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

The Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) took up the ₹9,000 Cr Mekedatu Balancing Reservoir-cum-Drinking Water Project of the Karnataka government for discussion at its meeting held on June 17. The total annual quantum prescribed by the Supreme Court for Tamil Nadu is 177.25 thousand million cubic feet (tmc ft) in a year. Of this, 80 tmc ft is estimated to be coming from the "uncontrolled catchments" below Kabini and KRS. The Mekedatu project will interfere with the flow of this portion of the State's due. {Read more}

On June 7, Union Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia unveiled "National Air Sports Policy 2022 (NASP 2022)" to promote sports like aerobatics, hot-air ballooning, and paragliding, with the aim of making India one of the top aerosports nations by 2030. As part of the policy, a four-tier structure will be established to govern aero sports, with the Air Sports Federation of India (ASFI) as the apex body. The ASFI will be an autonomous body under the Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA). Air sports are managed by the Switzerland-based Federation Aeronautique Internationale (FAI) around the world. {Read more}

3. On June 6, Kerala government announced that two cases of Norovirus infection, similar to the diarrhoea-inducing rotavirus, were found in the state. The disease is highly-contagious and the state health department urged the people to maintain hygiene. It is a virus which leads to gastroenteritis or stomach flu. {Read more}

- **4.** On June 8, National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has created a Guinness World Record for constructing a single lane continuous bituminous concrete road of 75 kilometres in 105 hours and 33 minutes on the National Highway (NH) between Amravati and Akola districts in Maharashtra. The project was implemented by 720 workers. The Amravati to Akola section is part of NH 53. Union Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari has set a target to build 60 kilometres of highway per day in India. During the pandemic in 2021-22, the country's national highway construction speed had even slowed down to 28.64 km a day. Primary responsibility of the construction of national highways and expressways across the country lies with the NHAI & NHIDCL. {Read more}

- **5.** On June 3, the 3rd "Uttar Pradesh Investment Summit 2022" was inaugurated by PM Narendra Modi in the presence of CM Yogi Adityanath in Lucknow. PM Modi laid the foundation stone of 1,406 projects worth more than Rs 80,000 Cr in the state. Abu Dhabi-headquartered Lulu Group will invest Rs 2500 Cr in Uttar Pradesh in 3 new projects in the state. Besides, Adani Group will invest Rs 70,000 Cr in Uttar Pradesh. More than 600 investors are showcasing various initiatives, mega projects as well as number of startups and technological innovations. - **6.** On June 7, Ministry of Power notified the "Green Open Access Rules, 2022" to further accelerate India's renewable energy programmes. These rules are notified for promoting generation, purchase and consumption of green energy including through waste-to-energy plants. It enables a simplified procedure for the open access to green power. As per the rules, the green open access is allowed to any consumer and the limit of open access transaction has been reduced from 1 MW (megawatt) to 100 kW for green energy. As per the rules, the approvals are to be granted in 15 days or else it will be deemed to have been approved. {Read more}

12. The RBI's 2nd Monetary Policy of FY23 was released on June 8, 2022. At the end of its 3-day monetary policy committee (MPC) meeting, the RBI saw inflation higher at 6.7% for the current fiscal year. Consumer prices accelerated to an eight-year high of nearly 7.8% in April, according to official data. The RBI raised the repo rate by 50 basis points to 4.90%. The Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate & Bank Rate is revised to 5.15%. The Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) and the Statutory Liquidity Ratio (SLR) are kept unchanged at 4.50% & 18% respectively. While Reverse Repo Rate is also kept unchanged at 3.35%. {Read more}

On June 4, the Insurance Regulatory & Development Authority of India (IRDAI) reduced the capital required by insurance companies offering policies under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) by almost 50%. The easing of capital requirements by IRDAI will accelerate the penetration of life insurance in India. PMJJBY provides life insurance cover worth Rs 2 lakh to all account holders aged 18-50 years. The claims ratio for PMJJBY was 145.24% as of March 31, 2022. Recently, the Centre increased the premium rates for PMJJBY from Rs 330 to Rs 436 a year effective from June 1, 2022. {Read more} Key Points:

On June 8, the Reserve Bank (RBI) raised the Additional Factor of Authentication (AFA) limit from Rs 5,000 to Rs 15,000 per transaction for e-mandates on cards, Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs) and UPI for recurring transactions. That means additional authentication will not be need for payment of Rs 15,000 per transaction. The RBI also proposed to allow the linking of credit cards to the UPI platform for the first time. Moreover, in a big boost to the home loan segment, the RBI doubled the limit on housing loans from cooperative banks. The limits for tier-I and tier-II UCBs have been revised from Rs 30 lakh to Rs 60 lakh and Rs 70 lakh to Rs 1.40 Cr, respectively. These limits were last revised for UCBs in 2011 and for RCBs in 2009. {Read more}

On June 6, the US and South Korean militaries launched 8 ballistic missiles into the sea, aimed at demonstrating the ability to respond swiftly and accurately to North Korean attacks as South Korean military detected North Korea firing 8 short-range missiles on 5 June. The allies' live-fire exercise involved 8 Army Tactical Missile System missiles - one American and seven South Korean. {Read more}

16. On June 7, the Ministry of Defense issued new guidelines for the post of the Chief of Defence Staff (CDS). The new guidelines broaden the scope of eligible officers. The next Chief of Defence Staff could be anyone from the three serving Chiefs of Army, IAF or Navy, any serving three-star officer, any retired chief who is below 62 or any retired three-star officer also below the same age. Another change in eligibility criteria marks the inclusion of recently retired service chiefs and vice chiefs, despite the age ceiling being 62 years. The top post fell vacant after the sudden demise of General Bipin Rawat in December 2021. He took office as the CDS on 1 December, 2020. {Read more}



While in Men's singles, Rafael Nadal defeated Casper Ruud to win his 14th French Open title. With this, Rafael Nadal became the first player in history to win 22 Grand Slam titles in Men's Singles, followed by Roger Federer with 20 Grand Slams.
