Area Denial Munition (ADM) rocket systems from the same Pokhran Firing Ranges. {Read more}

527. In August 2022, Chief of Royal Navy of Malaysia Admiral Tan Sri Mohd Reza Bin Mohd Sany was on a four-day visit to India. Indian Navy Chief Admiral R. Hari Kumar and his visiting Malaysian counterpart Admiral Tan Sri Mohd Reza Bin Mohd Sany agreed to uphold the principle of collective responsibility for maritime security in the Indian Ocean Region. Both navies had carried out the bilateral exercise "Samudra Laksamana" in May 2022. {Read more}

He traversed through Africa and the Gulf region to India, China, South Korea and Japan as well as the northern Pacific. Rutherford has now officially broken 2 Guinness World records - Youngest person to fly around the world solo & Youngest person to fly around the world solo in an Ultra Light aircraft. {Read more}

529. On August 25, Chinese search engine giant Baidu Inc revealed its first quantum computer namely "Qianshi" and is ready to make it available to external users. The Baidu-developed quantum computer has a 10-quantum-bit (qubit) processor. The Beijing-based company has also developed a 36-qubit quantum chip. According to market researcher IDC, Global governments and companies will invest around \$16.4 billion in quantum development by the end of 2027. Moreover, U.S. tech giant IBM plans to make a quantum computer ready for commercial use in 2025 with a more-than-4,000 qubit processor. IBM has so far released quantum processors with 127 qubits. Google is also aiming to develop a computer with 10,00,000 qubits by the end of this decade. {Read more}
