It will also have the world's biggest dome. Once completed, it will be larger than the Taj Mahal and St. Paul's Cathedral in the Vatican. The Temple of Vedic Planetarium is ISKCON founder Srila Prabhupada's vision and is apparently inspired by the design of the Capitol building in the United States. The head of this massive undertaking is Alfred Ford (Ambarish Das), the great-grandson of renowned businessman Henry Ford. The temple's construction began in 2010, and it is expected to cost \$100 million. {Read more}

557. On August 26, Justice Uday Umesh Lalit, the 49th Chief Justice of India, assured that the Supreme Court will have to have at least one Constitution Bench functioning throughout the year. Justice Lalit's initiative comes at a time when the Supreme Court's pendency has crossed over 71,000 from a little over 55,000 in 2017. This is despite the fact that the sanctioned judicial strength of the court was increased to 34 judges in August 2019. Moreover, the Constitution Bench of the Supreme Court must have at least 5 judges. {Read more}

As part of the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, the 'Khadi Utsav' was organised to pay tribute to khadi and its importance during the freedom struggle. Around 7,500 women khadi artisans from various districts of Gujarat participated in this 'Utsav' or 'Festival'. In Bhuj town of Kutch district of Gujarat, the PM inaugurated a "Smriti Van" that celebrates the spirit of resilience shown by people following the 2001 earthquake in Gujarat. He also inaugurated the Kachchh Branch Canal of Sardar Sarovar Project. {Read more}

With the destruction of their natural habitat and historical hunting, no Dugong has been sighted in China since 2008. This is the first functional extinction of a large mammal in China's coastal waters. Part of Sirenia family, Dugong, weighs half a tonne, and is the only vegetarian marine mammal. The marine mammal has been declared 'Vulnerable' by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN). The marine mammals have a life expectancy of around 70 years. {Read more}
