Afcons also created India's deepest Metro station, located 30 metres below the Howrah railway station. {Read more}

In July 2022, Researchers have identified a new species of evergreen tree belonging to the genus 'Miliusa' from the Agasthyamala biosphere reserve in the southern arm of the Western Ghats in the Thiruvananthapuram district of Kerala. The tree, which grows to a height of about 6 to 9 metres with drooping branches, has been christened "Miliusa agasthyamalana" after the location where it was found. The discovery was published in the journal Phytotaxa. The identification of the new species has also taken the total number of species of Miliusa found in India to 25. {Read more} **Key Points:**

This is the first selection made by the FSIB following its incorporation on July 1, 2022. The erstwhile Banks Board Bureau (BBB) was revamped into FSIB with certain amendments in its mandate. According to the 'NaBFID Act 2021', the institution will have one MD and not more than three DMDs. In October 2021, the government appointed veteran banker K. V. Kamath as the Chairperson of the NaBFID for 3 years. The newly-incorporated NaBFID is targeting financial assistance of Rs 1 lakh Crore in its first year of operations. {Read more}
