

### **National & States Affairs**

**351.** In July 2022, Union Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav inaugurated India's largest online herbarium database, the 'Indian Virtual Herbarium' web portal. The portal has been developed by the Botanical Survey of India (BSI) under the framework of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' and 'Digital India'. The database created is the largest storage of information about plant diversity in India. An herbarium (Latin: hortus siccus) is a collection of plant samples with associated data preserved for long-term study. {Read more}

**352.** In July 2022, Pharmaceutical company Bajaj Healthcare Limited has become the first private player in India to be awarded a government contract for the highly-regulated Opium processing sector. That means the company can use opium to extract active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) used in medicines. Thane-based Bajaj Healthcare had received two letters from the central government to manufacture APIs from processing of unlanced poppy capsule as well as straw and opium gum. The contracts will be valid for a period of 5 years. The company said it will execute both tenders at their API manufacturing unit in Savli, Gujarat. {Read more}

**353.** To commemorate 75 years of Independence, a nationwide campaign called 'Har Ghar Tiranga' is launched in which 20 Cr houses and 100 Cr people were supposed to hoist the National Flag in at their houses between August 13 and 15. To make things easy for the citizens, the central government modified the "Flag Code of India, 2002", to allow the tricolour to be displayed in the open and on individual houses/buildings day and night. Before this modification, the flag could be hoisted only between sunrise and sunset. In December 2021, the Flag Code of India was modified, allowing the use of polyester apart from cotton, wool, silk and khadi for making flags. On January 26, 2002, the Flag Code of India came into effect. {Read more}

**354.** In July 2022, the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) barred hotels and restaurants from levying service charge automatically or by default in food bills and allowed customers to file complaints in case of violation. The consumer may lodge a complaint against the violator hotel or restaurants on the National Consumer Helpline (NCH) - 1915 or through NCH mobile app. The Ministry highlighted that the consumer may also file a complaint against unfair trade practice with the Consumer Commission through "e-Daakhil" portal for its speedy redressal. {Read more}

**355.** On July 17, National Legal Services Authority Chairman, Uday Umesh Lalit launched India's first AI-powered digital Lok Adalat by the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority (RSLSA). The digital Lok Adalat was designed and developed by its technology partner Jupitice Justice Technologies. A NITI Aayog report suggested that it would take approximately 324 years to dispose all cases pending in India. 75-97% of legal problems never reach the courts. The Digital Lok Adalat will be used to dispose of pending disputes or disputes that are at the pre-litigation stage. {Read more}

356. On July 19, Jawaharlal Nehru Port became the first major port of India to become 100% Landlord port having all berths being operated on Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) model. JNP is one of the leading container ports of India and is ranked 26<sup>th</sup> among the top 100 global port, as per the "Lloyds List Top 100 Ports 2021" report. Total handling of JNPCT will increase to 1.8 million twenty-foot equivalent units (TEUs) from the present handling capacity of 1.5 million TEUs in 2020-21. This will reinforce JNPA's position as the 'Premier container port of India'. {Read more}

**357.** Civil Aviation Ministry is set to launch the "DIGI YATRA" project, aimed at achieving contactless, seamless processing of passengers, at two airports - Varanasi and Bengaluru, in August 2022 as part of its first phase. In its second phase, the DIGI YATRA project will be launched at 5 airports - Pune, Vijayawada, Delhi, Kolkata and Hyderabad, by March 2023. The contactless and seamless processing of passengers will be achieved via the Facial Recognition Technology (FRT). The system, also known as Digi Yatra Central Ecosystem (DYCE), provides for decentralised mobile wallet-based identity management platform. The DYCE system was formed by the Digi Yatra Foundation (DYF). {Read more}

**358.** On July 18, Union Minister Jitendra Singh launched the "National Standards for Civil Service Training Institutions (NSCSTI)" at Capacity Building Commission's (CBC) headquarters in New Delhi, aimed at elevating their quality and capacity. With this, India became the first country in the world to come out with a unique model to create standards for Civil Service Training Institutions at national level. {Read more}

The committee will be headed by former Agriculture Secretary Sanjay Agrawal. {Read more}

# International Affairs

**360.** As US companies struggle to entice workers back to offices, the parliament of the Netherlands approved legislation to establish 'Work from Home' as a legal right, setting the Netherlands up to be one of the first countries to enshrine such flexibility in law. It still needs a nod from the Dutch senate before its final adoption. The law forces employers to consider employee requests to work from home as long as their professions allow it. {Read more}

**361.** On July 20, Indonesia recently announced 'Digital Nomad Visas' for travellers to attract foreign travellers, as it plans to boost its economic condition. This initiative will enable remote workers to stay in the country for a long time, and that too tax-free through Digital Nomad Visa. Digital Nomads are those who choose to work independently and remotely. They travel and work, and also choose to spend their income in the country they are travelling to. Indonesia's Digital Nomad Visa would be the longest digital nomad visa as it will be applicable for 5 years. {Read more}

- Indonesia announced 'Digital Nomad Visas' for travellers to attract foreign travellers (validity 5 years)
- It will enable remote workers to stay in Indonesia for a long time, and that too tax-free through 'Digital Nomad Visa'



**362.** In July 2022, U.S. President Joe Biden and Israeli Prime Minister Yair Lapid signed a joint pledge "Jerusalem Declaration" to deny Iran nuclear arms. They will not allow Iran to acquire a nuclear weapon, according to Joe Biden. The Jerusalem Declaration further committed the United States and Israel to cooperating on defence projects such a laser interceptors, as well as on civilian technologies. {Read more}

The CAATSA is a law that came into effect in the US in 2017, and was meant to punish countries having deep engagements with Russia, North Korea, and Iran using economic sanctions. {Read more}

**364.** On July 18, Go Digit General Insurance launched "Pay as you Drive (PAYD)" add-on feature for motor insurance Own Damage (OD) policies. This makes Digit Insurance one of India's first insurers to introduce the add-on for its customers. Earlier in May, HDFC ERGO General Insurance had launched its "Pay as you Drive" program; an insurance solution that offers distance-based insurance to reduce upfront costs of premium. {Read more}

**365.** On July 16, Karnataka Bank signed an MoU with JCB India Limited, a manufacturer of earthmoving and construction equipment in India. Under the agreement, JCB will be nominating Karnataka Bank as its 'preferred financier' wherein individuals, contractors, companies and partnership firms can avail loans from the bank at competitive interest rates. The tie-up arrangement with JCB India is expected to boost the lending avenues under the bank's MSME portfolio. {Read more} **Key Points:**

**366.** As on July 19, according to the Reserve Bank of India's 5<sup>th</sup> round of Survey on Remittances titled "Headwinds of Covid-19 and India's Inward Remittances", the share of remittances from the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) region in India's inward remittances is estimated to have declined from more than 50% in 2016- 17 to about 30% in 2020-21. The US surpassed the UAE as the top source country for India, accounting for 23% of total remittances in 2020-21. India remained the top recipient country (with \$89.4 billion inward remittances), accounting for 12% of total global remittances. Maharashtra displaced Kerala as the top remittance recipient State with about 35% of India's total share in remittance receipts. {Read more}

**367.** As on July 18, in the run up to setting up a social stock exchange, the government has declared "Zero Coupon Zero Principal Instruments" as securities for the purposes of the "Securities Contracts (Regulation) Act, 1956". Zero coupon zero principal instrument means an instrument issued by a Not-for-Profit Organisation (NPO) which will be registered with the social stock exchange segment of a recognised stock exchange. These instruments will be governed by rules made by the SEBI. The Social Stock Exchange (SSE) is a novel concept in India. The idea was floated by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in her Budget Speech 2019-20. {Read more}

**368.** In July 2022, Bharat Electronics (BEL) announced the signing of a contract worth Rs 250 Cr with the Ministry of Defence, for the supply of 9 integrated Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) complex (IAC) MOD 'C' Systems. IAC MOD 'C' is an integrated ASW system for all surface ships of the Indian Navy. IAC MOD C has been indigenously developed by BEL in association with the DRDO. {Read more}

**369.** On July 18, PM Narendra Modi addressed the Naval Innovation and Indigenisation Organisation (NIIO) seminar named "Swavlamban". During the seminar, Prime Minister unveiled 'SPRINT Challenges', which are aimed at giving a boost to the usage of the indigenous technology in the Indian Navy. As a part of the 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav', NIIO, in conjunction with the Defence Innovation Organisation (DIO), aims at inducting at least 75 new indigenous technologies/products into the Indian Navy. This collaborative project is named "SPRINT" (Supporting Pole-Vaulting in R & D through iDEX, NIIO and TDAC). {Read more}

**370.** On July 17, the Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) created its first mountain-warfare training centre in northeast India, its second overall, to skill its troops in high-altitude combat and survival tactics. With this, the ITBP aims to guard the Line of Actual Control with China. The new centre has been established in remote Dombang, abutting the LAC, and is located at a height of 10,040 ft in Sikkim. {Read more}

**371.** On July 18, former West Indies skipper Denesh Ramdin announced his retirement from international cricket. Ramdin led West Indies in 17 matches - 13 Tests, three T20Is and an ODI after he was named West Indies' Test captain in 2014. Ramdin played his last match for West Indies in a T20I in December 2019. However, he will continue to play franchise cricket. Meanwhile, West Indies batter Lendl Simmons also announced his retirement from international cricket. {Read more}.

**377.** On July 15, the Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute and Research Centre (RGCI) has installed the first-ever made in India surgical robotic system, "SSI-Mantra", devised by new-age Indian med-tech start-up SS Innovations. The RGCI is a visionary project of the Indraprastha Cancer Society and Research Centre aimed at providing the best of oncological care to those who need it. {Read more}



**396.** On July 15, Adani Group chief Gautam Adani became the world's 4<sup>th</sup> richest person with a net worth of \$112.9 billion, surpassing Microsoft cofounder Bill Gates (\$102 billion), according to Forbes' Real-Time Billionaires List. The rankings of billionaires shuffled after Microsoft founder Bill Gates last week announced \$20 billion donation of his wealth to his non-profit organisation - Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Reliance Group Chairman, Mukesh Ambani, with a net worth of \$90.1 billion, was placed at 10<sup>th</sup> on the Forbes list. Elon Musk topped the list with \$230 billion net worth, followed by Bernard Arnault & Jeff Bezos. While on July 21, according to the Bloomberg Billionaires Index, Indian billionaire Gautam Adani displaced Bill Gates to become the world's 4<sup>th</sup>-richest person. Adani's net worth surged to \$112.5 billion. Reliance chairman Mukesh Ambani ranked 10<sup>th</sup> with about \$90 billion wealth in Bloomberg Billionaires Index. Only three people were richer than Adani: Tesla chief Elon Musk (\$252. 2 billion net worth), Louis Vuitton CEO Bernard Arnault (\$156. 5 billion), and Amazon founder Jeff Bezos (\$149. 9 billion). {Read more}
