On August 7, Billionaire Rakesh Jhunjhunwala's Akasa Air made its debut flight operating from Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport to Ahmedabad's Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport. The flight of India's newest airline was inaugurated by Union Minister for Civil Aviation Jyotiraditya M. Scindia. The airline code of Akasa Air is QP. Vinay Dube is the current CEO of Akasa Air. 54. On August 5, a Himalayan Spice Garden, the first of its kind in the entire Himalayan region & India, was inaugurated at Soni in Ranikhet by noted historian Shekhar Pathak. The garden has been developed by the research wing of the Uttarakhand Forest Department with funding from the Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA) in 2 years. It presently houses more than 30 different spices out of which there are 8 spices from the Allium family (onion) of the Himalayan region. Shekhar Pathak's recent books include "The Chipko Movement: A People's History" based on his Hindi book "Hari Bhari Ummeed". The Indian Himalayan Region is spread across 13 Indian States/Union Territories (namely Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, Assam and West Bengal), stretching across 2500 km. Through this mass movement or ‘Jan Bhagidari’ initiative, the Ministry of Culture also intended to amplify and support the ‘Har Ghar Tiranga’ movement. 56. On August 5, the Indian government has set the target to eliminate Kala-azar from the country by 2023. In a written reply in Lok Sabha, Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare Dr. Bharati Pravin Pawar said, out of 633 Kala-azar endemic blocks, 625 blocks have achieved the elimination target in 2021. The “World Health Organisation (WHO) Neglected Tropical Diseases Road Map” has the target set for Kala-azar elimination by 2030. [{Read more}](#)

On August 5, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution (MoCAFPD) launched a common registration facility called “My Ration-My Right” in 11 states & UTs on pilot basis to enable homeless people, destitutes, migrants and other eligible beneficiaries to apply for ration cards. The ‘National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA)’ provides a maximum coverage for about 81.35 Crore persons. At present, around 79.77 Crore persons are given highly subsidised foodgrains under the Act. By the end of August, all 36 States and UTs are expected to be covered on the platform. [{Read more}](#)

58. Russia became India’s 3rd largest coal supplier in July, with imports rising by over a fifth compared with June to a record 2.06 million tonnes, according to data from Indian consultancy CoalMint. Russia has historically been the 6th largest supplier of coal to India. Indonesia was the top supplier, while South Africa was marginally ahead of Russia. Overall Indian coal imports were 23.8 million tonnes in July. [{Read more}](#)

On August 5, Housing Development Finance Corporation (HDFC) Limited announced the completion of the USD 1.1 billion Syndicated Social Loan Facility for the financing of affordable housing in India. The loan has been priced competitively at a margin of 90 bps over SOFR (Secured Overnight Financing Rate). This transaction marks several meaningful milestones, including India's largest social financing issuance, the largest social loan globally, the first social ECB loan out of India and the largest ECB loan deal from a Housing Finance Company/private NBFC in India. 60. On August 4, the IRDAI allowed insurers to buy more perpetual bonds issued by banks and permitted them to participate in the public listing of high-yielding InvITs (Investment Trusts), enhancing the capital sources for such instruments. According to the IRDAI, the aggregate value of AT1 (additional tier one) bonds held in a particular bank, at any point of time, shall not exceed 10% of the total outstanding AT1 bonds of that particular bank. An insurer could immediately invest up to Rs 100 Cr of a Rs 1,000-Cr AT1 bond sale by a bank. Moreover, the IRDAI also specified that the public holding in the InvITs/REITs shall not be less than 30% of total outstanding units of the InvIT/REIT at the time of investment. Moreover, No insurer will invest more than 20% of the outstanding debt instruments in a single InvIT/REIT. [{Read more}](#)

On August 5, the SEBI granted in-principle approval for change in control of HDFC Asset Management Company along with change in one of the co-sponsors of HDFC Mutual Fund from HDFC Ltd to HDFC Bank. The change in control will happen following the merger of HDFC and HDFC Bank. HDFC AMC is the investment manager to the schemes of HDFC Mutual Fund. Currently, HDFC and Abrdn Investment Management Ltd (erstwhile Standard Life Investments Ltd) are the sponsors of the fund house. [{Read more}](#)

62. On August 5, the Reserve Bank of India announced renewed rate hikes in its 3rd Monetary Policy committee review. The repo rate was hiked by 50 bps to 5.40%. The RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das announced that the FY23 GDP growth forecast has been retained at 7.2%. The Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate or Bank Rate is 5.15%. The Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) and the Statutory Liquidity Ratio (SLR) are kept at 4.50% & 18% respectively. While Reverse Repo Rate is kept at 3.35%.

