### National & States Affairs

**451.** As on July 23, Burhanpur also known as the 'Darwaza of Dakhin' (Gateway of Deccan) in Madhya Pradesh became the first 'Har Ghar Jal' certified district in India. Only 37,241 rural households (36.54%) out of a total of 1,01, 905 households in Burhanpur had potable drinking water through tap connections at the time of the launch of Jal Jeevan Mission on August 15, 2019. It has been done within a span of 34 months. Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC) has been formed in all 254 villages. {Read more}

**453.** In July 2022, at least 65 cases of black fever or 'kala-azar' have been reported from 11 districts of West Bengal. Earier, Kala Azar was practically eradicated from West Bengal. **454.** On July 21, the running and maintenance of ships of the Union Territory (UT) of Lakshadweep have been handed over to the Shipping Corporation of India to improve shipping operations. Of the five ships in service for the people of Lakshadweep and connecting people between islands and Kochi, two are undergoing repairs. Lakshadweep administration had facilitated hassle-free movement of Hajj Pilgrims through special voyages and requirements of students, for attending exams, have also been taken care of by coordinating with the education department. {Read more}. **Key Points:**

**455.** As on July 25, only 4 states have adopted "Model Tenancy Act (MTA)" since the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) circulated it on June 7, 2021. Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and Assam have revised Tenancy Laws on the lines of MTA. Model Tenancy Act aims to promote rental housing by balancing and protecting the interests of both the tenants and landlords by regulating renting of premises in an efficient and transparent manner through an adjudicating mechanism for speedy dispute resolution. {Read more} Key Points:

**456.** On July 20, Ministry of Commerce & Industry prohibited the import of human embryos in accordance with the 'Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act, 2021' and the 'Surrogacy (Regulation) Act, 2021'. Earlier, the imports were prohibited except for research purposes based on the guidelines of the Department of Health Research. {Read more} Key Points:

**457.** In July 2022, Kerala, which slipped to the 8<sup>th</sup> place in holding the sittings of the State Assembly during the first wave of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, got back to the 1<sup>st</sup> place in 2021, with its House sitting for 61 days, the highest for any State. Despite enjoying the record of having the highest number of sittings during 2021 for any State legislature, Kerala had promulgated 144 ordinances, also the highest in the country in 2021. Odisha & Karnataka followed Kerala with 43 & 40 sitting days, respectively. {Read more}

**458.** In July 2022, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has launched a new mobile app named "AadhaarFaceRd" to perform face authentication through mobile app from anywhere and at any time. Now, Aadhaar holders no longer need to carry physical identification by using Iris and Fingerprint scans by physically visiting their local Aadhaar enrollment centre. Aadhaar holders' identities can be stored in the Central Identity Data Repository using face authentication, according to the UIDAI. {Read more}

**459.** On July 20, the Commerce Ministry announced that Work from Home (WFH) is allowed for a maximum period of 1 year in a Special Economic Zone unit and can be extended to 50% of total employees. ### **International Affairs**

**460.** Saudi Arabia is planning to build the world's largest structure: two buildings reaching up to 1,600 feet in height and running parallel for 75 miles, as the documents accessed by The Wall Street Journal show. The Wall Street Journal claims that the skyscrapers, expected to cost a whopping \$1 trillion, will be made of mirrored glass, and are part of the project named 'Mirror Line'. The Mirror Line is designed by the US-based Morphosis Architects. Mirror Line has been envisioned as the epicentre of the new desert city called "Neom", which is being constructed as per Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman's plans to set up a zero-carbon city in a 170-km line. Neom will be around the size of Massachusetts. As per documents, the two buildings will be connected via walkways, and a high-speed train will run underneath them. The project will reportedly house 5 million people. The prince has claimed he wants the Mirror Line to be ready by 2030, but engineers said it could take up to 50 years for completion. {Read more}

**461.** On July 22, Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunisation (GAVI) made announcement for international support worth nearly USD 160 million for the next 3 years to facilitate increased vaccine access to children at high risk of illness and death from malaria. Malaria remains a primary cause of childhood illness and death in sub-Saharan Africa. In 2020, nearly half a million African children died from malaria or 1 child died of malaria every minute, according to the WHO's report. Since the world's first malaria vaccine was introduced in 2019, it has been well accepted in African communities after a relatively short period of time. {Read more}

- GAVI announced a \$160-million international support for the rollout of the 1<sup>st</sup> malaria vaccine in Africa for next 3 years

**462.** On July 22, Bajaj Allianz General Insurance launched its add-on motor insurance cover called 'Pay As You Consume' (PAYC) under the Irdai's sandbox regulations. Pay as you consume gives customers the flexibility to choose their insurance premium based on their vehicle usage, depending on their driving behaviour, using telematics. {Read more} **Key Points:**

