

351. On August 22, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) in collaboration with Seva Bharti and Yuva Vikas Society launched the second phase of "Grameen Udyami Project" in Ranchi, Jharkhand. The partnership aims to multiskill India's youth and impart functional skills to them for enabling livelihoods. The multi-skilling project that aims to train 450 tribal students in Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand. The project is being implemented in 6 states including Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, and Gujarat. Moreover, the central government has sanctioned a budget of 85,000 Cr for tribal areas. {Read more}

352. On August 20, Larsen & Toubro (L&T) announced the commissioning of a Green Hydrogen Plant at its AM Naik Heavy Engineering Complex in Hazira, Gujarat. Shrikant Madhav Vaidya, Chairman, Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL), inaugurated the plant. The green hydrogen plant is designed for an electrolyser capacity of 800 kW comprising both Alkaline (380 kW) and PEM (420 kW) technologies. The plant will produce 45kg of green hydrogen daily. A blend of 15% hydrogen with natural gas will be used as a fuel. As part of its ESG commitments, L&T has pledged to achieve water neutrality by 2035 and carbon neutrality by 2040. {Read more}

353. On August 22, Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh unveiled India's first indigenous Hydrogen fuel cell bus in Pune. The Hydrogen fuel cell bus is developed by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) and KPIT Limited. The fuel cell makes use of hydrogen and air in order to produce electricity and power the bus, hence making it the environment-friendly transportation mode. If a diesel bus is to be compared, it typically emits 100 tons of CO2 per annum on long-distance routes. {Read more}

All facilities and equipment including spraying of trees, spraying of water as well as cutting and pruning are there in the ambulance. The ambulance will be operated by the Horticulture Department of the Municipal Corporation. {Read more}

Among the platforms set on sail were INS Tarkash which reached Brazil in South America on August 15, INS Tharangini at London, UK in Europe, INS Sumedha at Perth in Australia, INS Saryu at Singapore in Asia Continents, INS Tabar at Mombasa, Kenya in Africa Continents, and INS Satpura at San Diego Harbor, US in North America Continents. {Read more}

On August 19, a first-of-its-kind Composite Indoor Shooting Range (CISR) was inaugurated by Vice-Admiral Biswajit Dasgupta, Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief (FOC-in-C), Eastern Naval Command at INS Karna on the Eastern Seaboard. The CISR is a state of the art, self-contained, 25 m, six lane, live firing range for all primary and secondary weapons in the Navy. INS Karna is the first in the Navy and perhaps the only military unit in the country to set up and use a facility of this kind. {Read more}

This will help in meeting the target of production of 5 million tonnes of Green hydrogen by 2030. Hydrogen startup funding is in tune with PM Narendra Modi's vision of National Hydrogen Mission (NHM) launched on India's 75th Independence Day, last year. {Read more}

362. As India continues its fight with Covid19 and Monkeypox, a new illness called "Tomato Flu" has started spreading across India. Tomato Flu was first detected in Kollam district of Kerala on May 6, and as of August 24, India has reported as many as 82 confirmed cases of the viral disease. After Kerala, the flu has spread to Tamil Nadu, Haryana and Odisha. Children less than 5 years of age have been infected by the disease. The Lancet study states that this common contagious disease generally targets children from 1 to 5 years of age and adults with weaker immunity. 'Tomato Flu' is also known as 'Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD)'. {Read more}

As per the data submitted by the bank, more than 99% of the depositors are entitled to receive the full amount of their deposits from Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC). {Read more}

370. On August 19, Central Bank of India entered into a strategic Co-Lending Partnership with Incred Financial Services Ltd (IFSL) to offer loans to MSME Borrowers at competitive rates. Central Bank of India will take into its books 80% of the MSME Priority Sector loans under mutually agreed terms. While IFSL will service the loan account throughout the life cycle of the loan. {Read more}

371. On August 18, the SEBI issued new guidelines for Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs) and Venture Capital Funds (VCFs) for making investment abroad, under which overseas investee firms won't need to have an Indian connection. Under the rules, AIFs can invest in securities of companies incorporated outside India. Besides, VCFs are allowed to make investments in off-shore venture capital undertaking. The VCF is an AIF which invests primarily in unlisted securities of startups, early-stage venture capital undertakings mainly involved in a new business model. {Read more}

Science & Technology

372. On August 19, India has developed the first indigenously-developed RT-PCR kit for testing monkeypox disease. The kit was unveiled by Principal Scientific Adviser (PSA) Ajay Kumar Sood and developed by Transasia Bio-Medicals. According to WHO, Monkeypox is a viral Zoonosis, a virus transmitted to humans from animals. {Read more}

373. On August 21, a group of researchers discovered a new species of bent-toed gecko from Agasthyamalai hills in the Western Ghats. The species has been named "Cyrtodactylus aravindi" after noted malacologist N. A. Aravind. Aravind's ground gecko has so far been found only at two locations, Muppanddal and Thuckalay, in Kanyakumari district falling within the Agasthyamalai Biosphere Reserve in Tamil Nadu. The details of the new species were described in the journal, Vertebrate Zoology. {Read more}

374. On August 21, an international team of researchers has found a new species of long-fingered bats in India and Sri Lanka. The team named the new species of long-fingered bats as "Miniopterus phillipsi". It was named after W. W. A. Philips (1892-1981) in recognition of his contributions to studies on the mammals of Sri Lanka and South Asia. The initial research was carried out in Sri Lanka in 2019 and it took three years to be completed in both Sri Lanka and India. {Read more}
