The extension of the scheme for completing the remaining houses will cost Rs 2.17 lakh Cr, of which the Centre will spend over Rs 1.43 lakh Cr. Besides, the Cabinet also approved the funding and implementation of 'Ken-Betwa Inter-Linking of Rivers' project with a total cost of Rs 44,605 Cr. The project has a deadline of 8 years. A Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) called Ken-Betwa Link Project Authority (KBLPA) will be set up to implement the project. {Read more}

144. On December 6, India reported reduction in the malaria burden between 2019 and 2020, according to the World Health Organization's (WHO) latest "World Malaria Report". The WHO report noted that India accounted for 83% of cases and 82% of all malaria deaths in 2020 in the WHO South-East Asia Region. While globally, India contributed 1.7% of malaria cases and 1.2% deaths. There were an estimated 241 million malaria cases and 6,27,000 malaria deaths worldwide in 2020, representing about 14 million more cases and 69,000 more deaths in 2020 compared to 2019. Malaria deaths increased by 12% globally in 2020 compared with 2019. On the other hand, China and El Salvador were certified by the WHO as malaria-free in 2021, and Iran attained 3 consecutive years of zero indigenous cases in 2020. {Read more}
