

National & States Affairs

351. On June 16, Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) has developed an Indian Standard, "IS 17693: 2022", for a non-electric cooling cabinet made of clay. Mansukh Bhai Prajapati from Gujarat is the innovator behind the refrigerator which is named as 'Mitticool Refrigerator'. It is a natural refrigerator made primarily from clay to store vegetables, fruits, milk and also for cooling water. It provides natural coolness to foodstuffs stored in it without requiring any electricity. {Read more}

352. In June 2022, Bhogeshwara, reportedly the elephant with the longest tusks in Asia, died of natural causes at the age of 60. The wild elephant, also known as Mr. Kabini, was found dead in the Gundre range of Karnataka's Bandipur Tiger Reserve. According to forest department officials, Bhogeshwar's tusks (long & pointed teeth) were 2.54 meters and 2.34 meters long. {Read more}

353. On June 15, the Uttar Pradesh government decided to give incentives to set up units in the state's first Medical Device Park proposed on 350-acre land in Sector 28 of Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA). It was also decided to implement the centrally-sponsored Pt Deendayal Upadhyay Kisan Samridhi Yojana in the state till 2026-27. The state cabinet approved a proposal to set up Pilibhit Tiger Protection Foundation under the provisions of "Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972". Moreover, the state cabinet approved a proposal wherein no stamp duty will be levied on transfer of property between blood relations. The cabinet also approved a proposal to provide a sum of Rs 4.22 Cr to Bhatkhande Cultural University. {Read more}

354. The Delhi Airport (Indira Gandhi International Airport) is India's first airport to introduce personalised baggage tag called "BAGG TRAX", enabled by Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) technology. It will give passengers real-time information about when and on which belt is their check-in luggage arriving in the terminal. {Read more}

355. The census exercise, which was originally scheduled to take place in 2021, has been further pushed to 2023-24. In a letter sent to all states and UTs, the office of the Registrar General of India (RGI) has extended the deadline of freezing of administrative boundaries to December 31, 2022. As per 'Rule 8 (iv)' of the "Census Rules, 1990", the boundaries of administrative units shall be frozen from the date intimated by the Census Commissioner, which shall not be earlier than one year from the Census reference date. According to provisional RGI data, the number of districts has gone up from 640 in 2011 to 736. {Read more}

356. On June 17, Steel Minister Ram Chandra Prasad Singh inaugurated a 6-lane highway in Surat made of steel slag, a first of its kind in India. The road constructed using 100% steel-processed slag (waste) is a real example of converting "Waste into Wealth". Slag is a by-product (waste) of steel manufacturing. The road has jointly been made with the CSIR-Central Road Research Institute (CRRI). {Read more}

357. On June 17, India's first-ever girl Panchayat, "Balika Panchayat" is started in several villages of Gujarat's Kutch district. It aims to promote the social and political development of the girls and ensure their active participation of girls in politics. This is a unique initiative of the Women and Child Development Welfare department of the Gujarat Government under the 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' campaign. The Ministry of Women & Child Development is also planning to begin the girl panchayat across India. "Balika Panchayat" is a panchayat of girls between the age of 10 and 21 years. {Read more} Key Points:

On June 17, Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel inaugurated India's first government desalination plant only for industrial use at Dahej in Bharuch with a capacity of 100 MLD (million litres per day), set up at a cost of Rs 881 crore. The daily requirement of water for industries in Dahej is around 200 MLD, which is currently fetched from the Narmada river. The industries will now get treated sea water for their use. Former CM Vijay Rupani had laid the foundation for the plant at Dahej on November 30, 2019, due to the increased demand for water in industries. {Read more}

359. In June 2022, Red Sand Dunes were recently identified in the small desert situated in Tamil Nadu. The red dunes are called "Theri" in Tamil. They consist of sediments dating back to the Quaternary Period and are made of marine deposits. The dunes are spread over Kuthiraimozhi theri (2,387.12 hectares) and Sathankulam (899.08 ha) reserve forest of Tiruchendur taluk. {Read more}

The committee examines the representation of employees who are sacked under Fundamental Rule (FR) 56 (J), (I) and Rule 48 of the "Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules 1972". {Read more}

361. On June 18, Hanle village in Ladakh is set to become India's first Dark Sky Reserve. The village is part of Changthang Wildlife Sanctuary. The site will host activities to promote astronomy-tourism, giving a boost to local tourism and economy through science. Once declared as the Hanle Dark Sky Reserve (HDSR), the administration, local council members along with the scientists will collectively work towards preservation of the night sky from unwanted light pollution and illumination. {Read more}

364. On June 14, PM Narendra Modi inaugurated an underground "Gallery of Revolutionaries" museum dedicated to the luminaries of the freedom struggle, at the Raj Bhavan in Mumbai. The underground gallery is established in the subterranean network of 13 pre-World War-I British era bunkers. The gallery includes information on the freedom movement heroes, their role in the movement, sculptures, rare photographs, murals and details on tribal revolutionaries drawn by school-kids. {Read more}