**464.** On July 17, former Australian star Lleyton Hewitt was inducted into the "International Tennis Hall of Fame 2021". The Adelaide-born tennis player has won two Grand Slam singles titles in his illustrious career. Back in 2001, Hewitt became the world no.1 at the age of 20. Back in January 2016, Hewitt took retirement from Tennis, following the Australian Open. {Read more}

**466.** On July 25, the 1<sup>st</sup> Khelo India Fencing Women's League was started at the Talkatora Indoor Stadium, New Delhi. Over 300 women across 20 States had registered to participate in the event in the Cadet (U-17), Junior (U-20) and Senior (13 & above) categories. A total of Rs 1.54 Crore has been sanctioned by the Sports Authority of India (SAI) for this event. {Read more}

**467.** In July 2022, Captain Rohit Sharma-led Indian Cricket Team defeated England's team in both formats - Twenty 20 International (T20I) and One Day International (ODI), while the Test series ended in a 2-2 draw, in Manchester, England. In this match, Rohit Sharma became the first captain in the history of Cricket to win 14 consecutive T20Is. While Rishabh Pant scored his maiden Hundred in ODI for India. {Read more} Key Points:

## Persons in News

**469.** On July 21, a Nepali mountaineer Sanu Sherpa, 47, became the first person to complete all 14 of the world's 8,000metre peaks for the second time. He reached the summit of Pakistan's Gasherbrum II (8,035 metres) in July and achieved this milestone. He climbed his first 8,000-metre mountain in 2006. By 2019, he had summited all 14 8,000-metre peaks for the first time, one of around 40 people to do so at that time. He has reached the 8,849-metre (29,032-foot) top of Mount Everest 7 times. {Read more}



### Science & Technology

**470.** In July 2022, a rare 170-carat pink rough diamond called 'The Lulo Rose', weighing 34 grams, was discovered at Lucapa's Lulo Mine in Angola. It is touted to be the largest pink diamond discovered in the last 300 years. Lucapa Diamond Company stated that the pink diamond is the 5<sup>th</sup> largest diamond and the 27<sup>th</sup> 100+ carat diamond extracted in the Lulo Mining project till date. {Read more}

**471.** On July 24, China launched 'Wentian', the 2<sup>nd</sup> of the 3 modules to its Permanent Space Station. The 23-tonne Wentian ("Quest for the Heavens") laboratory module was launched on the back of China's most powerful rocket, 'Long March 5B' from the Wenchang Space Launch Center on the southern island of Hainan. China began constructing the space station in April 2021 with the launch of 'Tianhe', the first module. The third lab module, 'Mengtian' ("Dreaming of the Heavens"), is expected to be launched in October 2022. {Read more}

**472.** On July 20, the NASA awarded Elon Musk's SpaceX with a contract to provide launch services for the next space telescope mission called "Nancy Grace Roman Space Telescope". It is slated to launch in October 2026. Under the contract, SpaceX will launch the telescope on a Falcon Heavy rocket from NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Florida. The cost for the mission's launch is expected to be around \$255 million. The telescope was previously called the Wide Field InfraRed Survey Telescope but it was renamed after Dr. Nancy Grace Roman for her work at NASA. {Read more} **Key Points:**

**473.** On July 21, Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences, Dr. Jitendra Singh announced that Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) has developed indigenous technology for conversion of sea water to potable water. National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT), an autonomous Institute of Ministry of Earth Sciences, has developed "Low Temperature Thermal Desalination (LTTD)" technology for conversion of sea water to potable water. It has been successfully demonstrated in Lakshadweep islands. Three desalination plants based on the LTTD technology were developed and demonstrated at Kavaratti, Agati and Minicoy Islands of Lakshadweep. The capacity of each of these LTTD plants is 1 Lakh litre of potable water per day. {Read more}

- Ministry of Earth Sciences developed indigenous technology for conversion of sea water to potable water
- NIOT developed "Low Temperature Thermal Desalination" technology for conversion of sea water to potable water
- 3 desalination plants based on the LTTD technology established in Lakshadweep Islands

**474.** On July 25, US-based Boom Supersonic, the company which is developing the world's fastest airliner Overture, revealed the latest design for supersonic jet 'Overture' at the 'Farnborough Air Show', a UK-based aviation trade event. It can carry around 65-80 passengers at supersonic speeds of up to 2,100 kilometres per hour. With this speed, the ultra-high-speed jet can fly from New York to London in just 3.5 hours. Overture is expected to commence its operations 7 years later in 2029. Overture has been developed from the beginning to be Net Zero Carbon, flying on 100% Sustainable Aviation Fuel. {Read more}

