501. On January 28, NHEV (National Highway for Electric Vehicle) inaugurated India's largest electric vehicle (EV) charging station in Gurgaon, Haryana. This charging station has been installed and operated by Alektrify Pvt Ltd. This smart EV charging station has 96 operational charging ports for electric vehicles for 96 EVs at a time and can serve upto 576 electric vehicles round the clock. {Read more}

502. The flypast of Indian Air Force (IAF) was the grandest ever in the history of the Republic Day parade as the largest-ever fleet of 75 aircraft, including newly-acquired Rafale fighters, showcased the India's aerial assets over Rajpath. India's first woman fighter pilot, Flight Lieutenant Shivangi Singh became the second woman fighter pilot to be part of an IAF tableau after Flt Lt Bhawna Kanth. A total of 21 tableaux, 12 of various states/UTs and 9 of ministries/departments were showcased at Republic Day Parade this year. {Read more}

503. On January 25, the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) issued notification restricting the export of human hair, unworked, whether or not washed or scoured, waste of human hair or any other form of raw human hair. This is expected to curb the under-invoicing of the product and smuggling via Myanmar to China where it was labeled as domestic Chinese hair and processed. India is the world's largest producer of human hair and 80% of world hair is produced in India but only 2% of value-added products such as wigs are made here. {Read more}

504. On January 25, Himachal Pradesh celebrated its 52nd statehood day. On this occasion, Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur announced that the domestic consumers whose electricity consumption is up to 60 units per month will not be charged any money while those who consume up to 125 units will be charged only Re 1 per unit. For farmers, he announced to reduce the present cost of electricity from 50 paise to 30 paise per unit. He also announced to increase the limit of maximum annual income for availing the benefit of various welfare schemes and pensions for weaker sections of society from existing Rs 35,000 to Rs 50,000. {Read more}

The order also stated the outlet of the Najafgarh jheel should remain free from sewage before it joins the Yamuna river. The implementation of these action plans will be monitored by the National Wetland Authority. A status report on it is to be submitted to the NGT as on July 31. {Read more}

The finance ministry will take the final decision to impose the duties. India has already imposed anti-dumping duty on several products to tackle cheap imports from various countries, including China. {Read more}

While India INX became the first Exchange in IFSC to list Formosa Bonds issued by SBI. A Formosa bond is a bond issued in Taiwan but denominated in a currency other than the New Taiwan Dollar. {Read more}

ACC will decide on his selection after getting reports from anti-corruption agencies such as CVC and CBI. If appointed, he will replace Mukesh Kumar Surana, who will superannuate on April 30.
