

601. On July 28, Indus International School in Hyderabad introduced India's first teaching robot named "Eagle", as part of its collaborative learning model. As many as 21 highly interactive Eagle Robots were deployed at three Indus schools in Hyderabad, Bangalore and Pune. The robot is said to be capable of teaching students of grades V to XI, in the classroom along with the teacher and also in a standalone mode. They can impart education in more than 30 different languages. {Read more}

602. To commemorate the victory of Indian armed forces and pay tribute to the supreme sacrifice of the gunners in 'Opersation Vijay', the area 'Point 5140' at Drass in Kargil has been renamed as 'Gun Hill'. Point 5140 is a strategically important mountain peak in the Dras sector of Ladakh. On July 26, 1999, the Indian Army announced the successful culmination of 'Operation Vijay', declaring victory after a nearly three-month-long battle with Pakistani troops on the icy heights of Kargil in Ladakh. {Read more}

In July 2022, the Supreme Court directed Uttar Pradesh to take action on the recommendations made in the report submitted by a 3-member inquiry commission headed by former Supreme Court judge Justice (Retd) to probe into the encounter of gangster Vikas Dubey. The 3-member bench include Chief Justice of India N. V. Ramana, Justices Krishna Murari and Hima Kohli. Dubey was killed in an encounter on July 10, 2020, when a police vehicle carrying him from Ujjain to Kanpur met with an accident. {Read more}

On July 29, the second anniversary of the "National Education Policy (NEP) 2020" in New Delhi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah announced several initiatives including - a National Innovation & Entrepreneurship Promotion Policy for schools, introduction of 75 'Bharatiya Games' in schools, launch of 'Kalashala initiative' in 750 schools to help students discover India's rich cultural heritage, a Public Consultation Survey to seek suggestions for the new National Curriculum Framework for schools, etc. The NEP was launched by the government on July 29, 2020. Moreover, on this occasion, Arunachal Pradesh government signed a tripartite MoU with NITI Aayog and Reach to Teach Foundation for a large-scale transformation in School Education in the state. The school education transformation project is under NITI Aayog's 'Development Support Services for States (DSSS)' initiative. {Read more}

International Affairs

605. In July 2022, the World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared the global Monkeypox outbreak a 'Public Health Emergency of International Concern' (PHEIC), one step below that of 'Pandemic'. International Health Regulations Emergency Committee of the WHO decides the seriousness of a public health crisis. This declaration is temporary and reviewed every 3 months. In India, the first case of Monkeypox was reported in Kerala. {Read more}

606. On July 25, the European Commission had given permission for Bavarian Nordic's "Imvanex" vaccine to be marketed as protection against Monkeypox. Globally, over 16,000 cases of monkeypox have been reported from 75 countries as of now. Imvanex is a non-replicating smallpox vaccine developed by Danish biotechnology company Bavarian Nordic in collaboration with the U.S. government. The approval is valid in all European Union Member States as well as in Iceland, Liechtenstein, and Norway. The vaccine was approved by the European Commission in 2013 for immunization against smallpox. {Read more}

607. On July 28, the RBI has allowed another window to Payment Aggregators (existing as of March 2020) to apply to the central bank for a licence by September 30, 2022. The PAs should have a minimum net worth of Rs 15 Cr as on March 31, 2022 and a net worth of Rs 25 Cr by March 2023. And, they have to maintain a net worth of Rs 25 Cr at all times thereafter. {Read more}

On July 28, the RBI has temporarily permitted merchants or their Payment Aggregators (PAs) involved in settlement of transactions where cardholders decide to enter the card details manually to save the Card-on-File (CoF) data for a maximum period of "Transaction Date + 4 days" or till the settlement date, whichever is earlier. There shall be no change in the effective date of implementation of the requirements relating to "Restriction on Storage of Actual Card Data" (CoF) - all entities, except card issuers and card networks, shall purge the CoF data before October 1, 2022. For handling other post-transaction activities, acquiring banks can continue to store CoF data (customer card credentials) until January 31, 2023. {Read more}

614. On July 28, Tata group's arm for aerospace and defence, Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL), delivered an indigenously developed Quick Reaction Fighting Vehicle-Medium (QRFV) to the Indian Army. In the first-ever development in the Indian Defence Ecosystem, TASL became India's first private sector company to produce and deliver wheeled armoured combat-ready vehicles for the Indian armed forces in April, 2022. Infantry Protected Mobility Vehicle (IPMV) has been developed by Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL) along with DRDO. {Read more}

- TASL delivered an indigenously developed Quick Reaction Fighting Vehicle-Medium (QRFV) to the Indian Army
- TASL became India's 1st private company to produce wheeled armoured combat-ready vehicles for India's forces

615. On July 27, Japan announced to participate for the first time in Indonesia's "Garuda Shield" military exercise to be held in August, alongside the United States, Australia & Singapore. The military exercise was scheduled to be held from August 1 to 14 at Baturaja Training Area, Amborawang, and Batam Island Training Area in Indonesia. Garuda Shield is an annual combined and joint exercise between the Indonesia & the US. This joint-exercise was first held in 2009. {Read more}

616. On July 30, Sanket Sargar created history at the "Commonwealth Games 2022" in Birmingham, by snatching India's first medal at the competition this time. In the 55-kg Men's Weightlifting category, the weightlifter lifted a total of 248 kg to clinch the Silver medal, and finished just 1 kg short of the Gold medallist Aniq Kasdan of Malaysia. Sanket Sargar first came into the international limelight at the "Singapore International Weightlifting Meet 2022" where he lifted a total weight of 256 kg to clinch the gold medal. {Read more}

