

51. On June 1, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) launched two-month long "Har Ghar Dastak campaign 2.0". The objective of this mega Covid vaccination drive is to achieve optimal coverage among all eligible beneficiaries and accelerate the pace of vaccination. The campaign will continue till the July 31, 2022. Emphasis will be given to focused campaigns in old age homes, schools, colleges, prisons and brick kilns among others. {Read more}

And the Mining & construction of Permanent Structures within Extended Buffer Zone (ESZ) of 1 km radius of National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries is restricted. A bench comprising Justices L Nageswara Rao, BR Gavai and Aniruddha Bose passed the directions in applications filed in the T. N. Godavarman Thirumalpad case. A set of Guidelines for Declaration of EcoSensitive Zones (ESZ) around National Park and Wildlife Sanctuaries had been formulated by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) in 2011. {Read more}

58. On June 5, Sikkim Chief Minister Prem Singh Tamang, on the occasion of "World Environment Day", declared 'Blue Duke' as the State Butterfly. Of the 720 species of butterflies found in Sikkim, Blue Duke was selected as the state butterfly securing 57% votes in a recent online poll conducted by the Forest Department. Blue Duke, which goes by the scientific name 'Bassarona durga durga', is unique to Sikkim and the eastern Himalayas. It was discovered in the state in 1858. Blue Duke falls in 'Schedule 2' of the 'Wildlife Protection Act, 1972' and is a protected species in the Himalayas. {Read more}

59. On June 3, the government has approved a four-decade-low interest rate of 8.1% on Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) deposits for 2021-22, down from 8.5% in the previous year. Every month, an employee contributes 12% of his or her base income to the PF account, and the employer matches this payment. Umang App, EPFO Member e-Sewa portal, SMS, or a missed call are all options for checking the EPF amount. Moreover, in 2021, the PFRDA had increased the maximum age for joining the National Pension System (NPS) from 65 years to 70 years. Now the age criteria is 18-70 years. {Read more} Key Points:

The campaign was initially launched in December, 2021. About 74,000 cadets from 10 States and 4 Union Territories participated in the campaign during this phase. The purpose of the Abhiyan is to educate locals and sensitise them about 'Swachh Bharat'. {Read more}

- **62.** On June 3, the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) and India's public service broadcaster Prasar Bharati are exploring the feasibility of a technology called "Direct-to-Mobile (D2M) Broadcasting" that allows to broadcast video and other forms of multimedia content directly to mobile phones, without needing an active internet connection. Band 526-582 MHz is envisaged to work in coordination with both mobile and broadcast services. DoT has set up a committee to study this band. Moreover, Prasar Bharati had last year announced collaboration with IIT Kanpur to test the feasibility of this technology. {Read more}

According to a draft notification for Electronic Waste Management for Public Feedback, released by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEFCC), consumer goods companies and makers of electronics goods have to ensure that atleast 60% of their electronic waste is collected and recycled by 2023, with targets to increase them to 70% and 80% in 2024 and 2025 respectively. India first announced these rules in 2016 and amended it in 2018. Companies will have to register on an online portal and specify their annual production and e-waste collection targets. Along with specifying targets, the rules also lay out a system of companies securing Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) certificates. Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) will be the chief entity that will coordinate the trade of EPR certificates and monitor if companies are meeting their targets. {Read more}

64. On June 2, Turkish government sent a letter to the United Nations formally requesting the UN to recognise the country as 'Turkiye'. President Recep Tayyip Erdogan's government has been pressing for the internationally recognised name Turkey to be changed to "Turkiye" (pronounced tur-key-YAY) as it is spelled and pronounced in Turkish. The country's full official name will be "Republic of Türkiye". The country called itself Turkiye in 1923 after its declaration of independence. {Read more}

66. On June 1, the US announced to send "M142 Himars System" (High Mobility Artillery Rocket System) to Ukraine. The new weapon is a multiple launch rocket system (MLRS). It is a mobile unit that can simultaneously launch multiple precision-guided missiles. Both Ukraine and Russia already operate MLRS, but Himars has superior range and precision. These Himars missiles will have a range of about 50 miles (80 km). {Read more}

These researchers have also found that the plant is 4,500 years old. The ribbon weed covers an area of 20,000 hectares, 180 km in length. The largest tree in India, the Great Banyan in Howrah's Botanical Garden in West Bengal, covers 1.41 hectares. {Read more}
