101. On December 5, Madras High Court has imposed a ban on mobile phones in Tamil Nadu's temples. Madras High Court has urged the Tamil Nadu government to impose the restriction to preserve the cleanliness and sanctity of temples. The directive was issued to the State Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment (HR&CE) Department by the HC panel of Justices R Mahadevan and J Sathya Narayana Prasad. {Read more}

103. Uttarakhand has hired the US-based McKinsey, a global management consultancy, to help the state in achieving the target of doubling its Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) in the next 5 years. The State has the target of doubling GSDP from ₹2.73 lakh crore to ₹5.5 lakh crore by achieving a CAGR of 15% in the next 5 years. The government has signed a two-year agreement with the company under 'Shashakt (empowered) Uttarakhand' mission. The company will work in areas like agriculture, horticulture, Urban (Brownfield and greenfield cities), service sector, infra projects (core as well as social sectors) to accelerate the income of the people and of the State. {Read more}

104. In December, Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first phase of the 701-km "Hindu Hrudayasamrat Balasaheb Thackeray Maharashtra Samruddhi Mahamarg" in Maharashtra. The Expressway will reduce the time taken to 839-km distance between Nagpur and Mumbai, to 7 hours that currently takes at least 17 hours. The Expressway, also called 'Samruddhi Mahamarg/Corridor' or 'Nagpur-Mumbai Super Communication Expressway', built at a project outlay of ₹55,335 crore, runs past 392 villages across 10 districts. This is the second expressway in Maharashtra after the Mumbai-Pune Expressway. {Read more}

105. Airbus Beluga, the world's largest aircraft, has landed at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport in Mumbai for the first time. It's the Airbus A300-600ST, also called the 'Super Transporter'. The gigantic 56.15-metre-long whale-shaped plane can carry 47,000 kg of cargo and is used to transport outsized cargo like next-generation space material, valuable paintings and more. The aircraft entered service in January 1996. {Read more}

KVIC has already the Re-Hab project in 7 states - Karnataka, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Assam and Odisha, as the elephant attacks are common in these areas. Under this project, fencing of bee boxes is installed in areas from where elephants move towards the human settlements and farmers' agriculture. The initiative of Re-Hab project will be run by KVIC at select locations for a period of one year. {Read more}

The COP19, organised by Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES) in Panama City, accepted the proposal by Botswana and Namibia to degrade the status. Wild animal species listed in Appendix I include those threatened with extinction. The animals named under Appendix II may not necessarily be threatened with extinction, but trade of such species should be controlled to ensure it does not threaten their existence. Namibia's white rhino population is estimated to be around 1,237 individuals. {Read more}

The team comprises one geologist each from Mineral Exploration Corporation Ltd (MECL), KABIL (Khanij Bidesh India Ltd) and the Geological Survey of India (GSI). The team of geologists will be there for 15 days to carry out the exercise of assessing feasibility of lithium reserves in Argentina's Catamarca province. Lithium is the key component of batteries and other electronics including in rechargeable batteries (used in EVs) and energy storage solutions. With 8 million tons, Chile has the world's largest known lithium reserves, followed by Australia (2.7 million tons), Argentina (2 million tons) and China (1 million tons). {Read more}

To become a GM, a player has to secure three GM norms and cross the live rating of 2,500 ELO points. Mittal is the 5th Indian to achieve the GM title in 2022 after Bharath Subramaniyam, Rahul Srivatshav, V Pranav V and Pranav Anand. {Read more}

"iNCOVACC (BBV154)" became the world's first intra-nasal vaccine to receive both Primary series and Heterologous booster approval from the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) under Restricted Use in Emergency Situation for ages 18 and above, in India. iNCOVACC was developed by Bharat Biotech in partnership with Washington University, St. Louis. {Read more}

116. In December 2022, OpenAI has launched "ChatGPT", an artificial intelligence-powered chatbot. ChatGPT chatbot crossed 1 million users in less than a week of its launch. Once a user signs up for ChatGPT, they can use the chatbot to have a conversation, and the expectation is that it will give reasonably intelligent answers in the form of an essay. {Read more}

The results of the study have been published in Chemical Science, a journal published by the prestigious Royal Chemical Society. A new species of head-shield sea slug of the genus Melanochlamys Cheeseman named "Melanochlamys bengalensis" was discovered from West Bengal's Digha and adjoining places like Bakkhali, Tajpur, New Digha, Udaipur, Talsari, Chandipur and Kanika Islands (Odisha). The new species represents a distinct clade compared to the other species of the genus Melanochlamys. It is a small, 12mm-14mm long, black animal with its shell inside the body and no backbone (invertebrate). Its distribution is recorded on around a 295-kilometre stretch from Bakkhali of West Bengal to Konika Island of Odisha. The research paper on the new species has been published in the international journal, Molluscan Research, of Malacological Society of Australasia and the Society for the Study of Molluscan Diversity. {Read more}

Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) has declined from 130 per lakh live births in 2014-16 to 97 per lakh live births in 2018-20, according to the "Special Bulletin on Maternal Mortality in India 2018-20" released by the office of the Registrar General of India. Maternal death is the death of a woman while pregnant or within 42 days of termination of pregnancy. The target 3.1 of the Sustainable Development Goals set by the United Nations aims at reducing the global maternal mortality ratio to less than 70 per 1,00,000 live births. In India, Kerala has the lowest MMR of 19 per lakh live births followed by Maharashtra (33) and Telangana (43). Assam has the highest MMR of 195. {Read more}

India ranks 8th among the countries that are at the highest risk for mass killing in 2022 and 2023, according to the "Early Warning Project 2022-2023" released by the US-based research organisations in December 2022. There is a 7.4% or approximately one in 14 chance of a new mass killing beginning in India in 2022-2023. The Project is a joint initiative of the Simon-Skjodt Center for the Prevention of Genocide at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum and the Dickey Center for International Understanding at Dartmouth College. A mass killing, as per the report, is 1,000 or more civilians deliberately killed by armed forces over a period of a year or less, because of their membership in a particular group. Pakistan topped the list, followed by Yemen & Myanmar among all 162 countries. India has performed worse than Sudan (9th), Somalia (10th), Syria (11th), Iraq (12th), and Zimbabwe (14th rank). According to the 2021-2022 report, India was ranked in the second position. {Read more}

147. 87.1 lakh new formal jobs were created across India in the first half of the ongoing financial year 2022-23 (H1 FY23), according to an analysis of the data put out by the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO). This is a 35% increase compared to the year-ago period. In the first halves of FY21 and FY22, 24.6 lakh and 64.72 lakh formal jobs were created in the country, respectively. In this fiscal, most jobs were created in September - 16.82 lakh. EPFO data shows that a major proportion of these jobs were created in the Expert Services sector. More than 36 lakh jobs were included in the category, which consists manpower agencies, private security agencies and small contractors. It is then followed by Trading-Commercial Establishments and Engineering. Maharashtra created the maximum number of jobs, followed by Karnataka and Tamil Nadu. {Read more}
