401. On July 14, NASSCOM's Centre of Excellence (CoE) for "Internet of Things and Artificial Intelligence" (IoT & AI) has launched "Healthcare Innovation Challenge (HIC) 2.0". The one-of-its-kind initiative aims to address the challenges faced by healthcare providers in digital technology adoption. NASSCOM CoE was set up in July 2016 as part of the Digital India initiative of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY). {Read more} **Key Points:**

402. On July 15, India's first 'Grain ATM' has been set up in Farrukhnagar, Gurugram district of Haryana as a pilot project. It is an automatic machine which works like a bank ATM. Installed under the World Food Programme of the United Nations, it is called Automated, Multi Commodity, Grain Dispensing Machine. It can dispense up to 70 kg of grains within 5 to 7 minutes at a time. {Read more}

The Cabinet also approved the continuation of National Ayush Mission (NAM) as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for another 5 years till 2026. Besides this, the Cabinet announced that NAM would continue from April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2026, with a financial implication of ₹4,607.30 Cr. {Read more}

The project is part of efforts by Singapore to meet a goal of quadrupling its solar energy production by 2025 to help tackle climate change. The 60 MW peak solar photovoltaic (PV) farm has been built by a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sembcorp Industries. {Read more}
