201. On August 14, Union Minister Jitendra Singh launched India's first saline water lantern named "Roshini", which uses sea water to power the LED lamps, during a visit to SAGAR ANVESHIKA, a coastal research vessel operated and used by the National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT), Chennai. {Read more} Key Points:

202. Chandigarh University along with the NID Foundation created a Guinness World Record for the 'Largest Human Image of a Waving National Flag', as part of celebrations of 75 years of India's Independence on August 15. The record was accomplished with the participation of 5,885 persons. With the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign, the government aimed to have at least 20 Crore flags unfurled atop houses from August 13 to August 15. {Read more} **Key Points:**

203. NIPAM, a flagship program to impart IP awareness and basic training, was launched on 8 December, 2021 as a part of "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" celebrations. In 2019-20, the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution launched a centrally sponsored scheme "Fortification of Rice" for a period of 3 years with a total budget outlay of Rs 174.64 Crore. {Read more}

It is the first not only in India but across the world to gain the coveted place in the 'India Book of Records' as the Green Railway Station. The biennial (once every two years) event in the seafood sector will provide an ideal platform for interaction between Indian exporters and overseas importers of India's marine products. 208. On August 13, Asia's largest Compressed Biogas (CBG) plant in Sangrur district of Punjab started commercial production. The plant with a total capacity of 33.23 tonne CBG per day was commissioned at village Bhuttal Kalan (Sangrur) in April, 2022. Besides, PEDA (Punjab Energy Development Agency) also allocated 42 additional CBG projects of total capacity 492.58 Tonnes Per Day (TPD) based on paddy straw and other agro-residue to develop a lasting and sustainable solution to prevent stubble burning while also strengthening the rural economy. Two more plants of total capacity 14.25 tonnes CBG per day are likely to be completed in 2022-23. {Read more}

On August 14, Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav announced that India has added 11 more wetlands to the list of Ramsar sites, that are of international importance, bringing the country's total tally to 75 from 64. Of the 11 new sites, 4 are in Tamil Nadu (Chitrangudi Bird Sanctuary, Suchindram Theroor Wetland Complex, Vaduvur Bird Sanctuary, Kanjirankulam Bird Sanctuary), 3 in Odisha (Tampara Lake, Hirakud Reservoir, Ansupa Lake), 2 Jammu & Kashmir (Hygam Wetland Conservation Reserve, Shallbugh Wetland Conservation Reserve), and one each in Madhya Pradesh (Yashwant Sagar) and Maharashtra (Thane Creek). Currently, Tamil Nadu has the maximum number of Ramsar sites in India at 14. India in 1982 became a signatory to the 1971 Ramsar Convention. {Read more}

On August 12, China agreed to finance a feasibility study for a cross-border railway with Nepal under the "Trans-Himalayan Multi-dimensional Connectivity Network", part of the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) of China. China will send experts to conduct surveys for the railway this year. Moreover, China also pledged \$118 million for China-assisted projects in Nepal. {Read more}

214. As per the new notification from Ministry of Finance, Income tax payers will not be allowed to enroll in the government's social security scheme "Atal Pension Yojana (APY)" from October 1, 2022. The government introduced APY on June 1, 2015, to provide social security to workers mainly in the Unorganised Sector. Subscribers of the scheme (between the age group of 18-40 years) get a minimum guaranteed pension of Rs 1,000 to Rs 5,000 per month after attaining 60 years of age depending on their contributions. The new notification will not apply to subscribers who have joined or joins the scheme before October 1, 2022. Under the income tax law, people having taxable income of up to Rs 2.5 lakh are not required to pay income tax. More than 99 lakh APY accounts were opened during the last fiscal, taking the total number of subscribers to 4.01 Cr at the end of March 2022. {Read more} Key Points:

India's Consumer Price Index (CPI)-based retail inflation, measured through the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) data released by the NSO, moderated to 6.71% in the month of July 2022, from 7.01% in June 2022. Still July's CPI inflation above the RBI's medium-term target of 4% for the 34th consecutive month and also above the RBI's tolerance range of 2-6% for the 7th consecutive month. Food inflation showed a month-on-month fall during July to 6.75%, from 7.75% in June. {Read more} Key Points:

