

On March 22, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) gave approval for the extension of applicability of "New Investment Policy (NIP)-2012" for 3 upcoming units of Hindustan Urvarak & Rasayan Ltd (HURL) at Gorakhpur, Sindri and Barauni. These three facilities aim to meet the demand for urea in seven states - Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal and Odisha. GAIL is supplying natural gas to these three units. HURL, incorporated in June, 2016, is a joint venture of Coal India Ltd, NTPC and Indian Oil Corporation. {Read more}

Moreover, Punjab State Assembly passed a resolution to install statues of Shaheed Bhagat Singh and Babasaheb Ambedkar in the Assembly. Shaheed Diwas 2022 was organized by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) by focusing on the theme "Tribute to Revolutionaries". {Read more}

Earlier the option of changing convertible notes into equity shares was allowed for up to 5 years from the day when initial convertible note was issued. The meeting was held in-person from March 21-25 in Bali. The Minamata Convention on Mercury is the most recent global agreement on Environment and Health. It was adopted in 2013 and entered into force August 16, 2017. {Read more}

The 65 new exoplanets will be studied for compositions that might support the presence of microbes, water, and gases or even life. More than 5,000 planets are now confirmed to exist beyond our solar system. Any planet that exists beyond our solar system is an exoplanet. NASA's Kepler Space Telescope suggests that the galaxy contains more planets than stars. {Read more}

It was on March 24, 1882 that the bacteria causing TB was discovered by Dr. Robert Koch. A century later, the World TB Day observance began on the same day. In 2022, the theme is "Invest to End TB. Save Lives". {Read more}
