

251. On August 16, Kerala government launched the "Lucky Bill" App to encourage consumers to upload invoices in a bid to curb tax evasion. The mobile application is designed by Digital University Kerala (DUK) & developed by the State GST department. The initiative is the first-of-its-kind to be introduced in India. Prizes worth Rs 5 Cr would be offered annually for the winners selected among buyers who upload their bills. {Read more}

Each of these clinics will have four staff members, including an MBBS doctor and a laboratory technician. {Read more}

255. On August 17, a first-of-its kind database of arrested narcotics offenders called, "NIDAAN" portal, has been made operational for use by various central and state prosecution agencies tasked to enforce anti-drugs laws in India. The portal "NIDAAN" (National Integrated Database on Arrested Narco-offenders) has been developed by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB). The NIDAAN platform sources its data from the ICJS (inter-operable criminal justice system) and the e-Prisons (a cloud-based application) repository. It is part of the narcotics coordination mechanism (NCORD) portal that was launched by Union Home Minister Amit Shah on July 30 in Chandigarh during the national conference on 'Drug trafficking and national security'. {Read more}

On August 16, Uttar Pradesh cabinet approved the "Uttar Pradesh Defence and Aerospace Unit and Employment Promotion Policy-2022", making the existing one more flexible and lucrative, providing higher incentives to investors setting up their units in the defence and aerospace manufacturing sector in the state. The cabinet decided to amend the policy (initially formulated in 2018) to provide incentives up to a maximum of Rs 500 Cr (against the existing Rs 15 Cr) to attract large investments. {Read more}

257. On August 15, Border Road Organization (BRO) announced to build its first steel slag road in Arunachal Pradesh, which can withstand heavy rains and adverse climatic conditions. The project is initiated after India's first success of using 100% steel slag on Hazira Port connectivity road in Surat, Gujarat which has longer life and was built at low cost. India is the world's second largest steel producing country after China and annually around 195 lakh tonnes of steel slag is generated in India and this quantity is slated to increase to 600 lakh tonne by 2030. {Read more}

260. On August 17, the Cabinet approved the widening access of the Traditional Knowledge Digital Library (TKDL) database to users, besides patent offices. This will be a new dawn for Indian traditional knowledge, as the TKDL will drive research & development, and innovation based on India's valued heritage across diverse fields. The TKDL is a prior art database of Indian traditional knowledge established in 2001, jointly by the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) and Department of Indian Systems of Medicine & Homeopathy. Until now, access to the complete TKDL database is restricted to 14 Patent Offices worldwide for the purposes of search and examination. {Read more}

The platform, powered by NSEIT, promises to augment efforts to build and nurture industry participation in R&D. {Read more}

262. On August 13, the World's Highest Railway Arch Bridge - Chenab Bridge's Golden Joint was inaugurated in Reasi, Jammu & Kashmir. The Golden Joint is connecting two ends of the deck of the world's highest railway bridge. It is 35 meters higher than the Eiffel Tower. The bridge will prove direct connectivity to the Kashmir valley. The construction was initially started in 2004 but the work was stopped in 2008-09. The Chenab bridge is 1,315 metres long and 359m above the river bed level. The bridge is being built at a cost of Rs 1,486 crore. {Read more}

263. According to the latest Government data, for the first time, 500 cities across India have declared themselves as 'SafaiMitra Surakshit Shehar'. These cities were able to achieve adequacy in terms of institutional capacity, manpower and equipment norms as stipulated by Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs and are providing safe working conditions for SafaiMitras. All Indian Cities are expected to be 'SafaiMitra Surakshit' by March 2024. Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs along with Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment launched 'NAMASTE' (National Action for Mechanized Sanitation Ecosystem) Scheme. National Safai Karamchari Financial Development Corporation (NSKFDC) would be implementing agency for NAMASTE. It envisages the safety and dignity of sanitation workers in urban India. {Read more}

The 3.5-km-long train, powered by 5 locos and loaded with 295 loaded wagons, carried a total trailing load of 27,000 tonnes of coal, the heaviest fuel transportation carried by the Indian Railway in a single arrangement. {Read more}

On August 18, the Union Cabinet approved a 1.5% interest subvention on short-term farm loans up to Rs 3 lakh, which will be provided to lending institutions for the financial year 2022-23 to 2024-25. Under the Modified Interest Subvention Scheme (MISS), short term agriculture loan upto Rs 3 lakh is available to farmers engaged in Agriculture and other allied activities at the rate of 7% per annum and an additional 3% subvention is also given to the farmers for prompt and timely repayment of loans. In order to support sectors affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, the cabinet also approved an enhancement of the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) corpus by Rs 50,000 Cr to Rs 5 trillion. {Read more} Key Points:

276. On August 16, Indian's largest defense public sector company, Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL) announced to open its first overseas office in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The office in Malaysia will help HAL in tapping the new business opportunities for Fighter Lead-in Trainer (FLIT) LCA and other requirements of Royal Malaysian Air Force (RMAF) like Su-30 MKM and Hawk upgrades. This is an important step as defence sector has achieved a significant growth in exporting military equipment. India registered highest ever Defence exports of Rs 12,815 Cr in 2021-22. In last year, the Defence Ministry approved a ₹48,000 Cr deal with HAL for the procurement of 83 Tejas fighter aircraft for the Indian Air Force (IAF). According to the HAL officials, HAL would start delivering the jets (Mk-IA variant) to the IAF in 2025 and all 83 jets will have to be handed over by 2030. {Read more}

277. On August 16, FIFA, the governing body of world football, banned the All India Football Federation (AIFF), citing 'third party' intervention. The ban was lifted on August 26, after FIFA received confirmation that the mandate of the Committee of Administrators that was set up to assume the powers of the AIFF Executive Committee had been terminated and that the AIFF administration had regained full control. {Read more}

279. As on August 2022, Kaizad Bharucha, executive director of HDFC Bank, emerged the Highest Earning Banker for 2021-22 (FY22). Bharucha received Rs 10.64 Cr remuneration in FY22, mainly due to Rs 4.46 Cr as performance bonus. However, Amitabh Chaudhry of Axis Bank was the Highest Paid MD & CEO among bankers in FY22 with a total remuneration of Rs 7.63 Cr in FY22. Chaudhry was followed by Sumant Kathpalia (Rs 7.3 Cr), MD & CEO of Indusind Bank, and Sandeep Bakhshi (Rs 7.08 Cr), MD & CEO of ICICI Bank. {Read more}

Science & Technology

280. On August 15, a team of clinicians and scientists from three Hyderabad-based institutes - LV Prasad Eye Institute (LVPEI), IIT Hyderabad & Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology (CCMB), 3D-printed an artificial cornea and transplanted it into a rabbit's eye. The researchers from the three institutes have collaborated to develop the 3D-printed Cornea from the human donor corneal tissue. It is a made-in-India product by an Indian clinician-scientist team and the first 3-D printed human cornea that is optically and physically suitable for transplantation.