On August 8, India and the US commenced the 13th edition of the Indo-US Joint Special Forces military exercise named “Ex Vajra Prahar 2022” in Himachal Pradesh’s Bakloh to improve interoperability between the Special Forces of both nations. This annual exercise is hosted alternatively between India and the United States. The 12th edition was conducted at Joint Base Lewis Mcchord, Washington (USA) in October 2021. [{Read more}](#)

66. On August 4, five women officers of the Indian Navy created history by completing the first all-women independent 'Maritime Reconnaissance & Surveillance Mission' in the Arabian Sea, onboard a 'Dornier-228' aircraft. The aircraft was captained by the Mission Commander, Lt. Cdr. Aanchal Sharma. They are part of the Indian Naval Air Squadron 'INAS-314', based at Naval Air Enclave, Porbandar, Gujarat. This first-of-its-kind military flying mission was unique and is expected to pave the way for women officers in the Aviation sector. [{Read more}](#)

This exercise is aimed at enhancing understanding, cooperation and interoperability between the armies of India and the US. The last edition was held in Alaska, the US in October 2021. The US designated India a "Major Defence Partner" in 2016. [{Read more}](#)

On August 4, indigenously developed Laser-Guided Anti-Tank Guided Missiles (ATGM) were successfully test-fired from Main Battle Tank (MBT) 'Arjun Mark 1A' by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Army at KK Ranges with support of Armoured Corps Centre & School (ACC&S) Ahmednagar in Maharashtra. The all-indigenous Laser Guided ATGM employs a tandem High Explosive Anti-Tank (HEAT) warhead to defeat Explosive Reactive Armour (ERA) protected armoured vehicles. [{Read more}](#)

69. In August 2022, Indian Army carried out "Exercise Skylight", validating and showcasing the resilience of its communication capabilities in case terrestrial connectivity. During the two-week long exercise, all satellite communication assets in the Army were activated and various technical and operational scenarios in space domain were simulated. The ISRO also participated in the exercise. Moreover, to train its personnel on all aspects of satellite communication, the Army recently published Request for Information for its own student satellite, for training engineering students in Military College of Telecommunication Engineering on satellite technology. 

On August 4, the Indian women's team, comprising Rupa Rani Tirkey, Lovely Choubey, Pinki Singh and Nayanmoni Saikia, secured a historic first-ever Gold in 'Lawn Bowls Women's Fours' at the "Commonwealth Games 2022". Rupa Rani Tirkey-led team defeated South Africa. Rupa Rani Tirkey is a former kabaddi player. Pinki Singh is a former Cricketer. Nayanmoni Saikia was a National-level Weightlifter in the early 2000s. Lovely Choubey, 42, is the senior-most player in the team. She was a long jumper in her early days. [{Read more}](#)

Science & Technology

72. On August 5, South Korea became the 7th country in the world to launch a mission to the Moon as it launched its Korea Pathfinder Lunar Orbiter, nicknamed "Danuri" aboard 'SpaceX Falcon-9'. The aircraft lifted off from the Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida, US. This is the first lunar mission by South Korea, which recently developed a space rocket launch capability. The lunar mission has been jointly developed by NASA and the Korea Aerospace Research Institute (KARI). [{Read more}](#)

The satellites were launched by a 'Long March-4B' carrier rocket and entered the planned orbit successfully. This launch marked the 430th mission for the Long March series carrier rockets. 74. On August 7, the ISRO launched the “AzaadiSAT” made by 750 school girls from 75 schools across India to unfurl Tricolour in space during India’s 75th year of Independence celebrations. The announcement for the same was made by PM Narendra Modi on August 15, 2018. The ISRO’s SSLV (Small Satellite Launch Vehicle), along with a co-passenger satellite “AzaadiSAT”, was launched for its first ever spaceflight from the Sriharikota base. This also makes it ISRO’s smallest rocket launch. [{Read more}](#)

75. On August 7, the Central Government plans to use satellite technology for the implementation of 110 projects in the ecologically sensitive Northeastern region by 2024. Shillong-based North Eastern Space Applications Centre (NESAC) will execute the projects in 8 North Eastern States. The projects were identified in the domains of agriculture, water resources, forestry and ecology, planning and development, UAV remote sensing and disaster management support. Set up in 2000, the NESAC is an autonomous institution under the Department of Space to provide space technology inputs and services for the development of the North Eastern region. [{Read more}](#)
