351. On December 14, Maruti Suzuki India has showcased the Wagon R Flex Fuel prototype model in Delhi. It is India's first mass-segment flex-fuel car designed to run on any ethanol-petrol blend between 20% ethanol and 85% petrol (E20-E85). India is the largest producer and consumer of sugar, and its second-largest exporter in the world. Ethanol made from processing crop waste, is ideal for an agrarian economy. This also gives an impetus to the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' initiative. Maruti Suzuki is working on a variety of technologies including electric, hybrid electric, CNG, bio-gas, ethanol, Flex-Fuel, etc. The company has already announced its commitment to make its entire product range E20 fuel material compliant by March 2023. {Read more}

NTPC crossed the 1 GW annual capacity in renewable energy (RE) segment by adding 1,074.59 MW RE in FY23. {Read more}

The Beypore Urus are purely made of premium wood, without using any modern techniques. The program will run for six months where startups will be trained on several aspects of building successful apps, including UX design, business model and monetization strategies, international expansion best practices, and data safety and security practices. Startups will have access to virtual instructor-led webinars, self-learning material, and mentorship sessions with leading local and global industry leaders. On December 16, Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare, Bharati Pravin Pawar told the Lok Sabha in a written reply, there has been an upsurge in measles cases in many states in India during November 2022. Some 10,416 cases and 40 deaths were registered through December 12, 2022. Six states - Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Kerala and Maharashtra, contributed most to the caseload. Maharashtra contributed the maximum to the burden. Financial support up to Rs 50 lakh is provided under the "National Policy for Rare Diseases (NPRD)" to the patients suffering from such diseases, Pawar told the Lok Sabha. India's doctor-population ratio is 1:834 per thousand population. {Read more}

362. On December 11, Uttarakhand is planning for its genetic enhancement to increase the productivity of its indigenous petite Badri cow that grazes on the medicinal herbs of the Himalayas. The Badri cow is the first registered cattle breed of Uttarakhand which has been certified by the National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (NBAGR). It gives only one to three litres of milk per day. To make the farmers of Uttarakhand breed Badri and not to shift to other high milk-producing alternative breeds like Jersey cows, the state officials have decided to opt for Multiple Ovulation Embryo Transfer (MOET), a conventional embryo flush, which is the most common procedure used in advanced cattle breeding. Moreover, ovum pickup in vitro fertilisation (IVF) is the other technology that will be used to increase the yield per animal. The State aims to achieve its targets in the next 10 years. {Read more} Key Points:

363. On December 14, Indian Energy Exchange (IEX) became India's first Carbon-Neutral Power Exchange, using market based tradable instruments to offset its carbon emissions. To reduce its carbon footprint, IEX voluntarily cancelled CERs (Certified Emissions Reductions) from clean projects registered under the Clean Development Mechanism of United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). According to the UNEP 2022 report, global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions must be cut 45% by 2030 to get on track to limit global warming to 1.5 degrees. {Read more} **Key Points:**

On December 10, the Forest department of Kerala, in association with Noolpuzha grama panchayat, launched the 'Vanikaran' (afforestation) project to restore natural vegetation and root out invasive plants. The project was executed under the Sulthan Bathery forest range of the Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary. 7,000 bamboo seedlings and 12,000 saplings of fruit plants were supplied for the project. Apart from planting the saplings, the authorities ensure the protection of plants for the next five years under the project. The workers have also constructed soil bunds and pits for harvesting rainwater to ensure availability of water for the saplings. {Read more}

There are 75 groups of most vulnerable sections amongst the tribals who are classified as the PVTGs spread over 18 States and the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Further, Ministry of Tribal Affairs is also implementing a scheme of Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) to provide quality education to Scheduled Tribes (ST) students including PVTG students (Class 6th to 12th) in remote areas. As per provision, 5% seat in each of the EMRSs is reserved for PVTG students only. {Read more}

