551. National Stock Exchange (NSE) and Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) launched the T+1 settlement rules from February 25, 2022. The settlement marks the official transfer of shares to the buyer's account and cash to the seller's account. Indian stock exchanges currently follow T+2 days settlement i.e. settlement of funds & securities happens on two business days after the order is executed. Before the SEBI introduced the T+2 settlement system in April 2003, India followed the T+3 settlement system. {Read more}

In February 2022, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) announced to start "Health Star" rating system for packaged foods just like the bureau of energy efficiency has for electronic appliances. As per the rating system, packaged foods will display the number of stars on the front of the pack, indicating how healthy or unhealthy it is depending upon the amount of salt, sugar and fat it has. It will be rolled out in the next few months. The authority is bringing in the regulation based on a report from IIM Ahmedabad. {Read more}

553. On February 26, the Union Cabinet approved a proposal to allow foreign direct investment (FDI) up to 20% in LIC through the automatic route. The FDI policy reform will further enhance Ease of Doing Business in the country, leading to larger FDI inflows. Current FDI policy which permits 74% foreign investment under the automatic route in the insurance sector does not apply for the LIC, as it is established and governed under the 'LIC Act, 1956'. While current FDI policy allows FDI in the insurance sector is not covered under either "Insurance Company" or "Intermediaries or Insurance Intermediaries". The decision is expected to open doors for foreign investors who are keen to participate in the upcoming initial public offering (IPO) of LIC, India's largest public offering. LIC filed draft papers with SEBI for the sale of 5% stake for an estimated Rs 63,000 Cr. {Read more}

562. On February 28, India's economy (GDP) expanded by 5.4% during the 3rd quarter (Q3FY22), as per the Quarterly Estimates of GDP for the 3rd quarter (October-December) of FY2021-22. The growth in GDP during 2021-22 is estimated at 8.9% as compared to a contraction of 6.6% in 2020-21, as per the data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO) in its Second Advance Estimates (SAE) of National Income. {Read more} **Key Points:**

On February 25, as the Russia-Ukraine conflict intensifies, the Export Credit Guarantee Corporation of India (ECGC) changed the insurance cover category for Russia from 'Open Cover' to 'Restricted Cover Category – I' (RCC-I), under which revolving limits (normally valid for a year) are approved specifically on a case-to-case basis. The ECGC also clarified that the coverage on export transactions to Moscow has not been withdrawn. In FY21, India's exports to Russia stood at \$2.6 billion, while imports stood at \$5.5 billion. {Read more}

574. On February 27, China launched a Long March-8 rocket to place 22 satellites in space and set a domestic record for the most spacecraft launched by a single rocket. The rocket was launched from the Wenchang Spacecraft Launch Site in south China's Hainan Province. These satellites will mainly be used for commercial remote sensing services, marine environment monitoring, forest fire prevention and disaster mitigation. The mission marked the 409th flight of the Long March carrier rockets. {Read more}
