451. On January 22, In a move aimed at making drones more accessible to the farmers, the Agriculture Ministry decided to provide 40-100% subsidy until March 2023 in purchasing drone by revising guidelines of Sub-Mission on Agricultural Mechanization (SMAM). The guidelines have been amended which envisages a grant up to 100% of the cost of agriculture drone or ₹10 lakh, whichever is less. But, this 100% grant will be limited to only Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institutes, ICAR institutes, Krishi Vigyan Kendras & State Agriculture Universities. Agriculture graduates establishing Custom Hiring Centers (CHCs) will be eligible to receive 50% of the basic cost of a drone or up to ₹5 lakh in grant for drone purchases. The FPOs would be eligible to receive a subsidy of 75% of the cost of drone if used only for demonstration purpose. {Read more}

452. On January 26, Andhra Pradesh government issued a draft notification for creating 13 new districts bringing the total figure to 26 districts from existing 13 districts. The two new tribal districts will be Manyam and Alluri Sitarama Raju. The other new districts are Anakapalli (out of the existing Visakhapatnam district), Konaseema and Kakinada (out of East Godavari), Eluru (out of West Godavari), NTR (out of Krishna), Bapatla and Palnadu (out of Guntur), Nandyal (out of Kurnool), Sri Satya Sai (out of Anantapuramu), Annamayya (out of Kadapa) and Sri Balaji (out of Chittoor). {Read more}

477. On January 26, the President approved awards of 384 gallantry and other defence decorations on the eve of 73rd Republic Day celebrations, which includes 12 Shaurya Chakras. The parade was held at Rajpath in New Delhi and the tableaux of 12 States were selected on this occasion. Olympic gold medalist Neeraj Chopra was bestowed the "Param Vishisht Seva Medal". The PVSM is usually accorded to three-star officers for distinguished service to the nation. Chopra is a Subedar in the Rajputana Rifles. Out of 12 Shaurya Chakras, six were awarded to Army personnel while the rest of six were awarded to CRPF personnel. Moreover, Ashoka Chakra, the country's highest peacetime gallantry award, was conferred on Assistant Sub-Inspector of Jammu and Kashmir Police, Babu Ram, posthumously. On the same occasion, Squadron Leader Suraj Nair was conferred with the award of "Vayu Sena Medal" for his act of exceptional courage and disregard to personal safety. {Read more}