On Utsav Fixed Deposit Scheme, SBI is offering an interest rate of 6.10% per annum on fixed deposits with a tenure of 1000 days. 217. On August 16, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh handed over several new defence systems, including the F-INSAS, the Nipun mines, the Landing Craft Assault (LCA), to the Indian Army. F-INSAS stands for "Future Infantry Soldier As A System". The full-gear of the F-INSAS system includes an AK-203 assault rifle. The DRDO had conceptualised the F-INSAS in line with the targets of the Army's Infantry Soldier Modernisation Programme. Nipun mines are indigenously designed and developed anti-personnel mines, termed by the DRDO as 'soft target blast munition'. They have been developed with the efforts of Armament Research and Development Establishment (ARDE), a Pune-based DRDO facility. The Landing Craft Assault (LCA) has been indigenously developed by Goa-based Aquarius ShipYard Limited. The LCA is meant to serve as a replacement for the boats with limited capabilities currently in use in the Pangong Tso Lake. {Read more} **Key Points:**

219. On August 11, Real Madrid defeated Eintracht Frankfurt to clinch the "Union of European Football Associations (UEFA) Super Cup" for a record-equaling fifth time in Helsinki, Finland. Real Madrid's Coach Carlo Ancelotti also became the first coach to lift the trophy four times. {Read more}

220. The oldest football tournament in Asia, Durand Cup, started from August 16, 2022. The tournament was inaugurated by West Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee. The opening match was played between FC Goa and Mohammedan SC at the Vivekananda Yuba Bharati Krirangan in Kolkata. For the first time in its history, the tournament was held in multiple cities this year i.e. West Bengal, Assam and Manipur. This year the tournament is into its 131st edition which featured 20 teams. The teams were divided into 4 groups of 5 teams each. Indian Oil is the title sponsor of the tournament. Durand Cup is one of the three major football tournaments in India, the other two being Indian Super League and Super Cup. The previous edition of Durand Cup 2021 was won by FC Goa. {Read more}

In the 2nd edition, about 4,000 participants from 8 North Eastern States will be competing in 18 disciplines at 13 venues spread across Shillong. {Read more} **Key Points:**

222. In August 2022, India's Pooja Ojha won Silver medal in the VL1 Women's 200m final at the "2022 ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships" in Halifax, Canada. This is the first ever medal for India in the World Championships of Para-Canoe. The para-canoe athlete from Madhya Pradesh's Bhind, finished second with the timing of 1:34.18. Hamburg's Lillemor Koper won the gold medal with a timing of 1:29.79. Pooja is currently ranked 9th among the world's top para canoe players. {Read more}

225. On August 15, Chennai-based Space Kidz India unfurled the Indian flag about 30 kilometres above the Earth. The event was part of the 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' slogan and under the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign launched by PM Narendra Modi to celebrate the historic anniversary. The flag was sent to an altitude of 1,06,000 feet above the planet on a balloon that unfurled it. Space Kidz India also coordinated and launched 'AzadiSAT' into Low Earth Orbit. AzadiSAT was developed by 750 girl students from across India to mark the 75 years of Independence. {Read more}

226. On August 13, a team of researchers discovered a new copepod species, a planktonic crustacean namely 'Tortanus dhritiae', from the coast of Great Nicobar, part of the Andaman-Nicobar archipelago in the Bay of Bengal. It was named after Dr. Dhriti Banerjee, the first woman Director of the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI). Tortanus dhritiae is mainly found on coral islands in the Pacific Ocean. The discovery was published in the international taxonomy journal 'Nauplius'. {Read more}

227. On August 10, IIT Guwahati announced to partner with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to develop solutions to problems of accessing water, electricity and internet for the AICTE-affiliated technical institutions in North-East India. IIT Guwahati and AICTE will work towards capacity-building in these institutions to promote research and development and prioritise in enhancing quality of education in remote regions of North-East India. **(Read more) Key Points:**

- IIT Guwahati + AICTE = partnered to develop solutions to problems of accessing Water, Electricity & Internet
- The partnership is for AICTE-affiliated technical institutions in North-East India

228. In a first, an indigenously developed howitzer gun, 'ATAG', became part of the 21-gun salute that was given to the tricolour during the 'Independence Day 2022' ceremony at the Red Fort. Developed by the DRDO with its Pune-based facility Armament Research & Development Establishment (ARDE), the Advanced Towed Artillery Gun System (ATAGS) was used alongside the traditional British-origin '25 Pounders' artillery guns. 'Howitzers' is an umbrella term for a category of Long-Range Artillery Guns. The ATAGS project was started in 2013 by DRDO to replace older guns in service in the Indian Army with a modern 155 mm artillery gun. {Read more}

- Advanced Towed Artillery Gun System (ATAGS), for the first time, became part of the 21-gun salute during the 'Independence Day 2022' ceremony
