All non-deposit taking HFCs with an asset size of ₹10,000 Cr and above, and all deposit taking HFCs irrespective of their asset size will have to achieve a minimum LCR of 50% by December 1, 2021 and 100% by December 1, 2025. {Read more}

The previous version of Astra missile had a strike range of about 110 km and now, its advanced variant can strike targets 160 km away. {Read more}
