

National & States Affairs

251. On July 10, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has formed a 3-member committee to carry out a delimitation exercise of Municipal Wards in Delhi. The delimitation exercise will pave the way for the city's first civic polls after the Municipal Corporation of Delhi's (MCD) reunification. Vijay Kumar Dev, the State Election Commissioner, will chair the committee. The committee will submit report in 4 months. On April 5, the Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bill, 2022, was passed by Parliament to reunify the three corporations. Maximum 250 municipal wards can be created under the 'Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Act, 2022'. {Read more}

252. On July 16, PM Narendra Modi inaugurated the 296-km-long Bundelkhand Expressway, which passes through 7 districts of Uttar Pradesh and has been constructed at a cost of around Rs 14,850 Cr. The four-lane expressway extends from NH-35 and merges with the Agra-Lucknow Expressway. {Read more}

253. On July 12, ReNew Power successfully refinanced its 2024 maturity Dollar-denominated Bonds worth \$525 million. The bonds were issued in 2019. The refinancing has cut the bonds' INR interest cost by 200 basis points, with the interest rate fixed for 3 years while pushing out the maturity to the end of fiscal year 2027. With this, ReNew Power became the first Indian Renewable Energy Company to refinance dollar-denominated bonds. {Read more}

The integrated facility spread across 40,000 square metres in Krishnagiri, around 300 kms from here, was expected to commence production in the second half of 2023. {Read more}

255. On July 12, Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami inaugurated 'Bal Vatikas' at Anganwadi Kendras across the state to strengthen the Pre-primary Education System. With this, Uttarakhand became the first state in the country to initiate process of implementing the Centre's New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 at the Pre-primary Level. The 'Bal Vatikas' will function at 4,457 anganwadi kendras in the state and will be equivalent to the nursery classes at a private school. The CM also said that the New Education Policy will be fully implemented in Uttarakhand by 2030. {Read more}

In July 2022, French aviation giant Safran Group announced to set up a "Maintenance, Repair & Overhaul (MRO) Facility" for its aircraft engines in Hyderabad at an initial investment of USD 150 million (around Rs 1,200 Cr) and create around 1,000 new job opportunities. This will be SAFRAN's largest MRO facility globally and will be the first Engine MRO established by Safran in India. {Read more}

The 3-year pilot project is expected to pave the way for a national network of Air Quality Sensors in rural India. India's current annual safe limits for PM 2.5 and PM 10 are 40 micrograms/per cubic metre (ug/m3) and 60 micrograms/cubic metre. {Read more}

The Census Data Workstation shall help spread awareness about the extensive amount of data colleges during Census operations in the country. {Read more}

259. On July 7, India's third power exchange namely "Hindustan Power Exchange (HPX)" (erstwhile Pranurja Solutions Ltd) was launched. It is backed by BSE and Power Trading Corporation (PTC). PTC India and BSE Investment hold 25% each in HPX, followed by 9.9% held by ICICI Bank. HPX received a nod from the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC). The other two exchanges in India are Indian Energy Exchange (IEX) and Power Exchange of India Itd (PXIL), of which IEX holds 98%. {Read more}

On July 9, Delhi Environment Minister Gopal Rai held a joint review meeting with the officials of the Environment Department and the Delhi Pollution Control Committee regarding the construction of India's first e-waste Eco Park at Holambi Kalan in Delhi in an area of about 21 acres. An 11-member steering committee has been formed and Delhi State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation (DSIIDC) has been made its implementing agency. Delhi produces over 2 lakh tonnes of e-waste every year, or about 9.5% of the total amount produced in India, and only 5% of the generated e-waste is properly recycled. {Read more}

261. On July 10, the government introduced certification of authenticity for jute products with the unveiling of "Jute Mark India" logo, by the Union Textile Secretary U. P. Singh. It is an initiative to promote and protect Indian jute products. National Jute Board is the nodal agency of the Union Textiles Ministry, responsible for the promotion of jute and jute products in India and abroad. JMI Scheme was implemented under an umbrella scheme for development and promotion of the jute sector between FY22 and FY26 with a total financial outlay of Rs 485.58 Cr by the Centre. {Read more}

PIMS shall come into effect from October 1, 2022. However, the online facility of registration is available from July 15, 2022. Paper products like currency paper, bank bond and Cheque paper, security printing paper, etc. have been excluded from mandatory registration. {Read more}

Cervical cancer is the second most frequent cancer among women between 15 and 44 years of age with a high death ratio in India. Every year in India, 1,22,844 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer and 67,477 die from the disease. {Read more}

280. On July 14, Samsung developed a new graphics Dynamic Random-Access Memory (DRAM) chip called "Graphics Double Data Rate 6 (GDDR6)" with a faster speed and improved power efficiency. The 24-gigabit GDDR6 adopts 3rd-generation, 10-nanometer technology and boasts a data processing speed that is over 30% faster than existing products. The new DRAM chip can process graphic images at a rate of up to 1.1 terabytes per second, which Samsung claims is the fastest in the world. The GDDR6 DRAM also improves power efficiency more than 20%. {Read more}



Ranks, Reports & Surveys

291. India ranks 135 among a total of 146 countries in the World Economic Forum (WEF)'s "Global Gender Gap Index 2022" and is the worst performer in the world in the "Health and Survival Sub-Index" where it is ranked 146. India also ranks poorly among its neighbours and is behind Bangladesh (71), Nepal (96), Sri Lanka (110), Maldives (117) and Bhutan (126). The report notes that India's score of 0.629 was its seventh-highest score in the last 16 years. Iceland (90.8%) is leading the global ranking, followed by Finland (86%, 2nd) & Norway (84.5%, 3rd). In 2021, India ranked 140 out of a total 156 countries on the index. {Read more}
