351. On December 15, Ashok Leyland, flagship of the Hinduja group, partnered with DRDO's lab, Combat Vehicles Research and Development Establishment (CVRDE) to develop and manufacture 600hp indigenous Engine to power futuristic combat vehicles under 'AtmaNirbhar Bharat'. {Read more}

Under the scheme, the acquiring banks will be incentivised by the Government at an estimated financial outlay of Rs 1,300 Cr for a period of 1 year. Besides, the Cabinet approved the implementation of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) for 2021-26 with an outlay of Rs 93,068 Cr that aims to benefit about 22 lakh farmers. Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP), Har Khet ko Paani (HKKP) and Watershed Development components were also approved for continuation during 2021-26. {Read more}