617. On July 30, Indian weightlifter Mirabai Chanu (49kg) from Manipur claimed India's first Gold medal at the "Commonwealth Games 2022" in Birmingham. She ended with a total lift of 201kg (88kg+113kg), which is far from her personal best. She had won Silver medal at the '2020 Tokyo Olympics' in Women's 49 kg category. India's other Gold medalists at 'CWG 2022' are - Jeremy Lalrinnunga, Achinta Sheuli, Sudhir, Bajrang Punia, Sakshi Malik, Deepak Punia, Ravi Kumar Dahiya, Vinesh Phogat, Naveen, Bhavina Patel, Nitu Ghangas, Amit Panghal, Eldhose Paul, Nikhat Zareen, Sharath Kamal/Sreeja Akula, PV Sindhu, Lakshya Sen, Satwiksairaj Rankireddy/Chirag Shetty, Sharath Kamal, Indian women's team (Lawn bowls), and Indian men's team (Table Tennis). {Read more}

618. The 14-year-old Squash player Anahat Singh, from Delhi, was the youngest member of the Indian contingent at the "Commonwealth Games 2022". Anahat has already won more than 50 titles including the US Junior Open, the British, German and Dutch Junior Opens and Asian Championship. She is the first sportswoman to win the British Junior Squash Open in 2019 and US Junior Squash Open in 2021. She has also qualified for the World Juniors Squash Championships 2022 in Nancy, France, scheduled to begin on August 9 and is poised to become the youngest Indian to feature in this tournament too. {Read more}

On July 26, Global payments and technology company Mastercard is set to replace Paytm as the title sponsor for all international and domestic cricket matches organised by the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI). The BCCI has, reportedly, accepted Paytm's plea for the reassignment of its title rights. Paytm has been BCCI's title sponsor since 2015, and renewed the contract in August 2019 for up to March 31, 2023. {Read more}

620. On July 28, four-time world champion Sebastian Vettel announced to retire from Formula One at the end of the 2022 Season. The 35-year-old German, who currently drives for the Aston Martin team, won his titles with Red Bull from 2010-13 and also spent six seasons with Ferrari. {Read more}

Science & Technology

621. On July 28, three entomologists, Kalesh Sadasivan, Vinayan P. Nair and Abraham Samuel of the Travancore Nature History Society (TNHS), have identified a new species of damselfly, "Anamalai Reed-tail" from the Western Ghats in the Peechi Wildlife Sanctuary in Kerala's Thrissur. The discovery has been published in the Journal of Threatened Taxa. This is the second species belonging to the damselfly genus Protosticta to be described by the TNHS researchers after Ponmudi Reed-tail that was described in 2015. With this, Kerala's damselfly checklist has now grown to 182. {Read more}

On July 29, IIT Madras launched "Nilekani Centre at Al4Bharat" to advance the state of Indian language technology with the support of Rohini and Nandan Nilekani (Non-executive Chairman of Infosys) with a grant of Rs 36 Cr through Nilekani Philanthropies. Al4Bharat was set up as an initiative of IIT Madras to build open-source language Al for Indian languages. Moreover, the "Digital India Bhashini" mission was also launched with the goal of all services and information being available to citizens in their own language with 'collaborative Al' at the core of the design. {Read more}

628. On July 28, three climate scientists from the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), Pune, have won National Awards for their contribution to the field. Swapna Panickal won the 'Anna Mani Women Scientist Award', Milind Mujumdar was given the 'Certificate of Merit' and Anoop Mahajan was chosen for the 'Young Scientist Award 2022'. Panickal has contributed to the sixth IPCC report released in 2018. While Mujumdar has extensively worked on improving climate models over the past two decades. Moreover, Mahajan's major work has been on the role of Halogen Compound Emissions with respect to Climate. {Read more}

The annual award was instituted in 2015 during the First World Indology Conference hosted by the then President of India. The award comprises a citation, a gold-plated medallion, and US\$ 20,000 (approximately ₹1.6 million). {Read more}

According to the report by Worldline, India recorded 9.36 billion transactions in terms of volume and Rs 10.25 trillion in terms of value, in the first quarter (January-March) of 2022 via various payment modes led by Unified Payment Interface (UPI). The UPI P2M (Person to Merchant) transactions emerged as the most preferred payment mode among consumers with a market share of 64% in volume and 50% in terms of value. Credit cards accounted for 7% of transactions, but 26% of value. As of the first quarter, the top UPI apps in terms of volume were PhonePe, Google Pay and Paytm (94% in terms of volume & 93% in terms of value). While the top remitter banks were State Bank of India, HDFC Bank and Bank of Baroda. Maharashtra is the state with the highest number of transactions at physical touch points. While Hyderabad recorded the highest number of transactions. {Read more}

642. On July 25, the Central Ground Water Board (CGWB) is periodically monitoring the ground water levels throughout India on a regional scale, through a network of monitoring wells. In order to assess the long-term fluctuation in ground water level, the water level data collected by CGWB during November 2021 when compared with November 2011, it indicates that about 70% wells have registered rise in water level whereas, about 30% of the wells monitored have registered decline in ground water level. The Central Government is implementing 'Atal Bhujal Yojana' (Atal Jal), a Rs 6000 Crore Central Sector Scheme with World Bank assistance, for sustainable management of ground water resources in 7 states. Government of India launched 'Jal Shakti Abhiyan (JSA)' in 2019 in 256 water stressed districts in India. {Read more}