365. In June 2022, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M. K. Stalin inaugurated "Empress", India's premium cruise, from Chennai Port. It is the first-ever luxury cruise line from the State. The vessel is operated by Cordelia Cruises. It sailed with 1,800 passengers and 600 crew. The Empress has 11 decks with 796 cabins and it will anchor at Puducherry and Visakhapatnam harbours. The two-night and three-day package costs around Rs 40,000 and a five-day trip to Puducherry costs around Rs 90,000 and could go beyond Rs 1.5 lakh. {Read more}

366. On June 16, Australia's new government formally committed to a more ambitious Greenhouse Gas reduction target of 43% by 2030, against its previous target of 26-28%. The total merchandise exports stood at \$95.5 billion in Q1 of FY22. Non-oil exports continue to witness a double-digit growth of 12.6%, amounting to \$93 billion in Q1 FY23. {Read more}

371. The Wholesale Price Index (WPI) inflation rose to a record high of 15.88% in May from 15.08% in April, according to data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Commerce & Industry. The high rate of inflation in May, 2022 is primarily due to rise in prices of mineral oils, crude petroleum & natural gas, food articles, basic metals, non-food articles, chemicals & chemical products and food products etc. Inflation in food articles in May was 12.34%. Retail inflation in May was 7.04%. The highest inflation rate was recorded by Telangana at 9.45%. To tame stubbornly high inflation, the RBI hiked its key interest rate by 40 basis points in May and 50 basis points in June. The RBI also raised inflation projection by 100 basis points to 6.7% for 2022-23. {Read more}

375. On June 15, the US Federal Reserve hiked interest rates by 0.75 percentage point, highest rate hike in 28 years since 1994, in a bid to tame runaway inflation. The hike in rates by the Fed came after inflation in the US surged unexpectedly in May, 2022. After the conclusion of a two-day Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) meeting in June, the US Central Bank chair Jerome Powell indicated that the Fed would increase its key interest rate by three quarters of a percentage point to a range of 1.5% to 1.75%. {Read more}

In June 2022, the official "FIFA U17 Women's World Cup 2022" draw was held at the FIFA Headquarters in Zurich, Switzerland in which hosts India have been clubbed with the USA, Morocco, and Brazil in Group A. The tournament will start on October 11 in Bhubaneswar and Goa. The DY Patil Stadium in Navi Mumbai will host the third-place match and final on October 30. This is the second time India is hosting a FIFA tournament after the U-17 Men's World Cup in 2017. {Read more} Key Points:

378. On June 15, India's Olympic gold medallist Neeraj Chopra set a new national record and finished with a silver medal with a throw of 89.30 metres at the Paavo Nurmi Games in Finland, bettering his own previous national record of 88.07 meters which he had set in Patiala in March, 2021. At the Tokyo Olympics on August 7, 2021, Chopra had won Gold medal for his throw of 87.58 meters. Finland's Oliver Helander won Gold medal with his personal best of 89.93 meters. {Read more}

Reportedly, Mexico is the first nation in football world to host the FIFA World Cup three times. {Read more}

380. On June 12, Britain's Queen Elizabeth II overtook Thailand's King Bhumibol Adulyadej to become the world's second-longest reigning monarch in history, after France's Louis XIV. The UK celebrated the 96-year-old Queen's Platinum Jubilee to mark 70 years of service to the nation with grand events. Thailand's King reigned for 70 years and 126 days between 1927 and 2016. Louis XIV of France remains the longest-reigning monarch, with a 72-year and 110-day reign from 1643 until 1715. {Read more}

381. In June 2022, Shreyas G. Hosur became the first officer from the Indian Railways to complete the gruelling "Ironman Triathlon" in Hamburg, Germany. He completed the event in 13 hours and 26 minutes. The Ironman Triathlon is considered to be the toughest single-day sports event in the world comprising - 3.8 km of Swimming, 180 km of Cycling and 42.2 km of Running. Hosur is a 2012-batch Indian Railway Accounts Service (IRAS) officer. This year was the race's 5th edition in Hamburg. {Read more}

Science & Technology

382. On June 16, the scientists discovered a new species of bamboo-dwelling bat in Nongkhyllem Wildlife Sanctuary in Ri Bhoi district of Meghalaya. The species has been named "Glischropus Meghalayanus" in honour of Megalaya's 50th statehood year. This discovery is the first report of a thick-thumbed bat not only from India but also from South Asia. The discovery was published in journal "Zootaxa". With this new discovery, the total number of bat species known from India stands at 131. Meghalaya harbours the highest bat diversity in the country with 67 species (51%). {Read more}