**475.** In July 2022, the French government announced to confer the "Chevalier de l'Ordre National du Mérite" or the "Knight of the Order of the Merit", on Kannan Sundaram, publisher of Kalachuvadu, for his contribution to the publishing collaboration between India and France. A ceremony to confer the award will be organised in New Delhi at the residence of the French Ambassador in September or October, 2022. {Read more} Key Points:

**476.** On July 21, Kaushik Rajashekara, an Indian-origin professor of engineering at the University of Houston, won the prestigious "Global Energy Prize" for outstanding contributions to transportation electrification and energy efficiency technologies while reducing power generation emissions. Only three people in the world were selected this year for the honour, bestowed by the Global Energy Association. Other two awardees are - Viktor Orlov, Chief Specialist of the Centre for Innovative Technologies (Rosatom in Russia) & pioneer in thermonuclear physics; and Mercouri Kanatzidis, Professor of Chemistry and Materials Science at Northwestern University, US. The awarding ceremony will be held during Russian Energy Week in Moscow on October 12-14, 2022. {Read more}

**477.** In July 2022, Madhya Pradesh bagged the award for "Most Film-Friendly State" at the 68<sup>th</sup> National Film Awards. Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh bagged Most Film-Friendly (Special mention) Award. Journalist Anant Vijay won the 'Best Writing on Cinema' category. While Ajay Devgn and Suriya shared the Best Actor award at the 68<sup>th</sup> National Film Awards. Ajay Devgn won the award for his role in 'Tanhaji: The Unsung Warrior' and Suriya won it for 'Soorarai Pottru'. The best actor in female category was won by Aparna Balamurali for 'Soorarai Pottru'. Tamil film 'Soorarai Pottru' won Best Feature Film award. While 'Testimony of Ana' won Best Non-Feature Film award. 'AK Ayyappanum Koshiyum' (Malayalam), directed by Sachidanandan KR, won in Best Direction category. Sumi (Marathi) was Best Children's Film. This year, there are 50 categories with over 300 feature films and 150 non-feature films competing for the prizes. A 10-member jury was led by director-producer Vipul Shah. {Read more}

**478.** On July 22, Union Minister for Chemicals & Fertilizers, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, launched 3 schemes under the banner of 'Strengthening Pharmaceuticals Industry (SPI)' to strengthen Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the Pharmaceutical sector. The SIDBI will be the project management consultant for implementing the scheme. The schemes provide for credit linked capital and interest subsidy for technology upgradation of MSME units in pharmaceutical sector, as well as support of up to Rs 20 Crore each for common facilities, including research centre in pharma clusters. **494.** On July 20, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change has notified amendment to the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Rules. The new rule exempts Highway projects of strategic and defence importance, which are 100 km from the Line of Control (LoC), among other locations, from an Environmental clearance before construction. Thermal power plants up to 15 MW based on biomass or non-hazardous municipal solid waste using auxiliary fuel such as coal, lignite or petroleum products up to 15% have also been exempted. The EIA is a process of evaluating the likely environmental impacts of a proposed project or development. The EIA Rules were notified in 2006. {Read more}

**495.** On July 22, the Supreme Court extended Green Protection to forest land in Aravalli ranges. The SC held that all land covered by the special orders issued under 'Section 4' of the 'Punjab Land Preservation Act (PLPA)' in Haryana will be treated as forests and be entitled to protection under the 'Forest Conservation Act, 1980'. Special orders under 'Section 4' of 'PLPA' are the restrictive provisions issued by the state government to prevent deforestation of a specified area that could lead to soil erosion. The court's ruling will mean around 30,000 hectares across the Aravallis and Shivaliks in Haryana will be considered forest land. The Aravali Range is a range of mountains in western India running approximately 692 km in a northeastern direction across the Indian states of Gujarat, Rajasthan, and Haryana, ending in Delhi. {Read more} Key Points:

Under the provisions of the Bill, private tours and expeditions to Antarctica would be prohibited without a permit or the written authorisation by a Member country. A Member country is one of the 54 signatories of the Treaty. The Bill also prohibits mining, dredging and activities that threaten the pristine conditions of the continent. Following its first expedition to Antarctica in 1982, India has now established two standing research stations, Bharti and Maitri, at Antarctica. The Bill also establishes a 'Committee on Antarctic Governance and Environmental Protection'. {Read more}

Besides, both sides also signed two MoUs on mutual recognition of Educational Qualifications, including Maritime Education and a framework agreement on Healthcare Workforce.
