The declaration was a part of the 34<sup>th</sup> session of FAO's Committee on Fisheries (COFI34), which ended its week-long meeting on February 8, 2021. Rs 25.5 Cr was allocated for Wildlife Institute of India in Budget 2021-22. FAO will celebrate the role of small-scale fishers & Women during the "International Year of Artisanal Fisheries and Aquaculture" in 2022. Russia has become a party to the Agreement on Port State Measure (PSMA), joining another 68 FAO members. {Read more}
