

151. On July 2, Railway Protection Force (RPF) launched a month-long pan India drive against smuggling of narcotics through rail, under code name "Operation NARCOS". RPF intensified its checks in trains and in identified black spots across the country in coordination with NCB and other LEA's to target drug peddlers involved in this illegal trade. In June 2022, RPF recovered various narcotics products including designer products valued Rs 7,40,77,126. {Read more}

On July 9, India joined the Interpol's "International Child Sexual Exploitation (ICSE) Database" which will allow it to draw links between victims, abusers and crime scene using audio-visual data. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), which is India's nodal agency for Interpol matters, joined the database making India the 68th country to connect to it. An intelligence and investigative tool, the database allows specialized investigators to share information on cases of child sexual abuse. Detectives in all 68 countries can exchange information and notes with their colleagues across the world. {Read more} Key Points:

The geo-portal was launched in August 2021 in the 40th meeting of the Board, chaired by Hardeep Singh Puri, Chairman of NCRPB and Minister for Housing & Urban Affairs. The geo-portal was developed by National Informatics Centre (NIC) for NCR Planning Board. {Read more}

155. On July 7, during the company's Annual General Meeting (AGM), Tata Power Chairman N. The company has planned Rs 14,000 Cr consolidated capex in FY23 with Rs 10,000 Cr in renewables. Tata Power plans to scale its generation capacity to over 30 GW by FY27 from current 13.5 GW. The company plans to increase Green Energy share to 60% over the next 5 years by 2027 and 80% by 2030, from current levels of 34%. The company has 3 Key Goals - Carbon Net Zero by 2045, 100% Water Neutral by 2030, Zero Waste to Landfills before 2030. {Read more}

The airline, backed by ace stock market investor Rakesh Jhunjhunwala, had taken delivery of its first Boeing 737 max aircraft in India on June 21, 2022. The airline will have 18 aircraft by the end of the fiscal year 2022-23. {Read more} **Key Points:**

157. On July 7, the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus in Mumbai has become the first railway station in India to be equipped with augmented reality screens. The futuristic technology will allow passengers at the station to get real-time digitised time table with a dedicated scrolling screen and railway information for an engaging experience. Augmented reality magic mirrors create a virtual world around the person standing in front of the screen. The Central Railways plans to bring in around Rs 50 lakh in revenues in 5 years. {Read more}

158. On July 4, the Western Railway (WR) opened its longest skywalk, from the Khar Road railway station to the nearby Bandra Terminus, for the passengers to reach the platforms to board trains easily. The skywalk spans 314 meters long and is 4.4 meters wide. The skywalk was built at a cost of around Rs 14 crore. Besides, the Western Railway has also been working in the direction to overhaul many Foot Over Bridges (FOBs) and Road Over Bridges (ROBs) in the metropolis. {Read more}

Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) approved a total of 314 applications (out of 320 applications under consideration) with proposed investments of Rs 86,824 Crore under a "Modified Special Incentive Package Scheme (M-SIPS)" till May 31, 2022. The proposals that were approved in May included an investment of Rs 596 Crore from Bosch Automotive Electronics Private Limited. The M-SIPS, announced by the government in July 2012, mainly provides a Capex Subsidy of 20-25%. M-SIPS was the first scheme under which the government supported Electronics Manufacturing Companies. {Read more}

160. On July 7, the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) approved the establishment of an "Interim Operational Hub", its first overseas office in Abu Dhabi, UAE. Starting with 57 founding members in 2016, AIIB now has a total of 105 members. Former RBI Governor Urjit Patel is one its five Vice Presidents. Besides being the AIIB's second largest shareholder after China, India has also secured USD 6.7 billion funding for 28 projects in recent years. {Read more}

163. On July 8, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed a penalty of Rs 5.72 Cr on Federal Bank for deficiencies in regulatory compliance. A penalty of Rs 70 lakh was also imposed on Bank of India for non-compliance with certain provisions of KYC norms. Moreover, a fine of Rs 7.6 lakh was imposed on Dhani Loans and Services Limited for non-compliance with KYC norms. {Read more}

164. On July 9, online payment gateways Razorpay, Stripe and Pine Labs are among the top fintech firms that received inprinciple approval from the RBI for a Payment Aggregator licence. The RBI is expected to release the full list of firms that were granted approvals shortly. At least 185 fintech firms, including big names like Cred, Razorpay, and PhonePe, had submitted proposals seeking the licence. Payment Aggregators are expected to have a net worth of Rs 15 Cr on the date of their applications or as of March 31, 2022, and Rs 25 Cr by the end of the ongoing fiscal year (FY23). In July, fintech startup 1Pay Mobileware also received the RBI's nod. {Read more}

The banks on which restrictions were imposed are - Ramgarhia Co-operative Bank, New Delhi; Sahebrao Deshmukh Co-operative Bank, Mumbai; Sangli Sahakari Bank, Mumbai; and Sharada Mahila Co-operative Bank, Karnataka. In the case of Ramgarhia Co-operative Bank and Sahebrao Deshmukh Cooperative Bank, the cap is Rs 50,000 per depositor, while it is Rs 45,000 in the case of Sangli Sahakari Bank. A depositor in Sharada Mahila Co-operative Bank can withdraw a maximum of Rs 7,000. {Read more}

On July 10, Karnataka Digital Economy Mission (KDEM) and State Bank of India (SBI) signed an MoU to open SBI's first dedicated branch for startups, "SBI Startup Hub branch", in Koramangala, Karnataka. The branch will be inaugurated in August. The collaboration will enable startups across the state to access banking facilities, funding, credit facilities. Rs 2 crore collateral-free financial assistance will be given to startup entrepreneurs. Moreover, the SBI also announced to start similar branches in Mysuru, Mangaluru, and Hubballi-Dharwad clusters in the next 6 months. {Read more}

World champion Anderson Peters of Grenada broke the 16-year-old meet record with a huge 90.31m throw in his third attempt. Important Days & Dates

180. India marks GST Day on 1 July to celebrate the 5th anniversary of the rollout of the Goods & Services Tax (GST). "GST Day" is observed every year by the Central Board of Indirect Tax and Customs (CBIC) to mark the roll-out of the historic tax reform. The day was first observed in 2018. The indirect tax regime was initiated in 2017 by the Centre. The tax system was finally passed by both the Rajya Sabha and Lok Sabha in 2016 and enacted as the 101st 'Constitution Amendment Act, 2016'. Geo-political conflicts and the COVID-19 pandemic has put the 17 sustainable development goals of United Nations in jeopardy, according to a UN report titled the "Sustainable Development Goals Report 2022" released on July 8. As per the report, the combined crisis led to an additional 75 million to 95 million people living in extreme poverty in 2022, compared with pre-pandemic projections. 93 million people worldwide were pushed into extreme poverty in 2020. The report also said, in 2021, an estimated 17 million metric tons of plastic entered the world's ocean and the volume of plastic pollution entering the ocean is expected to double or triple by 2040.
