The OECM tag is given by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) to areas that are not protected but support rich biodiversity. {Read more}

135. By the end of January, garbage collection directly from rural households of Andhra Pradesh reached 61.50% from 22% by the end of November. Andhra Pradesh CM Y. S. Jagan Mohan Reddy had flagged off 4,097 garbage collecting vehicles to kick off the Clean Andhra Pradesh (CLAP) or Jagananna Swachha Sankalpam programme which was started on October 2, 2021. The program was started with an aim to clean up rural areas, improve sanitation conditions and waste management with public participation. Now, the state government has targeted to achieve 100% rural household garbage collection under CLAP programme by October, 2022. {Read more}
