# National & States Affairs

**651.** On July 30, Ashwini Vaishnaw, Minister of Electronics and IT, started a daylong event to celebrate “8 Years of MyGov” in New Delhi. The event celebrated the journey of the world’s largest platform for participatory governance which has nearly 2.5 Cr registered citizens. The minister also launched ‘Responsible AI for Youth 2022’ which was created by the National E-Governance Division (NeGD) in collaboration with Intel India and the support of the Ministry of Education. The Program will be open to all school students studying in classes 8-12 across India to foster a deeper understanding of AI-tech. MyGov (mygov.in), the Government of India’s citizen engagement platform, was launched on July 26, 2014 by PM Narendra Modi and has been built on 3 pillars of ‘Do’, ‘Discuss’ and ‘Disseminate’. During the programme, PM Modi launched the “Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme” which aims to provide financial assistance to DISCOMs for modernization and strengthening of distribution infrastructure. **654.** On July 29, the Central government has decided to reduce resolution time of public grievances, raised on a dedicated portal, to a maximum of 30 days from the existing 45 days. Besides, it has been decided that a complaint received from a citizen will not be closed until an appeal filed against it is disposed of. Moreover, DARPG, under the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, has undertaken a comprehensive reform of the “Centralised Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS)”, an online portal that allows people to raise complaint against government bodies, to make it more responsive to the needs of the citizens. Last year, the DARPG had reduced the maximum time limit to 45 days from 60 days to resolve public grievances. [{Read more}](#)

So, this is a historic resolution passed by the UNGA that will change the nature of International Human Rights Law. [{Read more}](#)

**659.** As per the data released by the Controller General of Accounts (CGA) on July 29, the Centre’s fiscal deficit for the first quarter of FY23 (April-June) stood at 21.2% of the FY23 Budget estimate due to strong capital expenditure and weak revenue receipts. The fiscal deficit for the same period last year (April-June FY22) was 18.2% of the FY22 Budget estimate. The Centre’s revenue receipts rose just 5% to Rs 5.7 trillion in Q1 FY23. While the expenditure was at 24% of the full-year target. In May, the central board of the RBI had announced to transfer Rs 30,307 Cr as dividend to the government for the accounting year 2021-22 as against Rs 99,122 Cr last year. [{Read more}](#)

**660.** On July 31, Bank of Baroda’s Board accorded approval for divestment of 12.50% of its shareholding in a subsidiary, IndiaFirst Life Insurance Company Ltd (IFLIC). BoB increased its stake in IFLIC from 44% to 65%, buying Union Bank of India’s 21% stake in 2021. Moreover, Carmel Point Investments India Pvt Ltd owns 35% in IFLIC. [{Read more}](#)

While Madhya Pradesh’s Datia district bagged first prize in districts’ category. As many as 272 districts in India were identified for drug free India campaign by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. Yang's total wealth dropped to \$11 billion from nearly \$24 billion in 2021. Jindal, 72, is India's richest woman and the 10<sup>th</sup> richest person in India. In India's richest women list, she is followed by Kiran Mazumdar and Crishna Godrej. Savitri has been considered the richest Indian woman for the past few years, according to Forbes also. **676.** At least 85% of districts face arid conditions across India, according to the "Aridity Anomaly Outlook Index" for July 2022, issued by India Meteorological Department (IMD). Only 63 of 756 districts were non-arid, while 660 were facing different degrees of aridity. The data for the remaining 33 districts were not available. Some 196 districts are in the grip of a 'severe' degree of dryness and 65 of these are in Uttar Pradesh which has the highest number of districts experiencing arid conditions, followed by Bihar (33).
