651. In December 2021, Adani Solar, the photovoltaic manufacturing and research arm of the Adani Group, has begun manufacturing of large sized monocrystalline silicon ingots in India. With this, Adani Solar has become India's first manufacturer of large sized monocrystalline silicon ingots capable of producing M10 & G12 wafers. The company intends to add 2 GW of ingot and wafer capacity by the end of 2023 and 10 GW by 2025. {Read more}

SBI Foundation has designed the project in collaboration with Himalayan Environmental Studies and Conservation (HESCO) to promote equitable economic and ecological development in 10 disaster-prone villages in the Joshimath Block of Chamoli District. The project aims to achieve this crucial balance by promoting diversified livelihoods, including horticulture, ecotourism, bio farming, agriculture, and environmental protection measures, such as construction of check dams, protection walls, and water holes, to mitigate the risk of climate change. {Read more}

658. On December 30, West Bengal got its first Vande Bharat Express which was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at Kolkata's busiest station Howrah. The final destination is New Jalpaiguri station. The new train will reduce travel time between Siliguri and Kolkata significantly. The new 16-coach train, which features modern passenger facilities, will take around 7.5 hours to reach its destination. It is the 7th Vande Bharat Express that will be running in India. The last Vande Bharat Express was inaugurated by PM Modi on the Nagpur-Bilaspur route in early December. In the Union Budget for 2022, Finance Minister Sitharaman said that the government would build 400 more Vande Bharat trains in the next three years. {Read more}

On December 2022, Tamil Nadu Forest Department (TNFD) collaborated with HCL Foundation (HCLF), the CSR arm of HCLTech, for marine and coastal conservation to resolve the ghost net and marine debris problem in the Gulf of Mannar Marine National Park, Tamil Nadu. Gulf of Mannar (GoM), India's first Marine National Park and one of the largest biosphere reserves, is highly affected due to unsustainable fishing practices, dumping of plastics and ghost nets. A three-year action plan and 'Debris-Free Gulf of Mannar' mass awareness campaigns for a larger citizen's action will also be conducted. {Read more}

Temporary permits are given for 30 days, regular permits for 3 months and labour permits for a year. {Read more}

These High HorsePower (9000 HP) locomotives will be the future workhorse for freight operation on Indian Railways. Siemens, selected as technological partner, will manufacture these locomotives at Dahod and maintain these locomotives at four maintenance depots - Visakhapatnam, Raipur, Kharagpur, Pune for a period of 35 years utilising Railway's Manpower. Siemens India is a subsidiary of Germany-based Siemens AG. {Read more}

665. On December 25, India and Russia agreed to stop using the dollar and Euro for bilateral trade settlements, and planned to do all such transactions in rupee and Rouble/Ruble. The decision is taken to address the trade imbalance for a full-fledged transition to national currencies. Currently, India imports five times more from Russia than it sells back. Pavan Kapoor is the India's ambassador to Russia who addressed the Russia-India business dialogue recently. {Read more}

On December 26, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has expanded two of its committees - High Powered Steering Committee on Cyber Security (HPSC-CS) and Information Systems Security Committee (ISSC), in a bid to strengthen cyber security frameworks and cyber resilience requirements. The HPSC-CS has been expanded to 8 members from 6 earlier. It will continue to be chaired by Navin Kumar Singh, DG at National Critical Information Infrastructure Protection Centre (NCIIPC). The ISSC has been expanded to 7 members, chaired by H. Krishnamurthy, Professor at IISc, Bengaluru. The move came at a time when Central Depository Services Ltd (CDSL) faced cyber security issues in November. {Read more}

On December 26, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) conducted the "Financial Literacy and Inclusion Survey" to evaluate digital banking awareness and knowledge among the rural and urban population across. The survey was based on 3 parameters namely, Financial Knowledge, Attitude, and Behaviour. Of the total score of 21, the average urban and rural scores were 11.7. {Read more}

669. On December 25, Defence Ministry gave nod to procure 120 'Pralay' ballistic missiles for the armed forces that are likely to be deployed along India's border areas along Pakistan and China. In December 2021, The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully conducted the maiden flight test of the indigenously developed surface-to-surface Pralay missile. Pralay is capable of striking and destroying targets in the range of 150-500 km, and can also be used in the night to attack enemy's targets. The Pralay missile has an accuracy of 10 metres and has a speed of around 2,000 km per hour, and is equipped with an infrared or thermal scanner. The missile would be provided to the Air Force and the Navy. In the missiles of similar category, while China has Dongfeng-12 missiles, Pakistan possesses Ghaznavi, M-11 and Shaheen missiles. {Read more}

On December 28, Indian scientist Dr Mahima Swamy, who hails from Bengaluru, has been chosen to join the prestigious "European Molecular Biology Organization (EMBO) Young Investigator Network", recognising her as one of the top talents in biology in Europe. A key part of her work is the study of inflammatory bowel diseases and how these can be prompted by the body's immune system attacking the gut lining in the absence of infection. {Read more}

676. On December 27, a rare and potentially deadly brain-eating amoeba has been identified in South Korea for the first time. The brain-eating amoeba, known as 'Naegleria Fowleri', is typically found in warm freshwater and soil, and can cause a rare and severe infection known as primary amebic meningoencephalitis (PAM). Though it is a rare disease and it is difficult to estimate the exact number of cases, there have been 143 reported cases in the United States from 1962 to 2018. {Read more}
