On February 18, the Centre approved the implementation of Phase II of the Inter-Operable Criminal Justice System (ICJS) project by the Ministry of Home Affairs at a total cost of Rs 3,375 Cr during the period from 2022-23 to 2025-26. The project will be implemented as a central sector scheme. National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) will be responsible for the implementation of the project in association with National Informatics Centre (NIC). Under Phase-II, the system is built on the principle of 'One Data One Entry'. {Read more}

The Sagarmala programme is promoting rapid economic development. As many as 131 projects worth Rs 1.05 lakh Cr have been earmarked for Maharashtra. {Read more}

One of the recommendations was the separation of the roles of chairperson and MD/CEO.
