

As per the circular recently issued by the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) on June 8, all 'hyper-sensitive' airports in India will have to install a Perimeter Intrusion Detection System (PIDS) by December, 2023. The PIDS is a sensor that helps in alerting security agencies of any intrusion through the airport's boundary walls. Meanwhile, Bengaluru International Airport in Karnataka has recently introduced Artificial Intelligence-driven, assistance robots. {Read more}

208. On June 7, the longest steel bridge of India, "Mahatma Gandhi Setu" became operational. It is built over the river Ganga in Bihar connecting Patna in the south to Hajipur in the North. It was inaugurated in 1982 by Late Prime Minister Indira Gandhi and is around 5750 metres (18,860 feet) long. The Mahatma Gandhi Setu is also the first cantilever bridge in India. The project was given to Afcons Infrastructure, with Submit OJSC as a joint venture at an estimated cost of Rs 1,742 Cr. {Read more}

India is home to approximately 6.3 Cr MSMEs accounting for 30% of the country's GDP and employing over 110 million people at present. {Read more}

210. On June 9, Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar launched India's first homegrown COVID-19 vaccine for animals namely "Anocovax". It is developed by Haryana-based ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines (NRC). Anocovax is an inactivated SARS-CoV-2 Delta (COVID-19) vaccine for animals. The immunity induced by Anocovax neutralises both Delta and Omicron variants of SARS-CoV-2. The vaccine contains inactivated SARS-CoV-2 (Delta) antigen with Alhydrogel as an adjuvant which is safe for dogs, lions, leopards, mice and rabbits. {Read more}

211. On June 8, the Technology Development Board (TDB), a statutory body under the Department of Science & Technology, is set to launch a Rs 1,000 Cr startup fund under a public private partnership model. The TDB was set up as a statutory body in September 1996, under the "Technology Development Board Act, 1995". {Read more}

212. On June 9, the 193-member UN General Assembly (UNGA) held elections to elect the 5 non-permanent members for the 2-year term 2023-24. Ecuador, Japan, Malta, Mozambique and Switzerland were elected to the UN Security Council (UNSC) as non-permanent members for the 2023-2024 term and they will replace India, Ireland, Kenya, Mexico and Norway from January 1, 2023. India's two-year term at the UNSC as non-permanent member will end in December 2022. {Read more}

213. On June 9, Thailand became the first Asian country to legalize cultivating and possessing Marijuana for medical use. Thailand mainly wants to make a splash in the market for medical marijuana. It already has a well-developed medical tourism industry and its tropical climate is ideal for growing cannabis. Marijuana, also known as Cannabis among other names, is a psychoactive drug from the Cannabis plant. {Read more}

214. On June 8, China released a new comprehensive Geologic Map of the moon, the 'most detailed' till date. The map is to a scale of 1:25,00,000. The map includes 12,341 impact craters, 81 impact basins, 17 rock types and 14 types of structures. This map is expected to make a vital contribution to scientific research, exploration and landing site selection on the Earth's only natural satellite. The map was published by Science Bulletin. Previously, the USGS Astrogeology Science Centre had released a moon map to a scale of 1:50,00,000 in 2020. {Read more}

On June 9, Members of the European Parliament voted in Strasbourg, France to require automakers to cut carbon-dioxide emissions by 100% by 2035, by banning the sale of new petrol and diesel cars. The move aims to step up the fight against climate change through the faster development of electric vehicles. EU lawmakers also endorsed a 55% reduction in CO2 from automobiles in 2030 compared with 2021. {Read more}

The resolution also mentions Bangla and Urdu for the first time. The resolution encourages the UN to continue communication in official as well as non-official languages such as Portuguese, Kiswahili, Hindi, Persian, Bangla, and Urdu. {Read more}

The 'Extreme Risk Protection Laws', known informally as 'red-flag' laws, are among the possible solutions offered to tackle the endemic gun violence in the United States. The current 'red-flag' bill passed, called the 'Federal Extreme Risk Protection Order', was sponsored by the Democratic Representative of Georgia, Lucy Mcbath. The first 'red-flag' law was introduced in Connecticut in 1999. {Read more}

228. On June 13, Canadian singer Justin Bieber announced that he has been infected by a virus that causes the Ramsay Hunt syndrome. The Ramsay Hunt syndrome is a rare neurological disorder caused by the 'Varicella-Zoster' virus of the human herpesvirus family. There is no age bracket within which the virus affects humans. Ramsay Hunt syndrome occurs when a shingles outbreak affects the facial nerve near one of our ears. {Read more}

In June 2022, the researchers at the Botanical Survey of India (BSI) rediscovered a rare plant, sometimes called the "Indian Lipstick Plant", from remote Anjaw district in Arunachal Pradesh, after more than 100 years. The plant (Aeschynanthus monetaria Dunn) was first identified by British botanist Stephen Troyte Dunn in 1912. {Read more} Key Points:

230. On June 11, 'Chelonoidis phantasticus', which means 'Fantastic Giant Tortoise', commonly called the 'Fernandina Island Galapagos Giant Tortoise' has been discovered after a century. Researchers have reported the confirmation in a paper in "Nature Comunications Biology". The species was so far known only from a single individual, collected in 1906. Fernandina Island is the 3rd largest and youngest island of the Galapagos Islands, located in Ecuador. {Read more}

Appointments & Resignations

231. On June 11, Senior Indian diplomat Amandeep Singh Gill was appointed by United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres as his Envoy on Technology. The UN describes him as a "thought leader on digital technology". Amandeep was India's Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the Conference on Disarmament in Geneva from 2016 to 2018. He is the CEO of the International Digital Health & Artificial Intelligence Research Collaborative (I-DAIR) project, based in Geneva. The UN also appointed Ambassador Rabab Fatima, Permanent Representative of Bangladesh to the UN, as the Under Secretary General or Assistant Secretary General of the UN. She was also appointed as High Representative for the Least Developed Countries, Landlocked Developing Countries, and Small Island Developing States (UN-OHRLLS). She succeeds Jamaica's Courtenay Rattray. {Read more}

232. On June 9, the Election Commission of India (ECI) announced July 18 as the date of the 16th Presidential Election for electing the next President of India. The tenure of President Ram Nath Kovind will come to an end on July 24, 2022, and as per Article 62 of the Constitution, an election to fill the vacancy caused by the expiration of the term of office is required to be completed before the term ends. As per the 'Article 54', the President is elected by an Electoral College consisting of elected MPs of both Houses of Parliament and elected MLAs of the Legislative Assemblies of all states. Ram Nath Kovind was declared as the President-elect after the counting of votes which was held on 20 July 2017. {Read more}


