On January 16, Turkmenistan President Gurbanguly Berdymukhamedov ordered experts to find a way to extinguish a massive five-decade old fire in a giant natural gas crater in the country, dubbed the "Darvaza gas crater". Darvaza gas crater also known as "Gateway to Hell" is in the middle of the vast Karakum desert. The crater was created in 1971 during a Soviet drilling accident that hit a gas cavern. To prevent the dangerous fumes from spreading, the Soviets decided to burn off the gas by setting it on fire. The pit has been ablaze ever since and previous attempts to put it out have been unsuccessful. In 2018, the president officially renamed it to the "Shining of Karakum". {Read more} Key Points:
