

10. On June 3, India commissioned a unique "International Liquid-Mirror Telescope (ILMT)" atop a mountain in the Himalayan region. The telescope is built by astronomers from India, Belgium and Canada and it is located at an altitude of 2,450 metres at the Devasthal Observatory campus of Aryabhatta Research Institute of Observational Sciences (ARIES) in Nainital district, Uttarakhand. It is India's first and Asia's largest liquid-mirror telescope. It will keep a watch on the skies to identify transient or variable objects such as space debris, asteroids, supernovae and gravitational lenses. ILMT is a 4-metre class telescope. While 3.6 metre Devasthal Optical Telescope (DOT) is also located at ARIES in Nainital, Uttarakhand. {Read more}

Total accidents in 2020 decreased on an average by 18.46%, the number of persons killed decreased by 12.84% and the number of injures decreased by 22.84% over previous year's average. As per report, a total of 1,20,806 fatal accidents were reported in 2020, which is 12.23% lower than 2019. {Read more}