367. On December 14, the Union government has granted the Geographical Indication (GI) tag to 9 products from across India. Of the 9 GI tags given, 5 were for products from Kerala. With this, the total number of registered GI products in India stands at 432. The nine products include - Gamocha, pronounced as Gamosa or Gamusa, (Assam), Tandur Redgram (Telangana), Raktsey Karpo Apricot (Ladakh), Alibag White Onion (Maharashtra), and Kerala's products - Attappady Aattukombu Avara (oilseed crops), Kanthalloor Vattavada Veluthulli (Kanthalloor Vattavada Garlic), Attappady Thuvara (Attappady red gram), Kodungallur Pottuvellari (Kodungallur Snap Melon), and Onattukara Ellu (Onattukara Sesame). The GI status is valid for 10 years in India, and it can be renewed again. {Read more} **Key Points:**

On December 15, Jammu and Kashmir Chief Secretary Arun Kumar Mehta launched the online Visitor Management System called "SWAGATAM" to ensure easy and hassle-free entry of visitors to both Secretariats at Jammu and Srinagar. The system shall enable a person to schedule a meeting in advance for the redressal of his genuine grievances. {Read more} Key Points:

369. India recently approved a Sri Lankan request to designate the INR as a foreign currency. Sri Lankans can now hold \$10,000 worth of the Indian rupee (INR) in physical form, though the INR would not be legal tender in the island nation. This also means that Sri Lankans and Indians can use Indian rupees instead of US dollars for international transactions with each other. And for this, Sri Lankan banks must open Nostro Accounts with Indian banks. A nostro account refers to an account that a bank holds in a foreign currency in another bank. {Read more} **Key Points:**

370. On December 15, the Group of Seven (G7) countries, along with Norway and Denmark, signed an agreement called 'Just Energy Transition Partnership' to provide Vietnam with \$15.5 billion to help the Southeast Asian nation move faster from coal power to renewable energy, cutting its climate-damaging pollution. The aim is to help Vietnam reduce its emissions to "Net Zero" by 2050. The first such deal was signed with South Africa in 2021, and a similar agreement was signed with Indonesia in November. {Read more}

On December 14, the 54-member United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) adopted the draft resolution, introduced by the US, to remove Iran from the membership of the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women (UNCSW) for the remainder of its 2022-2026 term, citing its oppression of women and girls in Iran. India abstained in the ECOSOC on a draft resolution to oust Iran. Iran was rocked by protests after the death of 22-year-old Mahsa Amini. The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) is the principal global intergovernmental body exclusively dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women. After Iran's removal, now ECOSOC has 53 members. {Read more}

372. On December 13, New Zealand passed into law a unique plan to phase out tobacco smoking by imposing a lifetime ban on young people buying cigarettes. The law states that tobacco can't ever be sold to anybody born on or after Jan 1, 2009. health authorities hope smoking will fade away well before then. They have a stated goal of making New Zealand smoke-free by 2025. The law does not affect vaping, which has already become more popular than smoking in New Zealand. New Zealand in recent years also imposed a series of hefty tax hikes on cigarettes. {Read more} **Key Points:**

373. On December 13, HDFC got in-principle approval from BSE and NSE for its merger with HDFC Bank. In April 2022, HDFC Bank agreed to take over HDFC, the biggest domestic mortgage lender. Once merged, the new entity will have a combined asset base of around Rs 18 lakh Cr. The merger is expected to be completed by the second or third quarter of FY24. After the merger, HDFC Bank will be 100% owned by public shareholders while existing shareholders of HDFC will own 41% of the bank. Every HDFC shareholder will get 42 shares of HDFC Bank for every 25 shares held. {Read more}

374. On December 14, according to a report by Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the wholesale price-based inflation (WPI) declined to a 21-month low of 5.85% in November on easing prices of food, fuel and manufactured items. The inflation was 14.87% in November 2021. Inflation in food articles in November was 1.07% against 8.33% in the previous month. Retail inflation dipped below the RBI's upper tolerance level of 6% the first time in 11 months in November on softening food price index. {Read more}
