

51. On July 4, PM Narendra Modi inaugurated the "Digital India Week, 2022" in Gandhinagar, Gujarat. An integral part of the Digital India Week is the grand expo - "Digital Mela" which had more than 200 Stalls showcasing Digital India solutions for facilitating "Ease of Living". 52. The Gujarat forest department will restore 10,000 hectares of the Banni Grasslands in the coming year, and every year in the coming decade. The state plans on restoring at least 76,000 hectares of 2,497 sq km grassland which is a high-biodiversity area. The Banni grassland was also highlighted by PM Narendra Modi, in his keynote speech at the "United Nations High Level Dialogue on Desertification, Land Degradation and Drought" last year, as part of India's endeavour to reach the target of restoring 26 million hectares of degraded land by 2030. The grasslands of Gujarat constitute about 4.33% (8,490 sq km) of the total geographical area. Banni grassland was declared as Protected Forest in 1955, under the "Indian Forest Act, 1927". Banni Grasslands Reserve has 40 species of grass and 99 species of flowering plants. {Read more}

Ernakulam Dairy Plant is set to become India's first fully solar powered dairy plant. This solar power project will be installed with an outlay of Rs 11.5 Cr. 61. On July 5, all 30 Ambassadors of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) signed the Accession Protocols for Finland and Sweden at NATO's headquarters in Brussels, Belgium. All of NATO's 30 member countries hold the power to veto a new member. Turkey was initially proving to be an obstruction to the entry of Finland and Sweden into NATO. But all three countries recently signed a "trilateral memorandum" to extend their full support against threats to each other's security. Moreover, Japan participated in the NATO summit for the first time. Japanese Prime Minister, Fumio Kishida attended the summit, in June 2022. The '2022 NATO Summit' was held in Madrid, Spain. {Read more}

69. On June 27, the 47th meeting of the Goods & Services Tax (GST) Council was convened in Chandigarh. The meeting was chaired by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. On June 18, the GST Council had announced that the meeting would be held at Chandigarh instead of Srinagar, J & K. The council approved an increase in tax on electronic waste to 18% from 5%, and petroleum & coal bed methane to 12% from 5% earlier. Tax on household items & machinery was raised to 18% from 12%. The new rates will be effective from July 18. Moreover, Business Standard had reported that the GST Council is likely to consider a proposal for imposing a flat 28% tax on online skill gaming. Moreover, India's GST collections in June 2022 grew 56% year-on-year to around Rs 1.45 lakh Cr, compared to Rs 92,800 Cr in June 2021. {Read more}

On July 3, Indian runner Parul Chaudhary smashed the national record at the Sunset Tour in Los Angeles, as she became the first athlete from India to clock 8:57.19 time in the women's 3000m event. The 27-year-old Parul finished third. Parul, who specialises in steeplechase, broke Suriya Loganathan's record of 9:04.5s, set 6 years ago in New Delhi. She will also be competing in the women's 3000m Steeplechase event at the "2022 World Athletics Championships" in Oregon, US. {Read more}

The newly discovered material can convert infrared light to Renewable Energy. The exotic polaritons in the ScN can be utilized for solar and thermal energy harvesting. {Read more}

The plant was identified by researchers from Botanical Survey of India, Dehradun and Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), Shimla. The last record of the rare plant dates back to 1835. A study on the rediscovery of the species was recently published in July 2022 issue of 'Oryx', an international research journal published by Cambridge University Press on behalf of Fauna & Flora International. {Read more}

75. The UK hosted the 4th "Summit for Space Sustainability" in London, in collaboration with the Secure World Foundation. The UK also called for an "Astro Carta" for space sustainability, based on the Artemis Accords model for sustainable space exploration. Moreover, the ISRO is developing a docking experiment called 'SPADEX' to provide in-orbit servicing. Rahul Narwekar (45) is the youngest Speaker of the Assembly, not only in Maharashtra but across India. The post of the Speaker was vacant after Congress' Nana Patole resigned from the office in February 2021. {Read more}
