151. On January 5, Goa's newly developed Manohar International Airport, Mopa started its commercial operations. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the Manohar International Airport, Goa on 11th December 2022. The foundation stone of the airport was laid by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi in November 2016 and it has been developed at a cost of around Rs 2,870 Cr. Dabolim airport of Goa, being a Defence airport. put limitations on air traffic. The new airport would help tourism and enable Goa to become a hub for exporting perishable goods like fruits, vegetables, and



fish. This would create employment opportunities, increase income for locals, and attract visitors from across India. Recently, Goa reduced VAT on aviation fuel from 18% to 8%. {Read more}

It also aims for proper disposal of garbage, installation of garbage etc. The three-day long 'Global Investors Summit' will begin from February 10, 2023 and will conclude on February 12, 2023 at Lucknow. Moreover, the government will introduce 'Brand UP' in G-20. Apart from 100-day 'UP Global City', other similar campaigns being run by the Uttar Pradesh government are -Swachh Dhaba campaign, Swachh Virasat Abhiyan etc. {Read more}

156. On January 3, International Institute of Information Technology Bangalore (IIITB) rolled out Modular Open-Source Identity Platform (MOSIP) which is a digital identity platform. Upon the request of World Bank to initiate research and development, the project provides digital identities similar to Aadhaar to underdeveloped and developing countries. So far, 16 lakh lines of codes have been developed and used by countries, free of cost. Although the project was first aimed at providing MOSIP to five countries, it has now been extended to nine countries. Philippines, Morocco, Sri Lanka, Uganda, Ethiopia, Republic of Guinea, Sierra Leone, Burkina Faso, and Togolese Republic are the countries whose citizens will enroll on the platform. The project is highly scalable



and secure. The developers have also figured out a way to operate in 5,000+ habitable islands of Philippines where there is no good internet connection. The project is also being funded by Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Norad, Sir Ratan Tata Trust, Pratiksha Trust and Omidyar Network. {Read more}

158. On January 8, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has been granted an extension for the seventh time for 6 months till June 30, 2023, to frame rules for the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA). The citizenship amendment Bill (CAB) was passed by Parliament on December 11, 2019. It got the President's assent the next day. The law is yet to be implemented, as rules under the CAA are yet to be framed. According to the Manual on Parliamentary Work, rules for any legislation should have been framed within six months of Presidential assent, or seek



extension from the committees on subordinate legislation of the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha. The MHA sought time from the Parliamentary committees on six occasions. The first extension was granted in June 2020. {Read more}

159. On January 7, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya reviewed the progress of Fertilizers Corporation of India Ltd. (FCIL) Talcher unit at Angul, Odisha. Revival of FCIL Talcher unit is being undertaken by Talcher Fertilizers Ltd. (TFL). He informed that India's domestic production of urea will see a major boost with five new fertilizer plants coming up in the country. Four of these plants are already functional while Talcher is a coal gasification plant which will become functional by October 2024. Talcher unit which will be India's largest and first coal gasification urea plant. Since the project promotes coal gasification, it shall also aid in meeting the stated aim of gasifying 100



MT of coal by 2030. Start of all five plants would add 63.5 Lakh Metric Ton per annum (LMTPA) indigenous urea production capacity in the country. Out of five, four plants i.e. Ramagundam, Gorakhpur, Sindri and Barauni Fertilizer Plants have already started urea production in the country. {Read more}

160. On January 10, Supreme Court effectively extended the ground for enforcement of the fundamental rights. With this, a citizen can seek enforcement of the fundamental rights to freedom of speech not just against the state but against other citizens as well. Article 19 which guarantees freedom of speech and expression, is a right invoked against the state. The court, extending free speech against private citizens, opens up a range of possibilities in



Constitutional law. This interpretation could also bring an obligation on the state to ensure private entities also abide by Constitutional norms. {Read more}

161. On January 8, India handed 75 passenger buses to Sri Lanka as part of its assistance towards strengthening public transport infrastructure. As part of its 'Neighbourhood First' policy, India has extended multi-pronged assistance to Sri Lanka to help the country tide over its worst economic and humanitarian crisis since its independence from Great Britain in 1948. India handed 125 SUVs to the Sri Lanka Police under a line of credit in December to support the island nation and help it address the serious mobility restriction issues faced by the police, due to the non-availability of vehicles. The Sri Lankan government in May last year declared a debt default on over \$51 billion in the foreign loan – a first in the country's history. The Indian credit lines since early 2022 have been in use to import essentials and fuel after street protests erupted due to severe shortages of essentials. {Read more}

The launch of the scheme, which was conceived as part of an India-U.K. Migration and Mobility MoU signed in May 2021, was announced in November at the G20 summit in Bali. The letters were signed and exchanged between the two countries at the High Commission of India in London. {Read more}

163. On January 7, Kerala has become the first state in the country to go fully digital in its banking service. This achievement was possible due to social interventions through local self-government institutions along with infrastructure development and technological advances in the banking sector. Also, Kerala has received three 'Digital India' awards for the advancement in the digital sector. These medals are: silver medal for Ksheerashree portal, platinum award for Digital Workforce Management System and gold medal for District Administration of Kottayam. Kerala Fibre Optic Network (K-FON) project of the state government, which is almost 90% completed, will reduce the digital divide. The K-FON will ensure internet facility to everyone in the state and 17,155 km-long optic fibre cable network has been laid. Once the project gets completed, internet will be available to everyone in the state either for a cheaper price or for free-of-cost. {Read more}

167. On January 9, HDFC Capital, the real estate private equity arm of HDFC Group, achieved the initial close for second scheme of its third fund, by raising USD 376 million. The latest fund raising is the third by HDFC Capital's affordable real estate (H-Care 3) fund and the primary investor in the H-Care schemes is a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Abu Dhabi Investment Authority (ADIA). The fund will provide long-term, flexible funding across the life cycle of affordable and midincome housing projects including early-stage funding. Since the launch in 2016, the fund, across its schemes, has created a USD 3.1 billion funding platform, making it one of the largest private finance platforms in the world focused on development of affordable housing. HDFC Capital targets to finance 10 lakh affordable homes. {Read more}

The previous high was Rs 80,000 Crore in FY17, while in FY22 it was Rs 70,000 Crore. India and Japan conducted their first-ever bilateral combat air exercise named 'Veer Guardian 23' exercise from January 12 to 26 at the Hyakuri Air Base in Omitama, and the Iruma Air Base in Sayama in Japan. Sukhoi-30MKI Squadron Leader Avni Chaturvedi, India's first woman fighter pilot, was also a part of the Indian contingent that will feature in aerial wargames with Japan. This was the first instance of a woman air warrior leading an Indian fighter squadron on foreign soil. IAF participated with four Su-30 MKI, two C-17 Globemasters and an IL-78 tanker. Squadron leader Chaturvedi was inducted into the Indian Air Force fighter squadron in June 2016 alongside Mohana Jitarwal and Bhawana Kanth. In 2018, she became the first Indian woman pilot to take a solo flight in



a MiG-21 aircraft. In March 20<mark>20, she</mark> was awarded the Nari Shakti Purashkar by President Ram Nath Kovind. {Read more}



The extent of Out-of-Pocket Expenditure; 4. Confirmed Grievances and 5. Improvement in-patient's Health-Related Quality of Life.
